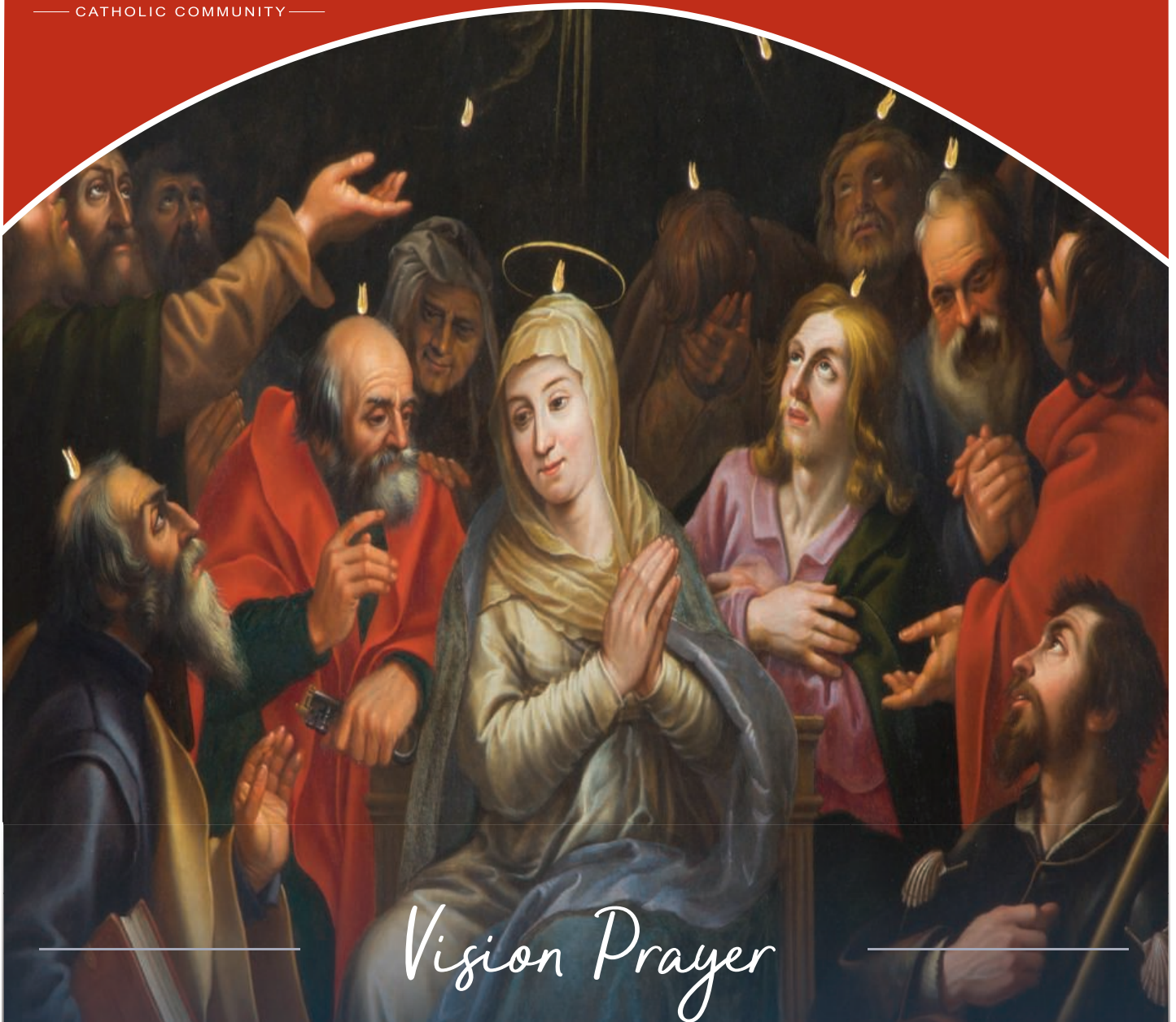

Welcome to St. Norbert Parish

To register with the parish, visit www.parish.stnorbert.org and click the *Register with Us* page under the *About* tab to download the Parish Registration form (English and Spanish). The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation.
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

Today the Easter season concludes with Pentecost Sunday, commemorating that day in the budding Church when the Father and the Son poured out the Holy Spirit in a special way on the Apostles. Then they took up the mission of proclaiming the Gospel throughout the world.

