

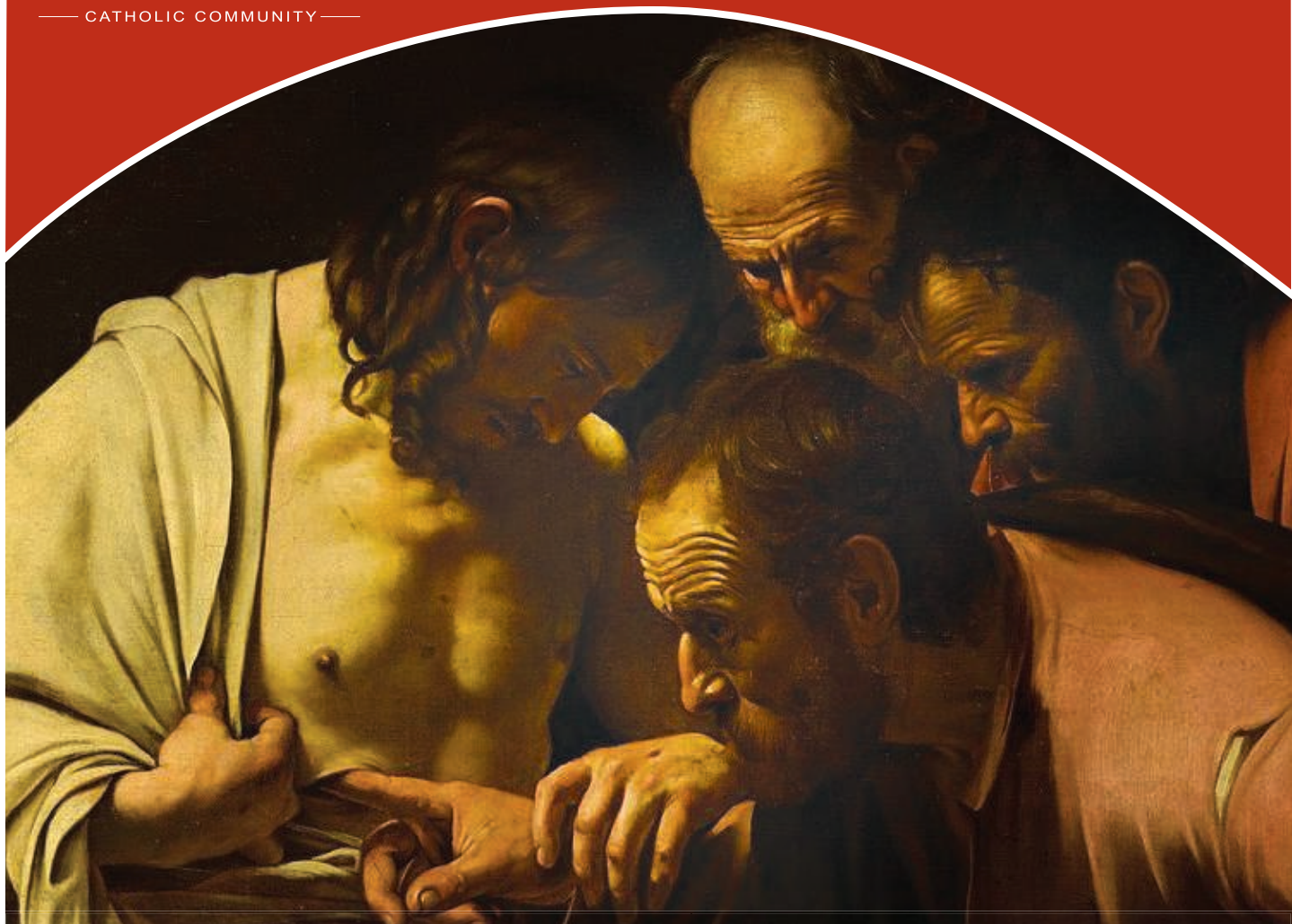

## Welcome to St. Norbert Parish

To register with the parish, visit [www.parish.stnorbert.org](http://www.parish.stnorbert.org) and click the *Register with Us* page under the *About* tab to download the Parish Registration form (English and Spanish). The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

### Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

### Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

### Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation.
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

### Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

### Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. One of our priests will automatically be paged.

### Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

Happy Easter! It is the Feast of Divine Mercy! Today's feast is among the newer feasts in the Church. On April 30, 2000, Saint Pope John Paul II canonized Saint Faustina and inaugurated the Feast of Divine Mercy as a universal feast. Because this Feast is so recent within the Church, we can be sure that we still have much to learn about the message of this Solemnity and the numerous messages about God's mercy revealed in Saint Faustina's Diary.

Among the many messages in her Diary, Jesus revealed that this Sunday, the eighth and final day of the Octave of Easter, is a day like none other. Though grace and mercy are continuously poured out from Heaven upon us, Jesus is clear that today is unique. Today, "a whole ocean of graces" is poured forth on souls approaching the font of His mercy. Sit with that image for a time. "A whole ocean of graces." What does that mean?

Symbolically speaking, a whole ocean is meant to depict the infinite. Imagine what it would be like to have the entire ocean poured on you—it's beyond comprehension! Thus, God is saying that the infinity of grace is given today. The question for us all to ponder is this: How receptive am I to those infinite graces?

Reflect today on this ocean being poured forth on you. How much of this mercy are you able to receive? As you humbly admit your limited openness to God's grace, know that God patiently waits for you. Dwelling in His fullness deep within you, waiting for you to journey to Him. Commit yourself to this journey through prayer, the reading of Scripture, the celebration of the Sacraments, and spiritual reading. There is an ocean of the fullness of life waiting for you. Dive in and allow His mercy to deepen your capacity to fully receive Him.

Christ is risen! He has risen indeed!

¡Feliz Pascua! Es la fiesta de la Divina Misericordia. La de hoy es una de las fiestas más recientes de la Iglesia. El 30 de Abril del 2000, San Juan Pablo II canonizó a Santa Faustina e inauguró la Fiesta de la Divina Misericordia como fiesta universal. Dado que esta fiesta es tan reciente en la Iglesia, podemos estar seguros de que aún nos queda mucho por aprender sobre el mensaje de esta solemnidad y los numerosos mensajes sobre la misericordia de Dios revelados en el Diario de Santa Faustina.

Entre los muchos mensajes de su Diario, Jesús reveló que este Domingo, octavo y último día de la Octava de Pascua, es un día como ningún otro. Aunque la gracia y la misericordia se derraman continuamente desde el Cielo sobre nosotros, Jesús tiene claro que hoy es un día único. Comprométete en este viaje a través de la oración, la lectura de las Escrituras, la celebración de los Sacramentos y la lectura espiritual. Hay un océano de plenitud de vida esperándote. Sumérgete y permite que Su misericordia profundice en tu capacidad de recibirle plenamente.

All St. Norbert parishioners are invited to the Reading Terminal Market on Friday, May 19th to celebrate this special award and remarkable partnership.

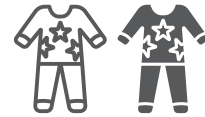

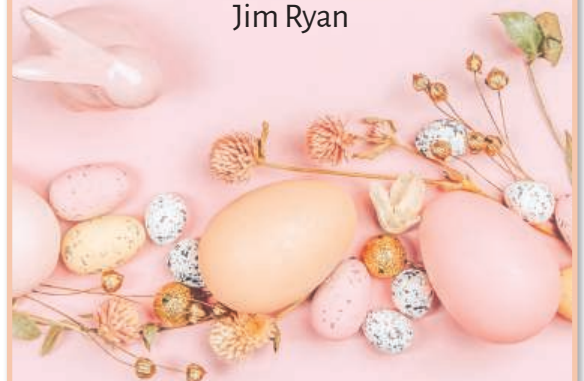

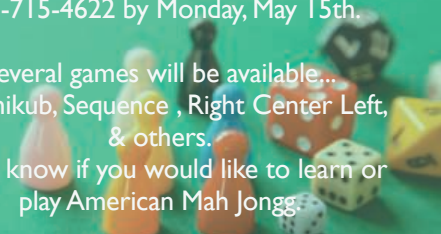
