

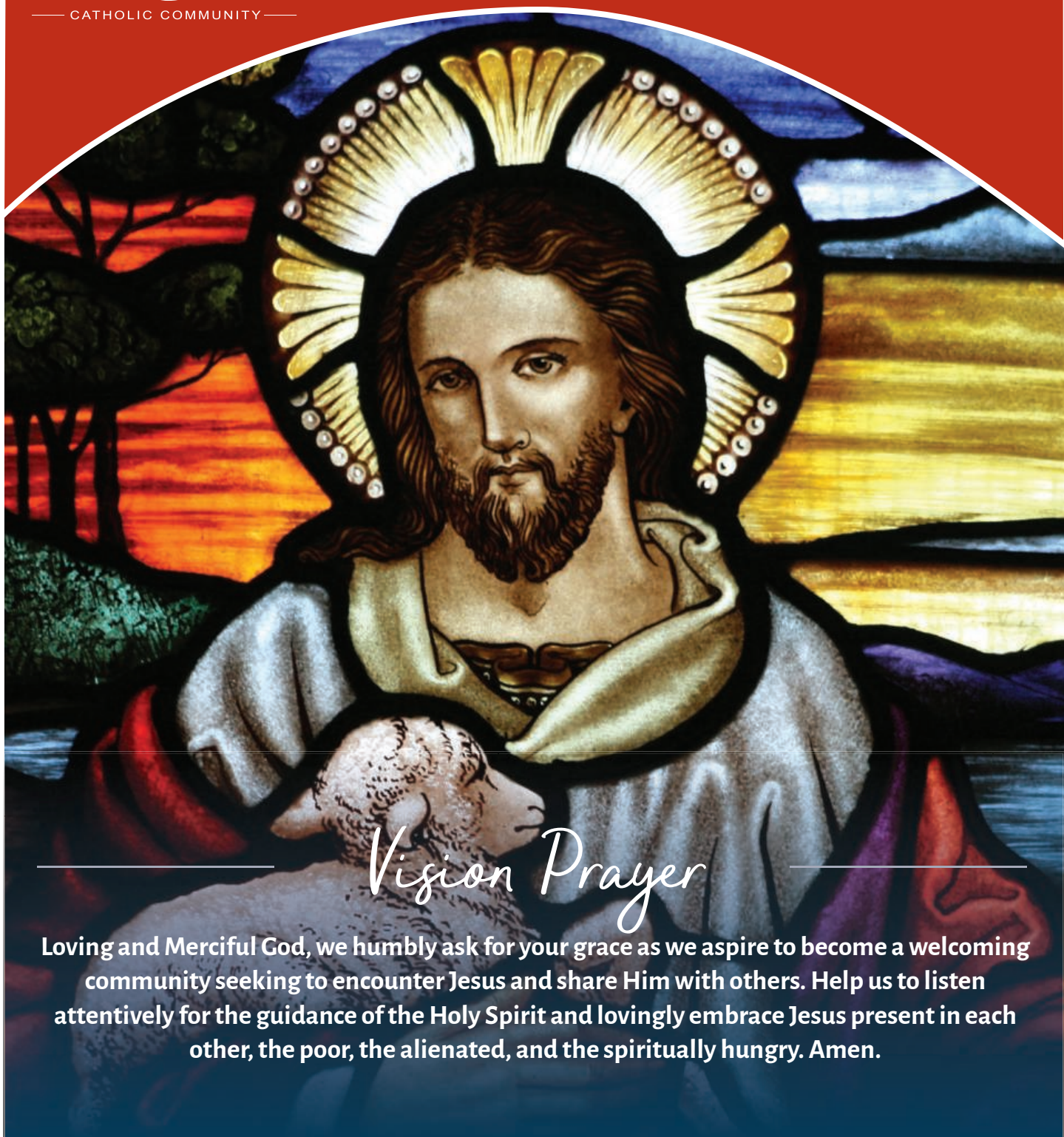

Welcome to St. Norbert Parish

To register with the parish, visit www.parish.stnorbert.org and click the *Register with Us* page under the *About* tab to download the Parish Registration form (English and Spanish). The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation.
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

Three thousand people became followers of Christ in one day due to one sermon given by St. Peter. That's what the Book of Acts records in the First Reading today. After the Apostles received the Holy Spirit in the Upper Room, they went to the Temple to give thanks, and the presence of the Holy Spirit attracted crowds of awestruck people.

