

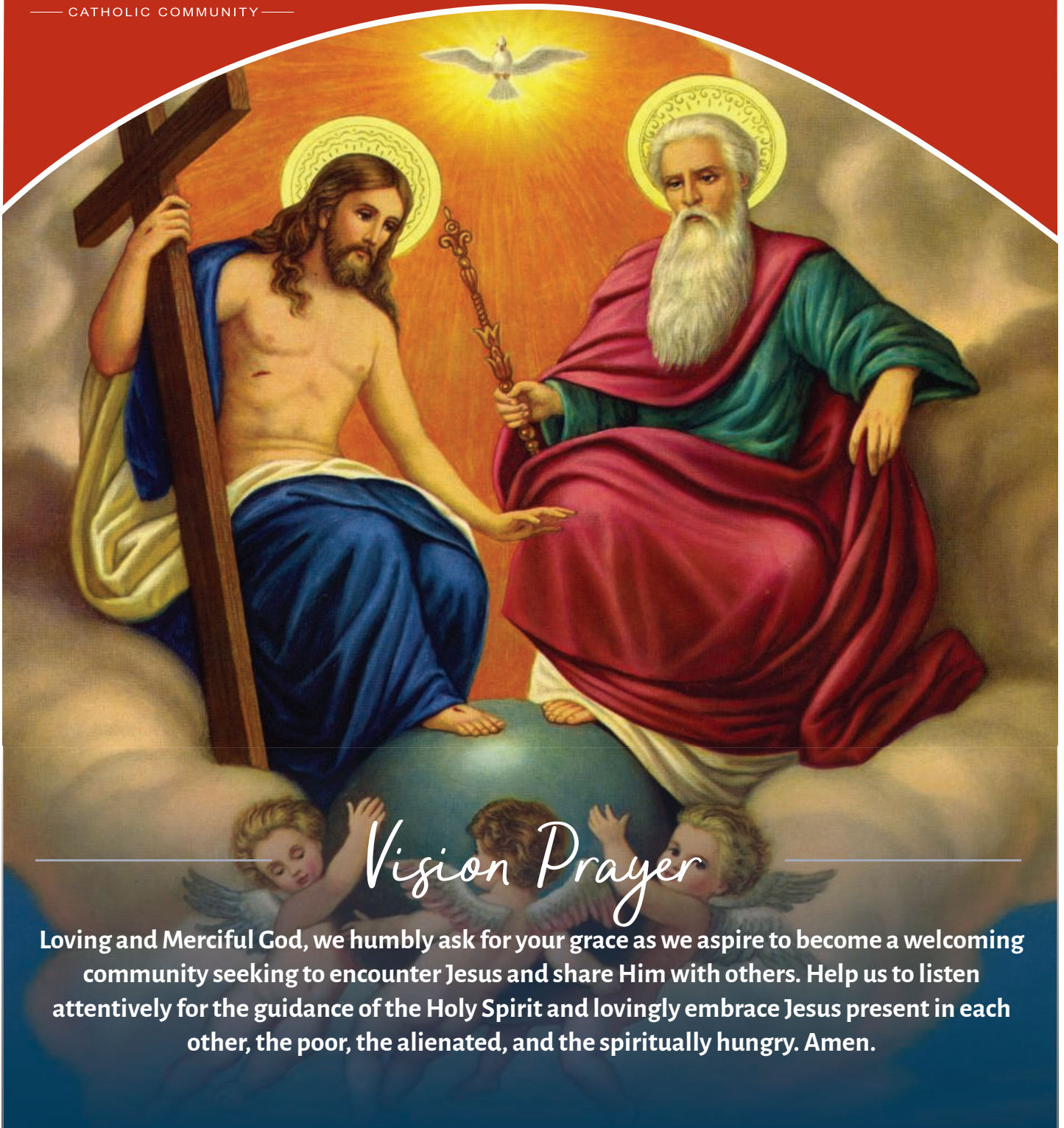

Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Pope Benedict XVI's first encyclical was entitled "God Is Love." It's something we've all heard before. In fact, maybe we've become so used to it that we don't remember how revolutionary and unique that concept of God really is.

There are many religions in the world, and many of them have come to understand that God is good. But almost all of them start with man's search for God. And because human nature is limited, that search can only arrive at a limited view. Christianity is different. Christianity is about God's search for man.

- Jesus Christ came to earth to rescue the fallen human race from evil.
- And so, in Christianity, we have the privilege of receiving God's own revelation of himself. He shows us, in Christ, who he is and what he's like.
- And his most fundamental and essential characteristic is love.
- Not power or knowledge, but love.
- This explains why Jesus came to earth first: "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but have eternal life."

And this also explains what the Holy Trinity is all about.

- If God were solitary, how could his nature be love?
- Love always means relationship and self-giving.
- God can only be loved if he is one and three: three divine persons, each fully divine, living from all eternity in an unbreakable unity of mutual love.

