



Reflections

ONE IN CHRIST



Friends,

Happy Easter! Jesus has risen today! He has overcome death and opened the gates of Heaven to all who believe. Alleluia!

Today's Gospel ends by saying, "For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead." This is evident by the initial reaction of Mary Magdalene, Peter, and the Apostle John. Mary first thought that someone had taken the body of Jesus. Peter and John were confused and ran to see. Once they saw the empty tomb, they believed. Eventually, all the Apostles would come to believe.

The initial reaction teaches an important lesson. Through the Resurrection, Christ is known to us today. But our knowledge of this event must continually deepen. The disciples came to understand over time. They didn't fully understand until seeing the empty tomb. They didn't comprehend until they saw the risen Lord. But their minds were open only after being given the gift of the Holy Spirit.

The Resurrection was an actual historical event. But it's also an event that transcends time. It's an event that must transform every moment of our lives. When Jesus rose from the dead, it was different than a simple return to life. He didn't come back to the life lived before. Instead, His resurrected state was a new beginning. He was body transformed, and he would now never die again. This resurrected body of our Lord, perfectly united to His divine soul, remains with Him forever.

We now have hope that, sharing in Christ's suffering and death, we'll also share in His Resurrection. But what does that mean? It means our bodies will never age, experience illness and be free from all disorders forever. Our new glorified bodies will demonstrate the ways we loved and served God. For example, Jesus' resurrected body had wounds on His hands, feet, and side. But now those wounds radiate His glory and forever testify to His act of perfect love.

Reflect today on the Resurrection of the Savior of the World. Reflect on His invitation to share in this new life. Our understanding of the Resurrection will only be understood when we share it. We must know and understand that our sharing in the resurrected state of Jesus is beyond imagination. This is what we celebrate today. He is risen!

Amigos,

¡Feliz Pascua! ¡Jesús ha resucitado hoy! Ha vencido la muerte y ha abierto las puertas del Cielo a todos los que creen. ¡Aleluya!

El Evangelio de hoy termina diciendo: "Porque aún no comprendían la Escritura que tenía que resucitar de entre los muertos". Esto es evidente por la reacción inicial de María Magdalena, Pedro y el apóstol Juan. María pensó primero que alguien se había llevado el cuerpo de Jesús. Pedro y Juan estaban confundidos y corrieron a ver. Una vez que vieron la tumba vacía, creyeron. Con el tiempo, todos los Apóstoles llegarían a creer.

La reacción inicial enseña una lección importante. A través de la Resurrección, hoy conocemos a Cristo. Pero nuestro conocimiento de este acontecimiento debe profundizarse continuamente. Los discípulos llegaron a comprender con el tiempo. No lo comprendieron del todo hasta que vieron la tumba vacía. No comprendieron hasta que vieron al Señor resucitado. Pero sus mentes se abrieron sólo después de recibir el don del Espíritu Santo.

La Resurrección fue un acontecimiento histórico real. Pero también es un acontecimiento que trasciende el tiempo. Es un acontecimiento que debe transformar cada momento de nuestras vidas. Cuando Jesús resucitó de entre los muertos, fue diferente a un simple regreso a la vida. No volvió a la vida que había vivido antes. En cambio, Su estado resucitado fue un nuevo comienzo. Su cuerpo fue transformado, y ahora nunca más moriría. Este cuerpo resucitado de nuestro Señor, perfectamente unido a su alma divina, permanece con Él para siempre.

Ahora tenemos la esperanza de que, compartiendo el sufrimiento y la muerte de Cristo, compartiremos también su Resurrección. ¿Qué significa esto? Significa que nuestros cuerpos nunca envejecerán, ni experimentarán enfermedades y estarán libres de todos los trastornos para siempre. Nuestros nuevos cuerpos glorificados demostrarán las formas en que amamos y servimos a Dios. Por ejemplo, el cuerpo resucitado de Jesús tenía heridas en Sus manos, pies y costado. Pero ahora esas heridas irradian Su gloria y dan testimonio para siempre de Su acto de amor perfecto.

Reflexiona hoy sobre la Resurrección del Salvador del Mundo. Reflexiona sobre su invitación a compartir esta nueva vida. Sólo entenderemos la Resurrección cuando la compartimos. Debemos saber y comprender que nuestra participación en el estado resucitado de Jesús va más allá de lo imaginable. Esto es lo que celebramos hoy. ¡Ha resucitado!


