## Welcome to St. Norbert Parish

### Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

### Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

### Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

### Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

### Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

### Prayer & Healing Ministry

Do you enjoy a good mystery? When we say that something is a mystery, sometimes we mean that the conclusion is hidden, but there are clues to help solve it. And once the mystery is solved, everything is clear and no longer a mystery.

At Mass, as the priest pronounces the words of the consecration, transforming the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Jesus, he genuflects, rises, and then says, “The mystery of faith.”

This “mystery of faith” is different. Those words spoken immediately after the consecration should draw us into holy amazement. No amount of earthly investigation can solve this mystery. It can only be understood through the gift of faith. Faith is knowing and believing without perceiving reality. Faith produces knowledge of a spiritual truth that can only be understood and believed through spiritual insight.

Once the consecration occurs, we cry interiorly, “My Lord and my God!” We’ll know that God the Son is present before us in a veiled way. Our eyes don’t perceive, nor do our senses reveal the great reality before us. We come to know and believe that the Son of God, the Savior of the World, is now present before us under the veil of bread and wine.

The entire Mystery of our Redemption is made present. Do you sense and experience this amazing reality at each Mass? Do you realize that as the words of consecration are spoken, the entire Mystery of redemption is present? Understanding that God the Second Person of the Holy Trinity descends to us?

Reflect today on the hidden but real “Mystery of Faith.” Allow yourself to be drawn into wonder and awe at what you are privileged to attend. Let your faith in the Most Holy Eucharist grow by being open to deepening this gift of faith through spiritual insight and belief. Behold this great Gift of the Eucharist with the eyes of faith, and you will be drawn into the wonder and awe that God wants to bestow upon you.

¿Disfrutas de un buen misterio? Cuando decimos que algo es un misterio, a veces nos referimos a que la conclusión está oculta, pero hay pistas que ayudan a resolverlo. Y una vez resuelto el misterio, todo queda claro y deja de ser un misterio.

En la Misa, cuando el sacerdote pronuncia las palabras de la consagración, transformando el pan y el vino en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús, hace una genuflexión, se levanta y dice: "El misterio de la fe".

Este "misterio de la fe" es diferente. Esas palabras pronunciadas inmediatamente después de la consagración deberían llevarnos a un santo asombro. Ninguna investigación terrenal puede resolver este misterio. Sólo puede ser comprendido mediante el don de la fe. La fe es saber y creer sin percibir la realidad. La fe produce el conocimiento de una verdad espiritual que sólo puede ser comprendida y creída a través de la perspicacia espiritual.

Cuando estamos dotados del conocimiento de la fe. Una vez que se produce la consagración, gritamos interiormente: "¡Señor mío y Dios mío!". Sabremos que Dios Hijo está presente ante nosotros de forma velada. Nuestros ojos no perciben, ni nuestros sentidos revelan la gran realidad que tenemos ante nosotros. Llegamos a saber y a creer que el Hijo de Dios, el Salvador del Mundo, está ahora presente ante nosotros bajo el velo del pan y del vino.

Todo el Misterio de nuestra Redención se hace presente. ¿Sientes y experimentas esta asombrosa realidad en cada Misa? ¿Te das cuenta de que, al pronunciar las palabras de la consagración, se hace presente todo el Misterio de la Redención? ¿Comprendes que Dios, Segunda Persona de la Santísima Trinidad, desciende hasta nosotros?

Reflexiona hoy sobre el oculto pero real "Misterio de la Fe". Déjate arrastrar por el asombro y la admiración ante lo que tienes el privilegio de presenciar. Deja que tu fe crezca en la Santísima Eucaristía estando abierto a profundizar en este don de la fe a través de la perspicacia espiritual y la creencia. Contempla este gran don de la Eucaristía con los ojos de la fe, y te sentirás atraído por la maravilla y el asombro que Dios quiere concederte.

