

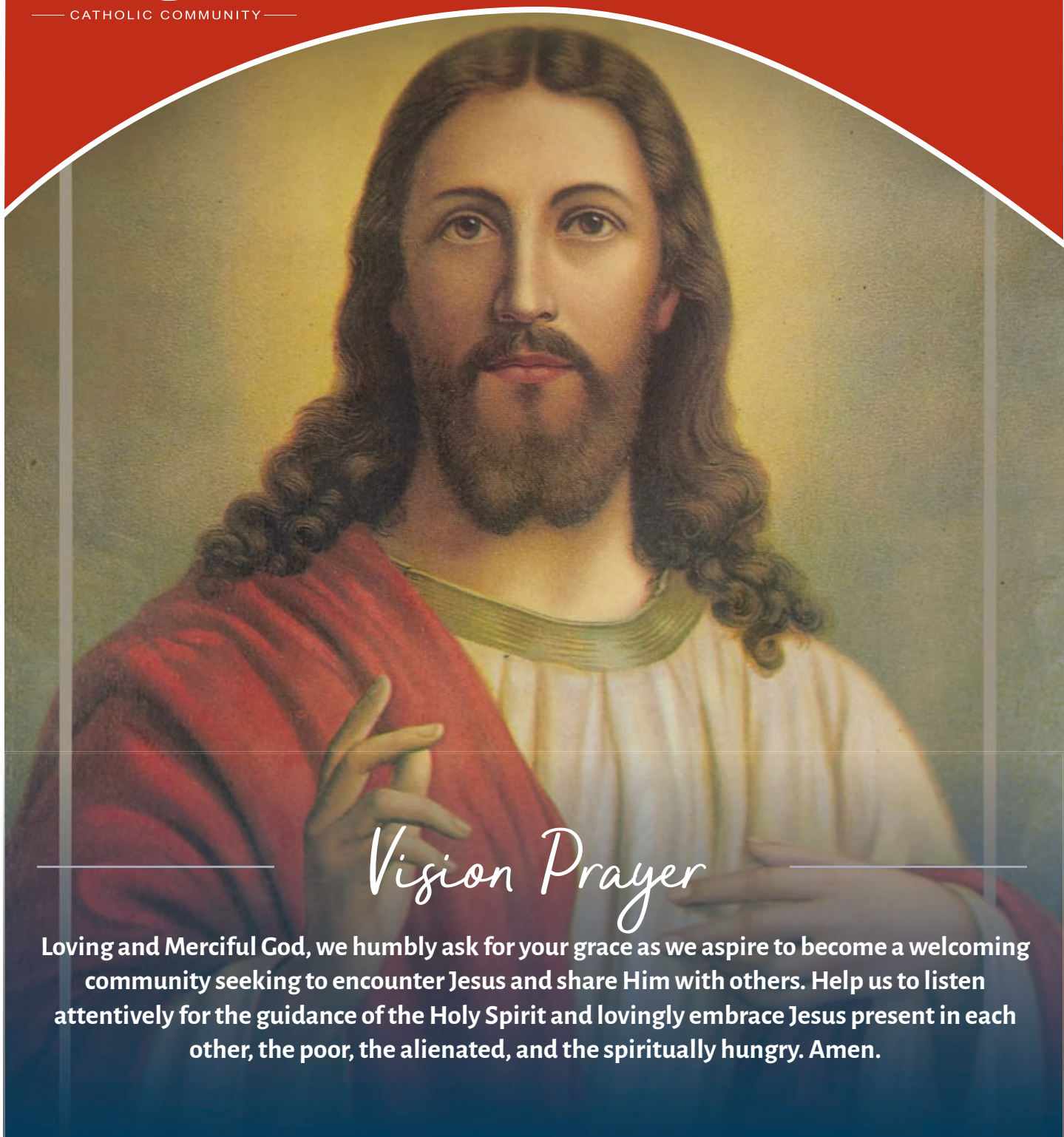

Welcome to St. Norbert Parish

To register with the parish, visit www.parish.stnorbert.org and click the *Register with Us* page under the *About* tab to download the Parish Registration form (English and Spanish). The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation.
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

In today's First Reading, we glimpse life in the first "parish" - in Jerusalem, soon after the Resurrection. Three characteristics stand out, which can help us reflect on our Christian identity even today.

First, the community of believers is steadily growing. The Church is a living body of believers in Christ meant to grow. If a community of Christians isn't growing, something is wrong; ours is a missionary religion. Christ sent his Apostles to preach his Word to all people; the Church is meant to spread into every corner of time and space.

Second, there is a clear structure of authority in the Church community. The Twelve Apostles are its leaders, as Jesus intended, and they solve the new problem that arises by ordaining the first Deacons. Today, every Catholic community is organized with the same hierarchical structure.

First is the pope, the successor St Peter, leader of the Twelve Apostles. Then there is the local bishop, the successor of those Apostles. Then there is the parish pastor, the bishop's representative for a specific area. None of them govern by their own authority. Instead, they receive their authority from Christ through the sacrament of holy orders. By obeying them, in matters of faith and morals, Christians are obeying Christ himself.