The Holy Spirit, throughout Church history, has showered down gifts upon her to keep her faithful to the teaching she's received from Our Lord. And to keep the fires burning to inspire hearts to turn and be reconciled with God and each other.

The Church teaches us that there are 7 gifts of the Holy Spirit. These gifts prepare us to receive the Holy Spirit's inspiration in our hearts.

- Wisdom gives us a "taste" for the things of God. We experience delight in what is right.
- Understanding is the gift that gives us a more profound sense of the meaning of Church teachings.
- Knowledge enables us to judge everything by the light of heaven.
- Counsel helps us speak the words that draw others closer to God.
- Fortitude gives us the strength to keep loving and being faithful to God and our calling when things get tough.
- Piety gives us reverence for God and towards each human person.
- Fear of the Lord helps us avoid sin because we love God and don't want to offend him.

St John Paul II said that he used to ask the Holy Spirit daily to give him these gifts in greater abundance. So, if he needed to do that, perhaps we should try it too. My challenge to you is to learn these gifts of the Holy Spirit (you can find the list on the internet or in the Catholic Church's Catechism) and pray for them each day this week. When doing that, we're opening the door to that new life the Holy Spirit brings.

The results of the Parish Pastoral Council election were not available in time for the May 19th publishing deadline for this bulletin. Therefore, the results of the election will be reported in the Sunday, June 4th bulletin. Thank you to the nominees for their willingness to serve and the parish community for voting.

2024 Mass Intentions Book

In order to give the opportunity for all parishioners to schedule a Mass Intention for their loved ones and to accommodate recently deceased individuals, the 2024 Mass Intention book for January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024 will be opened on Tuesday, June 13, 2023 and Wednesday, June 14, 2023 for in-person requests.

Announced Mass Intentions for 2024 will be accepted in-person in the Church Oratory on Tuesday, June 13th and Wednesday, June 14th from 9:30 am to 1:00 pm.

A maximum of five (5) Announced Intentions may be scheduled with no more than two (2) Intentions scheduled for a weekend Mass per year from any one requestor. In the interest of fairness, Mass Intentions requested on Tuesday, June 13th and Wednesday, June 14th must be made "in person" in the Church Oratory (not by telephone/ email). Requests will be honored on a first-come, first serve basis.

After the initial June 13th and June 14th opening of the 2024 Mass Intention Book, Announced Mass Intention requests will be accepted in the Parish Office, Monday through Friday during regular business hours (9:00 am – 1:00 pm). Again, a maximum of five (5) Announced Intentions may be scheduled with no more than two (2) Intentions scheduled for a weekend Mass per year from any one requestor.

A \$10 stipend, as determined by diocesan policy, is to accompany each Mass Intention request. Intentions will not be recorded until the stipend is received. Canon Law requires all stipends taken for Mass Intentions be said for the intention as designated.

Announced Mass Intention requests will be granted as close to the requested date and time as possible. If it is not possible to comply with the primary request, the next closest date and time will be scheduled. **Please have an alternate date chosen in the event that your first choice is not available.**

Please note: Mass Intentions may be requested for Sundays, most holidays, and weekdays throughout the year. Mass Intentions will not be accepted for the following dates: All Souls Day (November 2nd), Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil, Easter Sunday, Mother's Day (11:30 am mass), and Father's Day (11:30 am mass).

Announced Mass Intentions will be published in the Sunday Bulletin. The Mass Intention will also be announced during Mass. If requested, a Mass Card will be provided acknowledging your spiritual gift.

Summer Schedule Changes

This Memorial Day, let us pray in a particular way for all who died for our freedom so we could worship without fear. We also honor and pray for the safety of all the children and grandchildren of St. Norbert Parish who are currently serving in the U.S. Military.


