

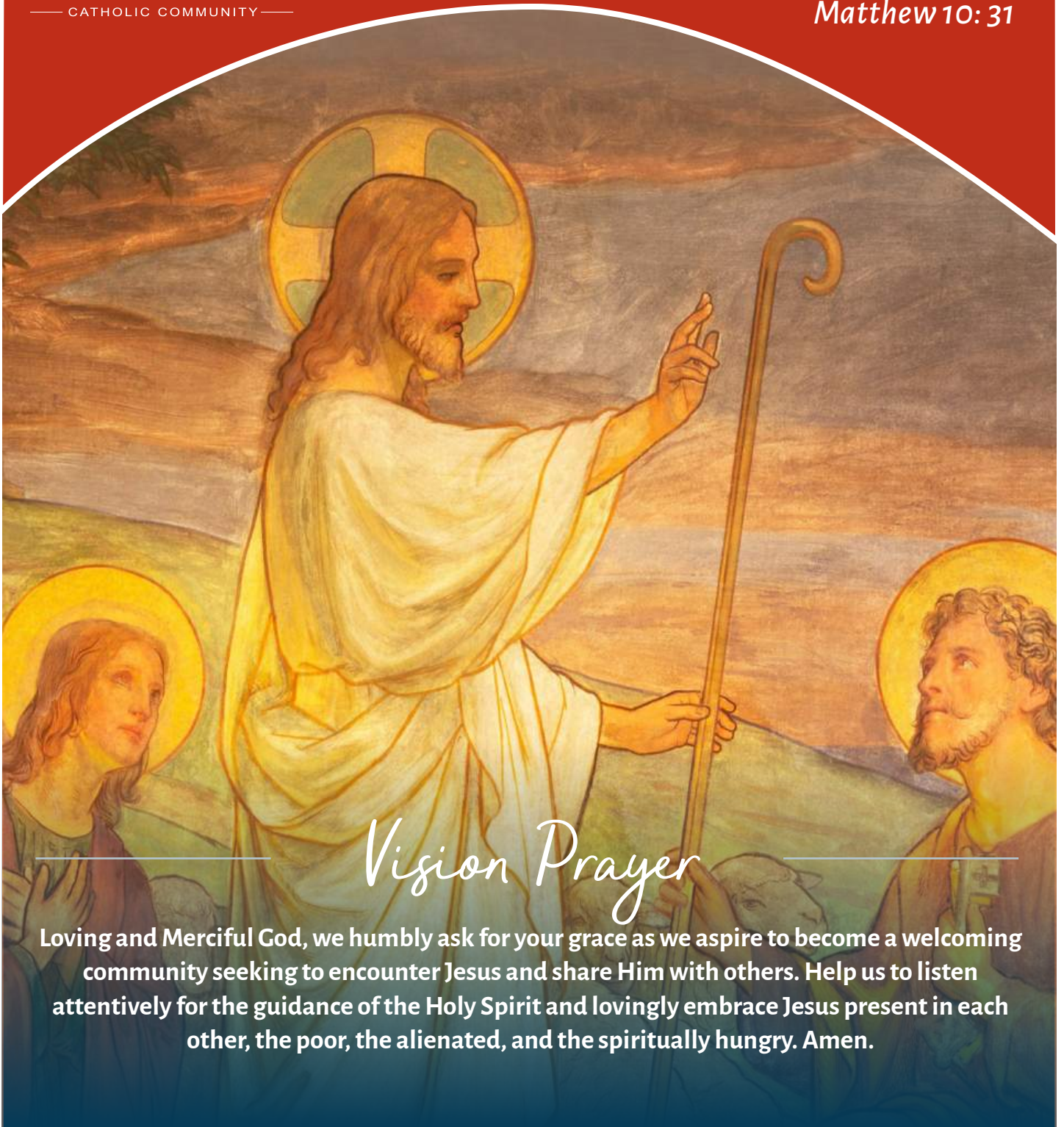

To register with the parish, visit www.pariah.stnorbert.org and click the *Register with Us* page under the *About* tab to download the Parish Registration form (English and Spanish). The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

In today's Gospel, Jesus reminds the Apostles that they only need to stand with him and not be afraid. He tells his Apostles three times - three times in just seven verses - not to be afraid. But Jesus also wants us to know that following him is demanding.

