Welcome to St. Norbert Parish

To register with the parish, visit www.parish.stnorbert.org and click the *Register with Us* page under the *About* tab to download the Parish Registration form (English and Spanish). The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

Today's Gospel begins by revealing the Heart of Jesus. A heart that is "moved with pity." As Jesus looked at the crowds, he saw they were "troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd." The sight of them evoked compassion and mercy from within Him. This is a beautiful image to prayerfully ponder.

Jesus looks at you as He gazed at the crowds long ago. Sometimes, when thinking of God, we may have inaccurate perceptions of who He is and how He sees us. If you don't regularly see the compassionate Heart of Jesus, ponder this passage, and know that His Heart of love for you is the same as it was for the crowds.

The second part of the passage reveals to us one of the ways that Jesus reaches out to us. He is the "master of the harvest," calling us. The Gospel says that Jesus immediately "summoned his twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits to drive them out and to cure every disease and illness."

As you look at your life, your struggles, spiritual needs, and desire to grow in faith, how has God fed you? Through whom has He spoken to you? Christ's shepherding occurs through participation in the Mass, the Sacrament of Confession, the written word, the inspired witness of another, and many other ways. What's helpful to think about is that any time you have encountered the grace of God through another, it happened because the Master of the Harvest chose to send a laborer to you.

Reflect on the image of Jesus gazing at you with love. And choosing to send His ministers to you. Pay special attention to how God has been speaking to you recently. If it's through a particular book, keep reading it. If it's through a specific preacher of the Gospel, keep listening. If it's through a certain conversation with a friend, spouse, or loved one, keep talking. God loves you and continues to reach out in different ways, especially by sending others in His name.

Amigos,

El Evangelio de hoy comienza revelando el Corazón de Jesús. Un corazón "compadecido". Al mirar a las multitudes, Jesús vio que estaban "angustiadas y abandonadas, como ovejas sin pastor". La visión de ellos evocó compasión y misericordia desde su interior. Es una bella imagen para meditar en oración.

Jesús te mira como miró a las multitudes hace mucho tiempo. A veces, cuando pensamos en Dios, podemos tener percepciones inexactas de quién es Él y de cómo nos ve. Si no ves con regularidad el Corazón compasivo de Jesús, reflexiona sobre este pasaje, y sepan que Su Corazón de amor por ti es el mismo que era para las multitudes.

La segunda parte del pasaje nos revela una de las maneras en que Jesús nos tiende la mano. Él es el "dueño de la cosecha", que nos llama. El Evangelio dice que Jesús inmediatamente "llamó a sus doce discípulos y les dio autoridad sobre los espíritus inmundos para expulsarlos y curar toda enfermedad y toda dolencia".

Al mirar tu vida, tus luchas, tus necesidades espirituales y tu deseo de crecer en la fe, ¿cómo te ha alimentado Dios? ¿A través de quién te ha hablado? El pastoreo de Cristo ocurre a través de la participación en la Misa, el Sacramento de la Confesión, la palabra escrita, el testimonio inspirado de otro, y muchas otras maneras. Es útil pensar que cada vez que has encontrado la gracia de Dios a través de otra persona, ha sido porque el Dueño de la cosecha decidió enviarte un obrero.

Reflexiona sobre la imagen de Jesús mirándote con amor y eligiendo enviarte a Sus ministros. Presta especial atención a cómo Dios te ha estado hablando recientemente. Si es a través de un libro en particular, sigue leyéndolo. Si es a través de un predicador específico del Evangelio, sigue escuchando. Si es a través de una determinada conversación con un amigo, cónyuge o ser querido, sigue hablando. Dios te ama y continúa alcanzándote de diferentes maneras, especialmente enviando a otros en Su nombre.

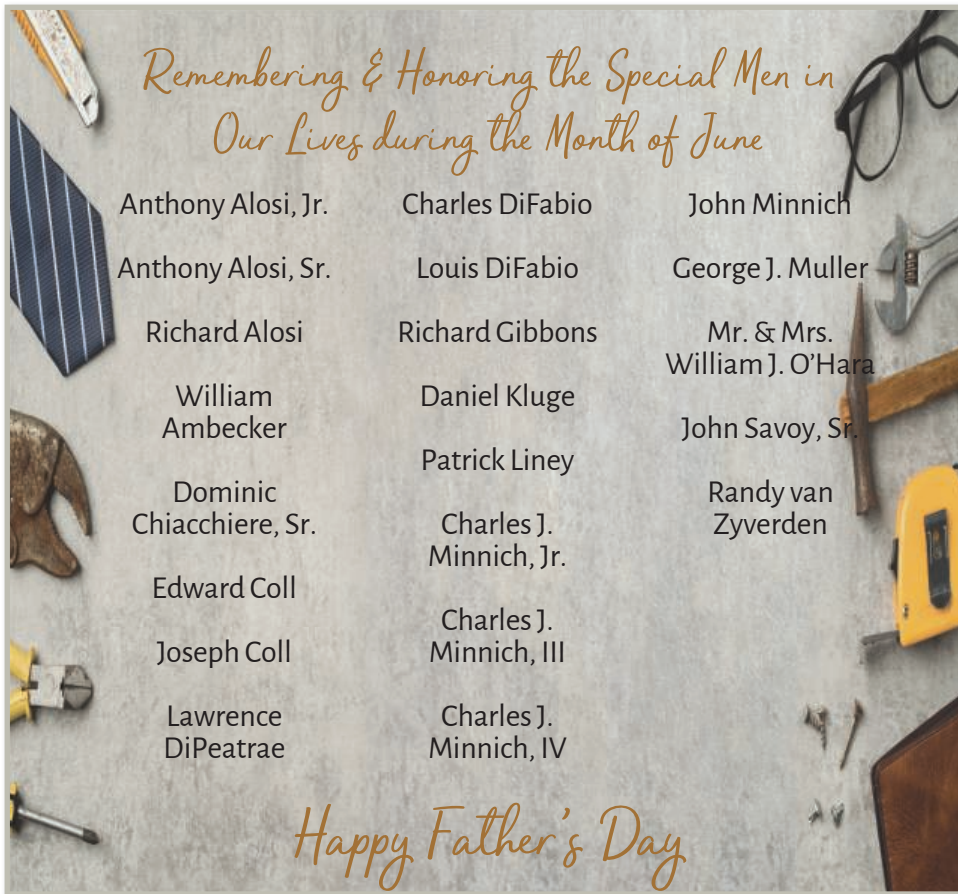
