

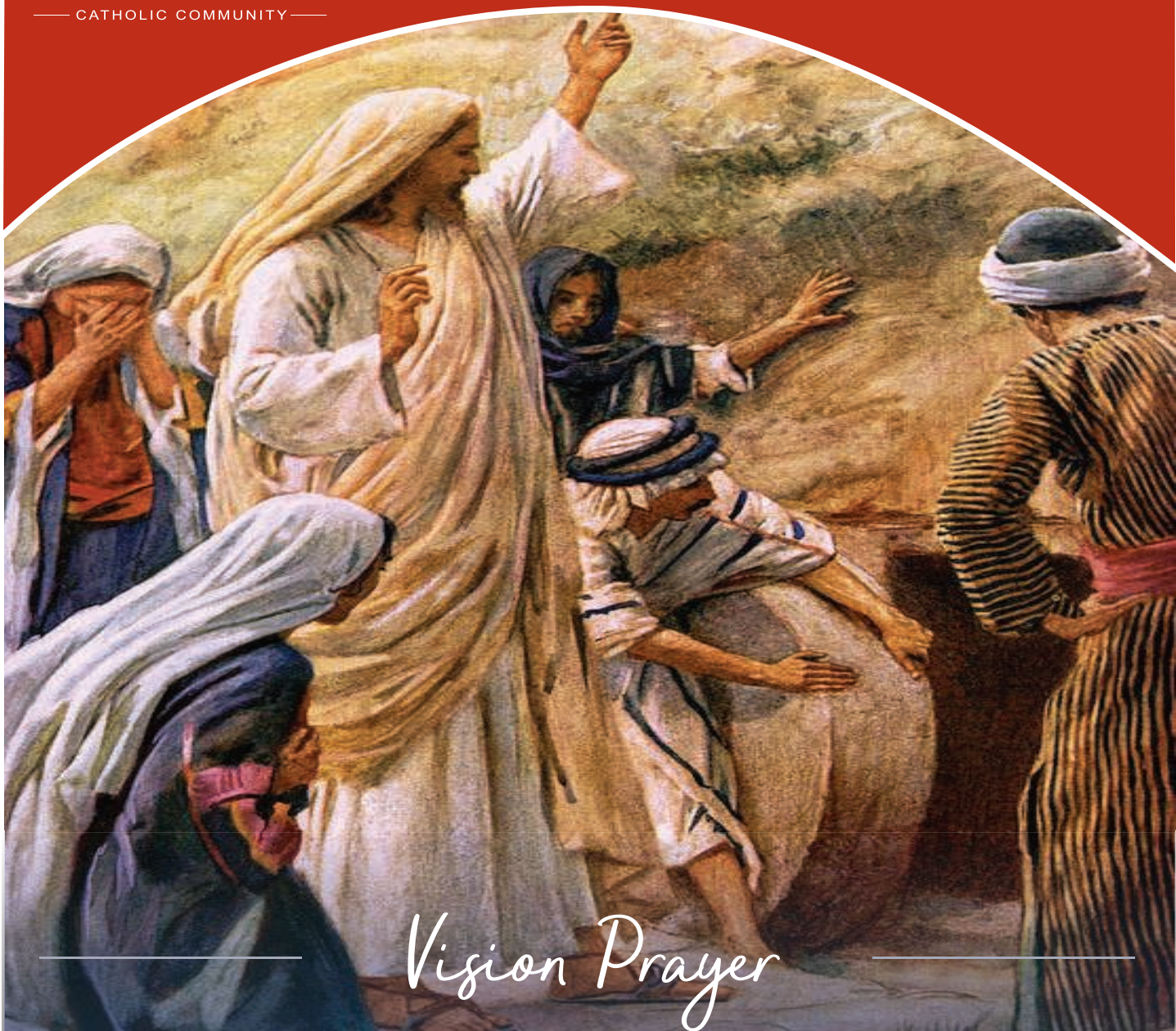

Friends,

This week ends our 5-week message series titled "When God Doesn't Make Sense." So far, we've received a good amount of positive feedback. The message for today is "unanswered prayer and God's timing." We will hear from John's Gospel the story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead. Jesus receives word that His close friend is very sick. Yet, he waits instead of speedily going to help. Martha and Mary, the sisters of Lazarus, remark, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died." Jesus' actions, at face value, really don't make sense. But perhaps upon further review, they, in fact, do?