We all have moments where we question whether the Lord really knows what's going on or cares about what happens to us. Jesus is our lifeline to the Father. St. Paul reminds us today that the grace we need comes through him and that grace sustains us in communion with him and the Father as well. We stand with the Father by standing with Christ. Staying united to him, grounded in his friendship, we're assured of meaning, purpose, and everlasting joy - no matter how hard our pilgrimage through life may get.

St Paul understood this. As he said in today's Second Reading, even though sin, evil, and suffering weigh on us, Christ's grace is infinitely more powerful: "For if by the transgression of the one the many died, how much more did the grace of God and the gracious gift of the one man Jesus Christ overflow for the many."

Jeremiah understood it well too. In today's First Reading, after listing his horrible sufferings, he shouts out a cheer of confidence in God: "But the Lord is with me, like a mighty champion: my persecutors will stumble, they will not triumph."

The Lord is our champion too. He proved it first when he rose from the dead. And has proven it thousands of times since, in the lives of the saints - those who have been faithful to his friendship. And he proves it every day on the altar, in the sacrifice of the Eucharist. Jesus will never abandon us. He wants to be our strength as we fight daily to be faithful soldiers of his Kingdom.

Today, let's promise him that whenever we feel the cold breath of fear behind us, we will call out to him in prayer, giving him a chance to show his stuff.

Amigos,

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús recuerda a los Apóstoles que sólo tienen que estar a su lado y no tener miedo. Les dice a sus Apóstoles tres veces -tres veces en sólo siete versículos- que no tengan miedo. Pero Jesús también quiere que sepamos que seguirle a Él tiene exigencias.

Todos tenemos momentos en los que nos preguntamos si el Señor sabe realmente lo que pasa o si le importa lo que nos ocurre. Jesús es nuestro salvavidas hacia el Padre. San Pablo nos recuerda hoy que la gracia que necesitamos viene a través de él y que esa gracia nos sostiene en comunión con él y también con el Padre. Estamos con el Padre si estamos con Cristo. Permaneciendo unidos a Él, arraigados en su amistad, tenemos la seguridad de que nuestra vida tiene sentido, propósito y alegría eterna, por dura que sea nuestra peregrinación por la vida.

San Pablo lo comprendió. Como dice en la segunda lectura de hoy, aunque el pecado, el mal y el sufrimiento pesen sobre nosotros, la gracia de Cristo es infinitamente más poderosa: "Porque si por la transgresión de uno murieron muchos, cuánto más la gracia de Dios y el don bondadoso de un solo hombre, Jesucristo, se desbordó en favor de todos".

Jeremías también lo entendió bien. En la primera lectura de hoy, después de enumerar sus horribles sufrimientos, lanza un grito de confianza en Dios: "Pero el Señor está conmigo, como un poderoso campeón: mis perseguidores tropezarán, no triunfarán".

El Señor es también nuestro campeón. Lo demostró primero cuando resucitó de entre los muertos. Y lo ha demostrado miles de veces desde entonces, en la vida de los santos, de los que han sido fieles a su amistad y lo demuestra cada día en el altar, en el sacrificio de la Eucaristía. Jesús nunca nos abandonará. Quiere ser nuestra fuerza mientras luchamos cada día por ser fieles soldados de su Reino.

Prometámosle hoy que, cada vez que sintamos el frío aliento del miedo detrás de nosotros, le llamaremos en oración, dándole la oportunidad de mostrar su presencia en nuestras vidas.
