

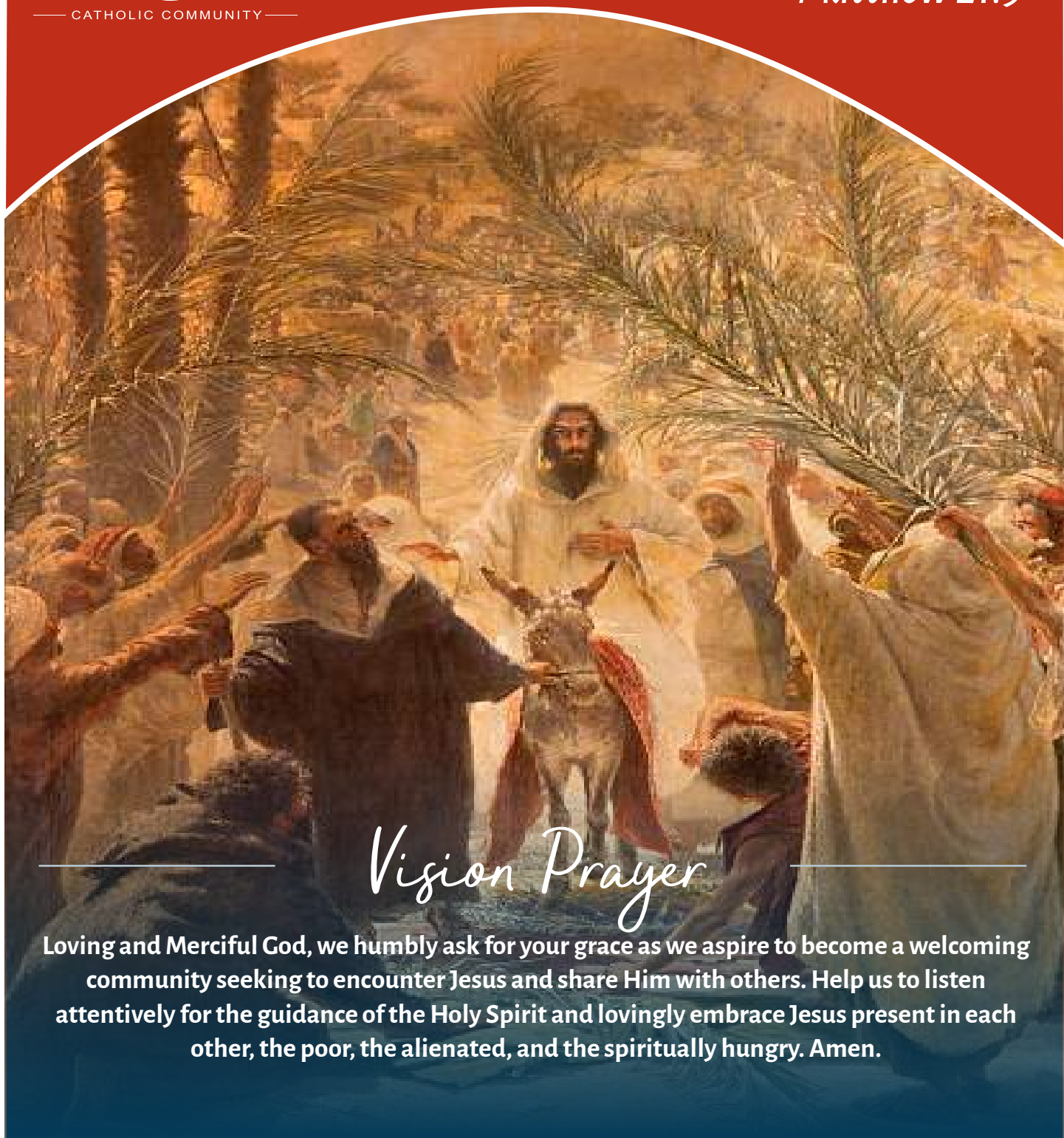

Friends,

Holy Week begins. The Scripture passage from today's Gospel is read at the beginning of Mass to commemorate Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem to fulfill the Passover. That year, Jesus was to become the new Passover Lamb. Today's Liturgy of the Word concludes with Matthew's version of Jesus' betrayal, arrest, and death on the Cross. Since we are blessed to read this narrative in full detail today, it is helpful to call to mind the Church's understanding of the Word of God.