Remember that God's timing differs from ours. Many times, that is difficult for us to understand. But we must trust that God always has a better plan. So, I encourage you to listen closely to the homily this weekend as the Deacons will present the last of our Lenten message series. And as always, we welcome your feedback.

Now, I'd like to switch gears and acknowledge two people who have been instrumental to our St. Norbert Parish Community. Ron and Maria Pollack are transitioning away from ministry. We wish them the very best in their future endeavors. Ron has been head sacristan since 2016. The sacristan is really the unsung hero of the liturgical celebration. The job of the sacristan takes excellent attention to detail- setting up for Mass and keeping up on all things needed for worship. From Altar linens to hosts to the sacramental wine and votive candles to making sure the priests have clean vestments. Ron also kept the schedule for all liturgical ministers, including altar servers, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, and lectors.

Ron has graciously offered to advise the person or persons who will take over this most critical position in our parish. Ron and Maria worked together and were central players in the Respect Life Ministry. Maria was right there, operating alongside Ron in all his duties to serve the Lord. Maria was also essential to our first Saturday, Our Lady of Fatima devotion. We are very grateful for their years of service to the St. Norbert Parish Community. Let us always keep them in our prayers.

Esta semana termina nuestra serie de mensajes de 5 semanas titulada "Cuando Dios no tiene sentido". Hasta ahora, hemos recibido una gran cantidad de comentarios positivos. El mensaje de hoy es "La oración sin respuesta y el tiempo de Dios". Escucharemos del Evangelio de Juan la historia de Jesús resucitando a Lázaro de entre los muertos. Jesús recibe la noticia de que su amigo íntimo está muy enfermo. Sin embargo, en lugar de ir rápidamente a ayudarlo, espera. Marta y María, las hermanas de Lázaro, comentan: "Señor, si hubieras estado aquí, mi hermano no hubiese muerto". Las acciones de Jesús, a primera vista, no tienen sentido. Pero tal vez, si las revisamos más detenidamente, sí lo tengan.

Recuerda que el tiempo de Dios difiere del nuestro. Muchas veces, eso nos resulta difícil de entender, pero debemos confiar en que Dios siempre tiene un mejor plan. Por lo tanto, los animo a escuchar con atención la homilía de este fin de semana.

Ahora, me gustaría cambiar de tema y reconocer a dos personas que han sido fundamentales para nuestra comunidad de San Norberto. Ron y Maria Pollack están dejando el ministerio. Les deseamos lo mejor en sus futuros proyectos. Ron ha sido el sacristán coordinador desde 2016. El sacristán es realmente el héroe anónimo de la celebración litúrgica. El trabajo del sacristán requiere una excelente atención al detalle, la preparación para la misa y mantenerse al día en todas las cosas necesarias para la misa, desde los manteles del altar hasta las hostias, el vino sacramental y las velas. 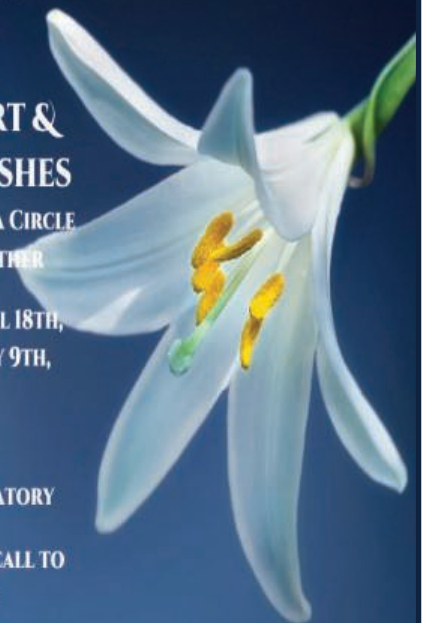
