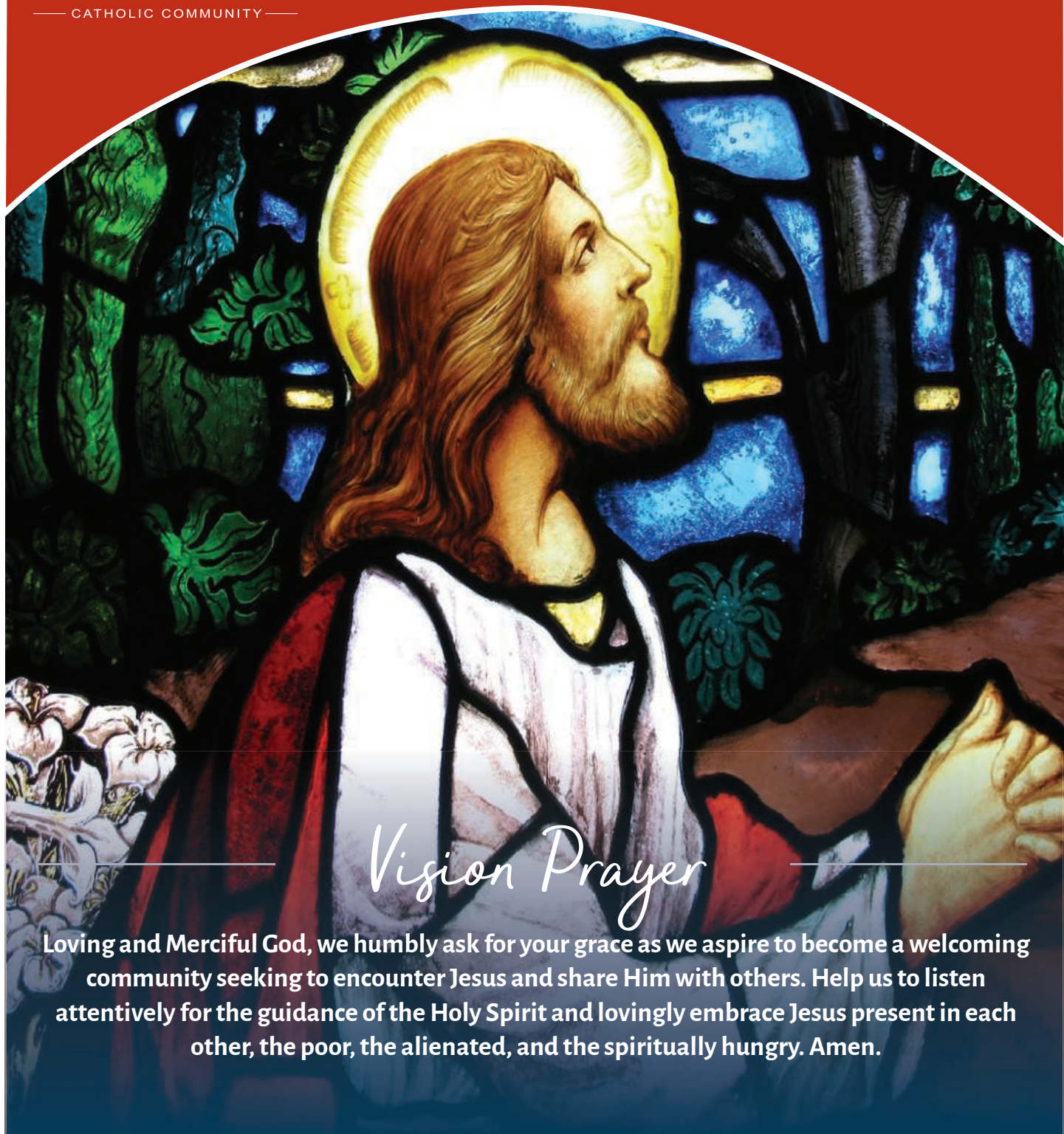

## Welcome to St. Norbert Parish

To register with the parish, visit [www.parish.stnorbert.org](http://www.parish.stnorbert.org) and click the *Register with Us* page under the *About* tab to download the Parish Registration form (English and Spanish). The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

### Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

### Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

### Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation.
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

### Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

### Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

### Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

In the Gospel, Jesus prays for all who would believe in Him. In His prayer, Jesus prayed for you and me. This High Priestly Prayer continues today through the celebration of the Holy Mass.

