

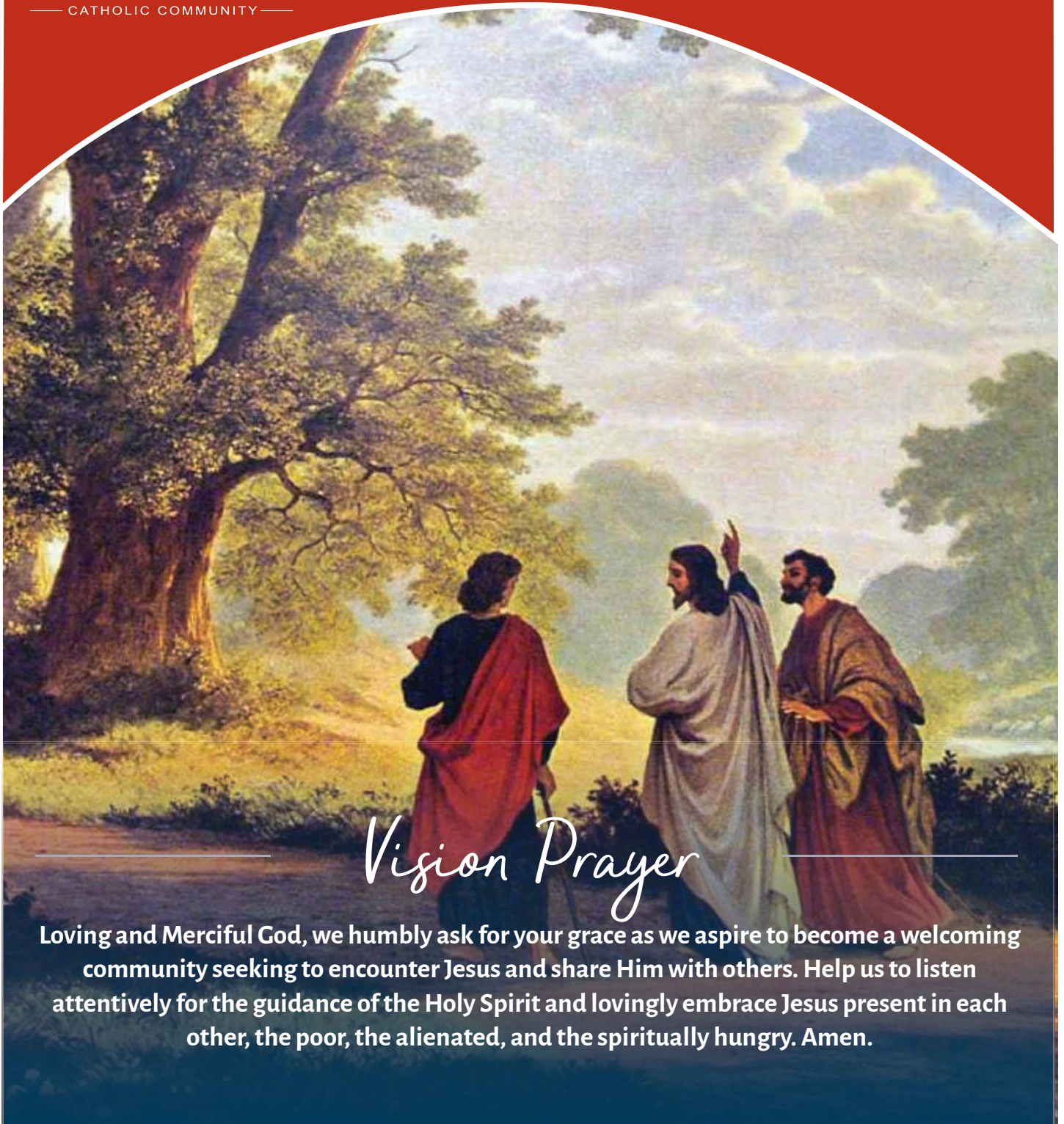

Welcome to St. Norbert Parish

To register with the parish, visit www.pariah.stnorbert.org and click the *Register with Us* page under the *About* tab to download the Parish Registration form (English and Spanish). The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation.
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

The Easter season is a time for rejoicing. Jesus has shattered the bonds of death through his Resurrection. We celebrate His victory because it is our victory as well. He didn't just destroy the bonds of death for himself but for all of us. And to show us the way to everlasting life.

In today's First Reading, St. Peter proclaims to the astounded crowds that it was impossible for Christ to be held by the throes of death. Peter alludes to King David because he's convincing his listeners by giving witness to Christ's Resurrection. He is proclaiming that Jesus is the Messiah.

When the Lord promised David that one of his descendants would be the Messiah, he said that descendant would reign forever (see 2 Samuel 7:12-13: "When your days are fulfilled, and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring after you, who shall come forth from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.")

The angel Gabriel told the same announcement to Mary: "He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give him the throne of his father David, and he will reign over the house of Jacob forever; of his kingdom, there will be no end" (Luke 1:32-33). Our Lord was that descendant of David, the Messiah.

It goes without saying that forever is a long time. Dynasties rise and fall, but David's will endure forever in Our Lord's because Christ conquered death: "God raised him up, releasing him from the throes of death."

Peter quotes Psalm 16 and attributes it to David (as the Psalms traditionally are) as a prophecy that David knew death would be conquered for him, too, through his descendant, who would reign forever. Jesus has fulfilled the prophecy. And shows us the path of life, true life forever with Him in paradise.

Christ is Risen. Alleluia, Alleluia!

Amigos,

La temporada de Pascua es un tiempo para regocijarse. Jesús ha roto los lazos de la muerte con su Resurrección. Celebramos su victoria porque es también nuestra victoria. Él no solamente destruyó los lazos de la muerte para sí mismo, sino para todos nosotros y para mostrarnos el camino a la vida eterna.

En la Primera Lectura de hoy, San Pedro proclama a las multitudes asombradas que era imposible que Cristo fuera retenido por las garras de la muerte. Pedro alude al rey David porque está convenciendo a sus oyentes al dar testimonio de la resurrección de Cristo. Él está proclamando que Jesús es el Mesías.

Cuando el Señor prometió a David que uno de sus descendientes sería el Mesías, dijo que ese descendiente reinaría para siempre (véase 2 Samuel 7:12-13: "Cuando tus días hayan concluido y te acuestes con tus padres, levantaré después de ti a tu descendiente, al que brota de tus entrañas, y afirmaré su realeza. El me construirá una casa y yo, por mi parte, afirmaré su trono real para siempre").

El ángel Gabriel le dio el mismo anuncio a María: "Este será grande y será llamado Hijo del Altísimo, y el Señor Dios le dará el trono de David, su padre, y reinará sobre la casa de Jacob para siempre; y su reino no tendrá fin" (Lc 1, 32-33). Nuestro Señor era ese descendiente de David, el Mesías.

No hace falta decir que para siempre es mucho tiempo. Las dinastías suben y bajan, pero la de David perdurará para siempre en la de Nuestro Señor, porque Cristo venció a la muerte: "Dios lo resucitó, liberándolo de la agonía de la muerte".

Pedro cita el Salmo 16 y se lo atribuye a David (como tradicionalmente se hace con los Salmos) como una profecía de que David sabía que la muerte sería vencida también para él a través de su descendiente, que reinaría para siempre. Jesús ha cumplido la profecía. Y nos muestra el camino de la vida, la verdadera vida para siempre con Él en el paraíso.

Cristo ha resucitado. ¡Aleluya, aleluya!