In the Temple, Peter stands and addresses them and speaks of Christ. And "they were cut to the heart." These were the same crowds who had rejected Jesus just a few weeks earlier. Hearing the truth about Christ made them want to follow Him. But they didn't know how. And so, they asked, "What are we to do?" Peter explains their need to repent and be baptized. They must give up their self-centered ways, follow Christ's teachings, and receive the sacraments.

We're all so familiar with this scene that we can easily overlook the most important thing. The grace of God didn't reach those three thousand people directly. Instead, it reached, inspired, changed, and renewed their lives through the mediation of the Apostles. Their conversion came through Christ's chosen messengers' preaching, witnessing, and ministry.

Christianity is not just about "me and Jesus." Christianity is about the whole family of Jesus. It is about his Church, through which Jesus has chosen to make himself known and loved by sinners who need His grace. God works through messengers. The Apostles were God's messengers, just as we are today.

"Witness Sunday" returns on the weekend of May 6/7. In the past, these "witnesses" have had a favorable influence on building and maintaining our community of faith. Just as the Apostles brought many to the Lord, I believe "Witness Sunday" can have that same influence. Also, that same weekend will be hospitality weekend. When arriving, please remember to put on a name tag. It's a great way to get to know each better.

Amigos,

Tres mil personas se convirtieron en seguidores de Cristo en un solo día gracias a un sermón de San Pedro. Eso es lo que recoge el Libro de los Hechos en la Primera Lectura de hoy. Después de que los Apóstoles recibieran el Espíritu Santo en el Cenáculo, fueron al Templo a dar gracias, y la presencia del Espíritu Santo atrajo a multitudes de personas asombradas.

En el Templo, Pedro, de pie, se dirige a ellos y les habla de Cristo. Y "se les partió el corazón". Eran las mismas multitudes que habían rechazado a Jesús apenas unas semanas antes. Escuchar la verdad sobre Cristo les hizo querer seguirle, pero no sabían cómo. Por eso se preguntaban: "¿Qué debemos hacer?". Pedro les explica que deben arrepentirse y bautizarse. Deben abandonar su egocentrismo, seguir las enseñanzas de Cristo y recibir los sacramentos.

Todos estamos tan familiarizados con esta escena que fácilmente podemos pasar por alto lo más importante. La gracia de Dios no llegó directamente a aquellas tres mil personas. Al contrario, alcanzó, inspiró, cambió y renovó sus vidas a través de la mediación de los Apóstoles. Su conversión se produjo a través de la predicación, el testimonio y el ministerio de los mensajeros elegidos por Cristo.

El cristianismo no se trata solamente de "Jesús y yo". El cristianismo trata a toda la familia de Jesús. Se trata de su Iglesia, a través de la cual Jesús ha elegido darse a conocer y hacerse amar por los pecadores que necesitan su gracia. Dios actúa a través de mensajeros. Los Apóstoles fueron mensajeros de Dios, como lo somos nosotros hoy.

El "Domingo de los testigos" vuelve el fin de semana del 6/7 de mayo. En el pasado, estos "testigos" han tenido una influencia favorable en la construcción y el mantenimiento de nuestra comunidad de fe. Al igual que los Apóstoles guiaron muchos hacia el Señor. Creo que el "Domingo de los Testigos" puede tener esa misma influencia. Además, ese mismo fin de semana será el de la hospitalidad. Cuando lleguen, por favor, recuerden ponerse una etiqueta con su nombre. Es una buena manera de conocernos mejor.