God is love. In other words, God is one, as the Catechism puts it, but not solitary. This mysterious and wonderful doctrine about God that he is both unity and trinity is called by the Catechism "the central mystery of Christian faith and life." Everything in Christianity depends on this mystery, which we can begin to understand in this life because God has chosen to reveal it to us.

As we come to graduation season, I ask you to pray for our soon-to-be graduates of SNS. I'm so proud of Mrs. Hennessy, her administrative staff, and teachers. They have worked diligently to nurture and develop these students in mind, body, and soul. As these young men and women enter their next chapter of development, let's fervently pray for them.

Amigos,

La primera encíclica del Papa Benedicto XVI se titulaba "Dios es amor". Es algo que todos hemos oído antes. De hecho, quizá nos hemos acostumbrado tanto a ello que no recordamos lo revolucionario y único que es realmente ese concepto de Dios.

- El amor siempre significa relación y entrega.
- Dios solo puede ser amado si es uno y tres: tres personas divinas, cada una plenamente divina, que viven desde toda la eternidad en una unidad inquebrantable de amor mutuo.

Dios es amor. En otras palabras, Dios es uno, como dice el Catecismo, pero no solitario. Esta doctrina misteriosa y maravillosa sobre Dios, que es a la vez unidad y trinidad, es llamada por el Catecismo "el misterio central de la fe y de la vida cristiana". Todo en el cristianismo depende de este misterio, que podemos empezar a comprender en esta vida, porque Dios ha elegido revelárnoslo.

Mientras nos acercamos a la época de graduación les pido que recen por nuestros futuros graduandos del Colegio de San Norberto. Estoy muy orgulloso de la Sra. Hennessy, su personal administrativo y maestros. Ellos han trabajado diligentemente para cultivar y desarrollar a estos estudiantes en mente, cuerpo y alma. Así como estos jóvenes entran en su próximo capítulo de desarrollo, vamos a orar fervientemente por ellos.

2024 Mass Intentions Book

In order to give the opportunity for all parishioners to schedule a Mass Intention for their loved ones and to accommodate recently deceased individuals, the 2024 Mass Intention book for January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024 will be opened on Tuesday, June 13, 2023 and Wednesday, June 14, 2023 for in-person requests.

Announced Mass Intentions for 2024 will be accepted in-person in the Church Oratory on Tuesday, June 13th and Wednesday, June 14th from 9:30 am to 1:00 pm.

A maximum of five (5) Announced Intentions may be scheduled with no more than two (2) Intentions scheduled for a weekend Mass per year from any one requestor. In the interest of fairness, Mass Intentions requested on Tuesday, June 13th and Wednesday, June 14th must be made "in person" in the Church Oratory (not by telephone/ email). Requests will be honored on a first-come, first serve basis.

After the initial June 13th and June 14th opening of the 2024 Mass Intention Book, Announced Mass Intention requests will be accepted in the Parish Office, Monday through Friday during regular business hours (9:00 am – 1:00 pm). Again, a maximum of five (5) Announced Intentions may be scheduled with no more than two (2) Intentions scheduled for a weekend Mass per year from any one requestor.

A \$10 stipend, as determined by diocesan policy, is to accompany each Mass Intention request. Intentions will not be recorded until the stipend is received. Canon Law requires all stipends taken for Mass Intentions be said for the intention as designated.

Announced Mass Intention requests will be granted as close to the requested date and time as possible. If it is not possible to comply with the primary request, the next closest date and time will be scheduled. **Please have an alternate date chosen in the event that your first choice is not available.**

Please note: Mass Intentions may be requested for Sundays, most holidays, and weekdays throughout the year. Mass Intentions will not be accepted for the following dates: All Souls Day (November 2nd), Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil, Easter Sunday, Mother's Day (11:30 am mass), and Father's Day (11:30 am mass).

Announced Mass Intentions will be published in the Sunday Bulletin. The Mass Intention will also be announced during Mass. If requested, a Mass Card will be provided acknowledging your spiritual gift.

When Russia invaded Ukraine in February 2022, a humanitarian crisis began for Ukrainians, whose lives were shattered by the violence of war. Many left their homes in eastern cities in Ukraine for cities in the west, such as Lviv, farther from the most intense fighting. From the beginning of the war, the Holy Father pleaded for an end to the violence and expressed his love and concern for the Ukrainian people who were its victims. In solidarity with the victims of war, the papal almoner, Cardinal Konrad Krajewski, made two visits to Ukraine in March 2022. He first visited the cities of Rivne and Zhovka and other regions directly affected by the early conflict. He returned to Ukraine to celebrate Mass in the cathedral in Lviv and to deliver an ambulance donated by the Holy Father to the Center for Mother and Child Health to assist children displaced by the war.

The Holy Father's charitable outreach to victims of war, migrants and refugees, and the poor affected by illness and natural disasters is supported by contributions to the Peter's Pence Collection.