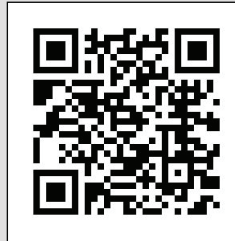

## 2024 Mass Intentions Book

In order to give the opportunity for all parishioners to schedule a Mass Intention for their loved ones and to accommodate recently deceased individuals, the 2024 Mass Intention book for January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024 will be opened on Tuesday, June 13, 2023 and Wednesday, June 14, 2023 for in-person requests.

**Announced Mass Intentions for 2024 will be accepted in-person in the Church Oratory on Tuesday, June 13th and Wednesday, June 14th from 9:30 am to 1:00 pm.**

**A maximum of five (5) Announced Intentions may be scheduled with no more than two (2) Intentions scheduled for a weekend Mass per year from any one requestor.** In the interest of fairness, Mass Intentions requested on Tuesday, June 13th and Wednesday, June 14th must be made "in person" in the Church Oratory (not by telephone/ email). Requests will be honored on a first-come, first serve basis.

After the initial June 13th and June 14th opening of the 2024 Mass Intention Book, Announced Mass Intention requests will be accepted in the Parish Office, Monday through Friday during regular business hours (9:00 am – 1:00 pm). Again, a maximum of five (5) Announced Intentions may be scheduled with no more than two (2) Intentions scheduled for a weekend Mass per year from any one requestor.

A \$10 stipend, as determined by diocesan policy, is to accompany each Mass Intention request. Intentions will not be recorded until the stipend is received. Canon Law requires all stipends taken for Mass Intentions be said for the intention as designated.

Announced Mass Intention requests will be granted as close to the requested date and time as possible. If it is not possible to comply with the primary request, the next closest date and time will be scheduled. **Please have an alternate date chosen in the event that your first choice is not available.**

Please note: Mass Intentions may be requested for Sundays, most holidays, and weekdays throughout the year. Mass Intentions will not be accepted for the following dates: All Souls Day (November 2nd), Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil, Easter Sunday, Mother's Day (11:30 am mass), and Father's Day (11:30 am mass).

Announced Mass Intentions will be published in the Sunday Bulletin. The Mass Intention will also be announced during Mass. If requested, a Mass Card will be provided acknowledging your spiritual gift.

Please refer to the email communication sent by Mr. Griswold to all CaFFE and school families with additional information about Confirmation and related activities.

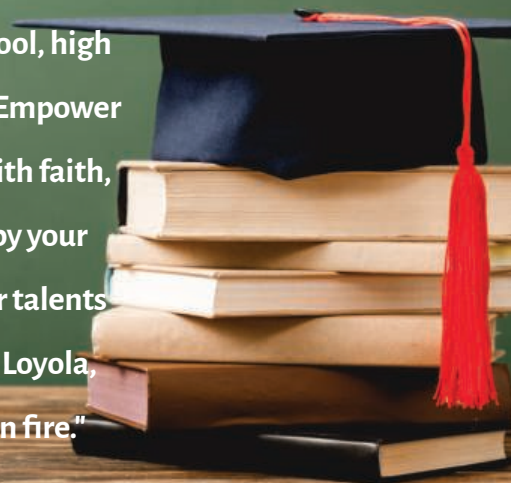
## Religious Education/ CaFFE 2023- 24 Registration

**W**hen Russia invaded Ukraine in February 2022, a humanitarian crisis began for Ukrainians, whose lives were shattered by the violence of war. Many left their homes in eastern cities in Ukraine for cities in the west, such as Lviv, farther from the most intense fighting. He first visited the cities of Rivne and Zhovka and other regions directly affected by the early conflict. He returned to Ukraine to celebrate Mass in the cathedral in Lviv and to deliver an ambulance donated by the Holy Father to the Center for Mother and Child Health to assist children displaced by the war.

The Holy Father's charitable outreach to victims of war, migrants and refugees, and the poor affected by illness and natural disasters is supported by contributions to the Peter's Pence Collection. When you participate in the collection, you join Catholics across the globe in supporting the pope's mission of mercy as well as the activities of the Holy See's dicasteries that assist his ministry.