When the Sacred Scriptures are read in Church, God speaks directly to us, and Christ is present in his word. This is an important lesson to learn, especially today. Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem, His last supper, and his suffering and death on the Cross happened over 2,000 years ago; in these historical events, Christ is present today. By participating in the proclamation of this Gospel, we are mystically united to this saving action of our Lord. And though our minds might wander at times, God is present if we listen.

As you begin this Holy Week, try to walk through it with Jesus every step of the way. Then, as you go about your week, remind yourself of the spiritual truth proclaimed today. On Holy Thursday, we will reflect on the Gift of the Most Holy Eucharist. On Good Friday, we'll hear Jesus' passion proclaimed in the Gospel of John.

At the heart of the story of the Passion of Jesus is a love like no other. This is a love that is pure, selfless, and sacrificial. It is a love so transforming that it is beyond comprehension. The love we witness is one in which God permits Himself to enter the deepest humiliation ever seen. He does this to meet us in our brokenness and imperfection and to raise us to the highest heights.

Know that Holy Week is more than a week of reflection. It's a week of participation in the mystery of God's pure and perfect love. As you reflect on this love, allow it to penetrate your heart.

I invite you to join us in the Triduum celebration beginning on Holy Thursday at 7:30 PM. On Good Friday at 12 noon for the Stations of the Cross. At 2 PM for the Good Friday Liturgy. At 7:30 PM, the Stations of the Cross in Spanish. And Holy Saturday for the Easter Vigil at 8 PM. And on Easter Sunday, for Mass at 9 and 11AM, with the Spanish Mass at 1:30 PM.

Amigos,

Comienza la Semana Santa. El pasaje del Evangelio de hoy se lee al comienzo de la Misa para conmemorar la entrada de Jesús en Jerusalén para cumplir la Pascua. Ese año, Jesús se convertiría en el nuevo Cordero pascual. La Liturgia de la Palabra de hoy concluye con la versión de Mateo de la traición, el arresto y la muerte de Jesús en la cruz. Puesto que hoy tenemos la bendición de leer este relato con todo detalle, es útil recordar cómo entiende la Iglesia la Palabra de Dios.

Cuando se leen las Sagradas Escrituras en la Iglesia, Dios nos habla directamente, y Cristo está presente en su palabra. Esta es una lección importante que debemos aprender, especialmente hoy. La entrada de Jesús en Jerusalén, su última cena y su sufrimiento y muerte en la Cruz sucedieron hace más de 2.000 años; en estos acontecimientos históricos, Cristo está presente hoy. Al participar en la proclamación de este Evangelio, nos unimos místicamente a esta acción salvadora de nuestro Señor. Y aunque nuestras mentes puedan divagar a veces, Dios está presente si escuchamos.

Al comenzar esta Semana Santa, intenta recorrerla con Jesús en cada paso del camino. Luego, a medida que avanza la semana, recuérdese a sí mismo la verdad espiritual proclamada hoy. El Jueves Santo, reflexionaremos sobre el Don de la Santísima Eucaristía. El Viernes Santo, escucharemos la proclamación de la pasión de Jesús en el Evangelio de Juan.

En el corazón de la historia de la Pasión de Jesús hay un amor sin igual. Es un amor puro, desinteresado y sacrificado. Es un amor tan transformador que resulta incomprensible. El amor que presenciamos es un amor en el que Dios se permite entrar en la humillación más profunda jamás vista. Lo hace para salir a nuestro encuentro en nuestro quebranto e imperfección y elevarnos a lo más alto.

Sabes que la Semana Santa es más que una semana de reflexión. Es una semana de participación en el misterio del amor puro y perfecto de Dios. Al reflexionar sobre este amor, deja que penetre en tu corazón.

Te invito a que te unas a nosotros en la celebración del Triduo que comienza el Jueves Santo a las 7:30 PM. El Viernes Santo a las 12 del mediodía para el Vía Crucis. A las 2 PM para la Liturgia del Viernes Santo. A las 7:30 PM, el Vía Crucis en Español. El Sábado Santo para la Vigilia Pascual a las 8 PM y el Domingo de Pascua, para la Misa a las 9 y 11 AM, y la Misa en Español a la 1:30 PM.
