Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Friends,

In the Gospel, Jesus says, "Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it." The goal of selfishness is to elevate oneself, thinking that this is what's best. But Jesus points out that when you live selfishly, putting yourself above others, you lose what's most important. You lose your soul. But if you live selflessly, putting others before you, it is in this act that you find your purpose in life.

Think of Jesus. He is God, the Second Person of the Holy Trinity, existing for eternity in perfect union with the Father and the Holy Spirit. He radiates pure love. He chose to become human. To suffer and be killed. His sacrifice went to the heart of who He is. Jesus is love itself. And love is always self-giving. It's always fulfilling. It always seeks the good of the other. Love fulfills the lover when it is pure, holy, and selfless. Jesus' sacrificial death on the Cross redeemed us, but also manifested the Son of God's perfect fulfillment in His human nature because His death was pure love.

Sin confuses us. Selfishness clouds our thinking. As a result, it becomes difficult to see that the way to fulfillment in life is by the complete and unwavering sacrifice of our lives given to others. When doing this, we imitate Jesus. The moment that sin leads us to think first about ourselves, we become blind to who we are and what makes us fulfilled.

Reflect on the divine mission you have been given to lose yourself for the sake of Christ. By loving God and others in this pure way, you become who you are and who you were created to be. You find yourself choosing to lose yourself in this world. Think of this profound mystery and believe it. Once you believe it, commit to living sacrificially, casting aside doubt so that you will never hesitate to love everyone sacrificially. In the radical act of selfless love, you'll discover and become who you were created to be.

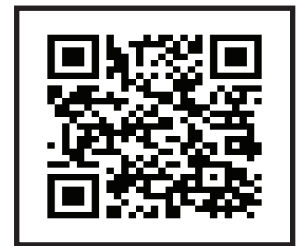