Think of Jesus, who just celebrated the Last Supper with His disciples. He prepared to offer His life on the Cross for the world's salvation. Within this context, Jesus prays this prayer. It's a prayer perpetuated by our Lord every time we celebrate the Holy Eucharist.

Jesus set an example for us on how to deal with the troubles encountered in life. But first, we must turn our eyes to Heaven and pray to the Father. Then, our full interior participation in the Holy Mass is the best way. What form of "trouble" do you experience right now in your life? Recall your struggles, and imagine Jesus kneeling next to you, praying this prayer to the Father for you.

This is what Jesus does each time we participate in the Holy Mass. The Mass is the perfect offering to the Father. It's the one and only source of all grace in our lives. Jesus glorifies the Father and invites us to share in it by uniting ourselves to Him. Through this perfect Sacrifice, Jesus bestows "eternal life" on us all.

Today, let's reflect on how we celebrate the Mass. When you attend, do you become distracted or inattentive to what occurs? The Mass is your hour each week in which you kneel next to Jesus as He kneels next to you, praying to the Father in Heaven. The power of the Mass is infinite. In the Mass, all the grace needed is given to you. You're invited to share in the glory of the Son of God. Think about your participation in the Mass and renew your commitment to pray it with our Lord.

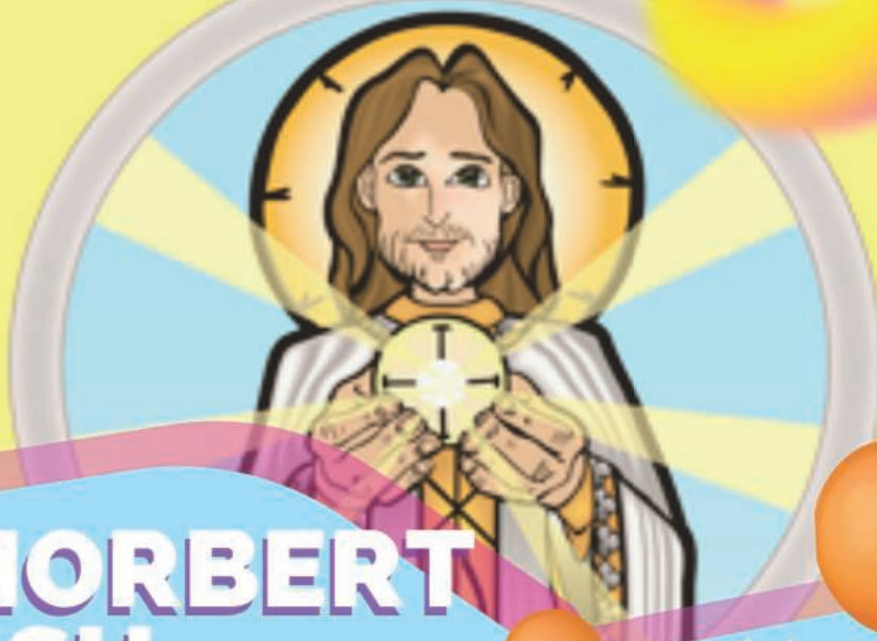

## ST. NORBERT PARISH COUNCIL NOMINATIONS

THE ANNUAL ELECTION OF NEW MEMBERS FOR THE PARISH  
PASTORAL COUNCIL (PPC) WILL BE HELD  
THE WEEKEND OF MAY 20 & 21

*Members of the PPC are selected according to a process defined by the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. The council is made up of nine elected and appointed members, along with three ex-officio council members comprised of parish staff. The composition of the PPC is meant to reflect the diversity of the parish community. The pastor presides over PPC meetings.*

### ELECTIONS

Each spring, parishioners are invited to nominate individuals to run for election to the PPC. Biographies of nominees are published prior to the election. This year six parishioners have been nominated for four openings.

Voting will be held in person at all the masses the weekend of May 20th and 21st.

### YOUR REPRESENTATIVES

Parish Councils serve as a consultative body that advises and assists the Pastor in areas of pastoral concern with the task of carrying out the mission of the Church. The PPC encourages all parishioners to participate fully in the life and mission of the Church at St. Norbert. Parishioners are always welcome to contact a council member to bring forward "a view from the pew" at monthly meetings.