Finally, even at the very beginning of the Church, we see disagreements among believers. This is the point I would like to focus on today.

Our faith in Christ doesn't make us perfect right away, just as it didn't make the first Christians perfect right away. Spiritual growth is a life-long process. The first Christians had to work through conflicts and selfish tendencies. It is the same today.

At St. Norbert's, our community continually seeks to grow. This weekend we'll have nearly 60 children receive their First Holy Communion. It is also a hospitality weekend hosted by the American Heritage Girls. This is a great chance to meet other community members after all the Masses. We'll also restart "Witness Sunday" at this weekend's Masses. Why not invite a friend or family member who has been away from Church? May we all be "witnesses" and help grow Christ's Church.

Amigos,

En la primera lectura de hoy, vislumbramos la vida en la primera "parroquia" en Jerusalén, poco después de la Resurrección. Hay tres características que se destacan y que hoy también pueden ayudarnos a reflexionar sobre nuestra identidad cristiana.

En primer lugar, la comunidad de creyentes crece sin cesar. La Iglesia es un cuerpo vivo de creyentes en Cristo destinado a crecer. Si una comunidad de cristianos no crece, algo está mal; la nuestra es una religión misionera. Cristo envió a sus Apóstoles a predicar su Palabra a todos los pueblos; la Iglesia está destinada a extenderse por todos los rincones del tiempo y del espacio.

En segundo lugar, existe una clara estructura de autoridad en la comunidad eclesial. Los Doce Apóstoles son sus líderes, como Jesús quería, y resuelven el nuevo problema que surge al ordenar a los primeros Diáconos. Hoy en día, toda comunidad católica está organizada con la misma estructura jerárquica.

Primero está el Papa, el sucesor de San Pedro, líder de los Doce Apóstoles. Luego está el obispo local, sucesor de esos Apóstoles. Luego está el párroco, representante del obispo para una zona específica. Ninguno de ellos gobierna por su propia autoridad. Al contrario, reciben su autoridad de Cristo a través del sacramento de la Ordenación. Obedeciéndoles, en materia de fe y de moral, los cristianos obedecen a Cristo mismo.

Por último, incluso en los comienzos de la Iglesia, vemos desacuerdos entre los creyentes. Este es el punto en el que me gustaría centrarme hoy.

Nuestra fe en Cristo no nos hace perfectos de inmediato, como tampoco hizo perfectos de inmediato a los primeros cristianos. El crecimiento espiritual es un proceso que dura toda la vida. Los primeros cristianos tuvieron que superar conflictos y tendencias egoístas. Lo mismo ocurre hoy.

En San Norberto, nuestra comunidad busca crecer continuamente. Este fin de semana casi 60 niños recibirán la Primera Comunión. También es un fin de semana de hospitalidad organizado por las American Heritage Girls. Esta es una gran oportunidad para conocer a otros miembros de la comunidad después de todas las misas. También reiniciaremos el "Domingo de Testigos" en las misas de este fin de semana. ¿Por qué no invitar a un amigo o familiar que ha estado alejado de la Iglesia? Que todos seamos "testigos" y ayudemos a crecer a la Iglesia de Cristo.

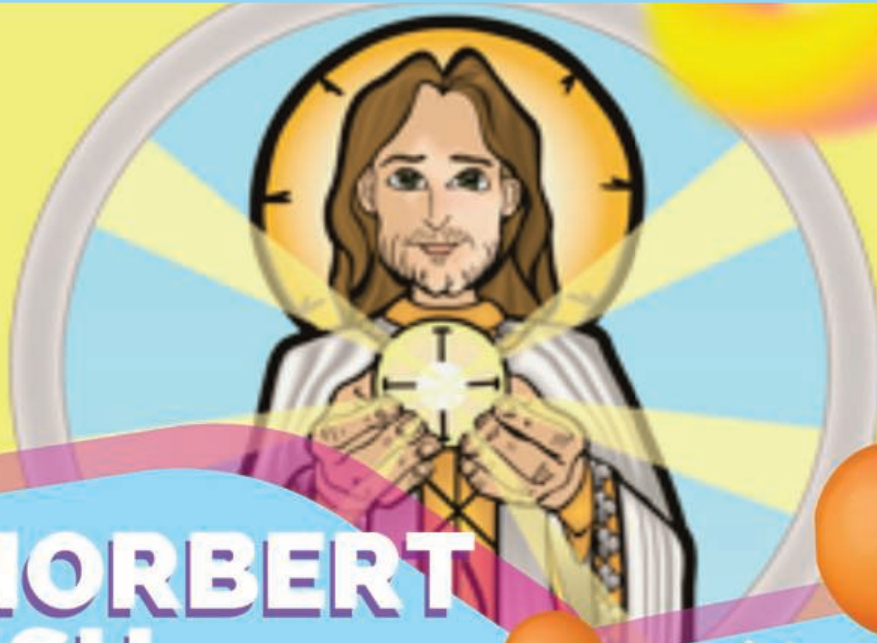
