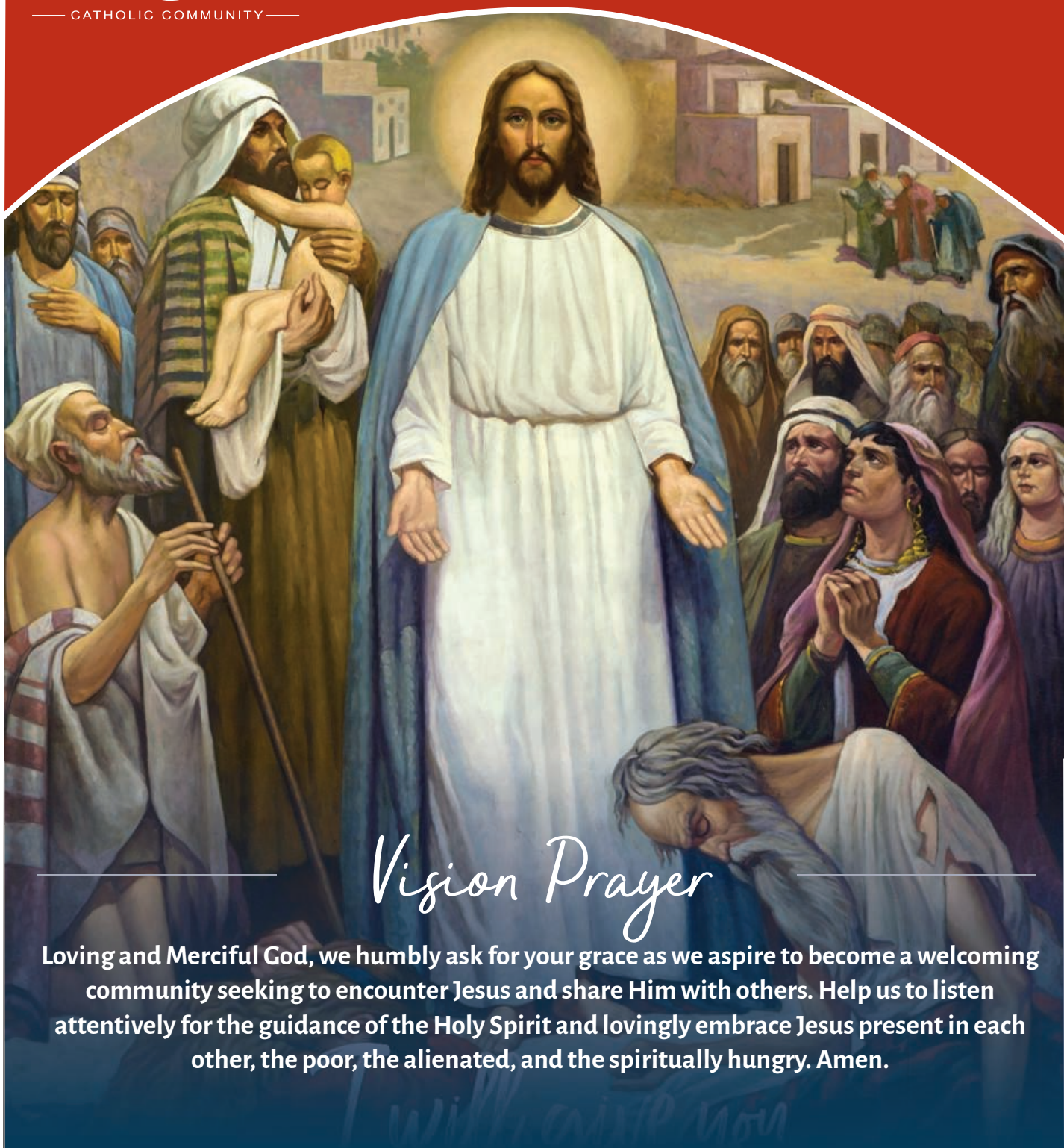

To register, visit www.parish.stnorbert.org and click the *Register with Us* page under the *About* tab to complete the on-line Parish Registration form (<https://www.osvhub.com/stnorbert/directory/register>). The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

Christ brings peace to our souls. We have all experienced Christ's peace, at least a little. We have tasted the joy of his forgiveness in the sacrament of confession. The assurance that he cares for loved ones who have died, and the consolation of knowing that he is near. And yet, for most of us, that interior peace is not as deep and steady as we would like. The storms of life still seem to upset the ship of faith on which our hearts sail.

Is there anything we can do to experience Christ's peace more steadily, securely, and deeply? "Take my yoke upon you," Jesus says, "and I will give you rest." What is that yoke? Jesus tells us, "Learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart." Humility is the secret to experiencing Christ's peace. The more we grow in humility, the more Christ's peace, strength, and wisdom take over our hearts. Like all virtues, humility grows gradually, like a muscle if we exercise it.

Lucky for us, there are three ways to exercise humility. First, prayer. Every time we pray sincerely, we acknowledge our dependence on God - an act of humility. This is why St. John Vianney said, "God commands you to pray, but he forbids you to worry." It was his variation of the old saying- "Courage is fear that has said its prayers."

Second, speaking well of other people. Every time we observe and praise the good points of others, we loosen the shackles of arrogance and envy that bind humility.

Third, obedience to God's will. Whenever we conscientiously fulfill our responsibilities in life, follow our conscience, and obey Church teaching, we are humbly reversing the arrogant rebellion of original sin.

Today, Jesus will again prove his humility and love by coming to us in Holy Communion. When he does, let's tell him how much we long for his peace and ask him to lay his restful yoke of humility upon us.

Amigos,

Cristo trae paz a nuestras almas. Todos hemos experimentado la paz de Cristo, al menos un poco. Hemos saboreado la alegría de su perdón en el sacramento de la confesión. La seguridad de que cuida de los seres queridos que han muerto, y el consuelo de saber que está cerca. Y, sin embargo, para la mayoría de nosotros, esa paz interior no es tan profunda y firme como quisiéramos. Las tormentas de la vida parecen seguir perturbando la nave de la fe en la que navega nuestro corazón.

¿Hay algo que podamos hacer para experimentar la paz de Cristo de manera más firme, segura y profunda? "Llevad mi yugo sobre vosotros", dice Jesús, "y yo os aliviaré". ¿Qué es ese yugo? Jesús nos dice: "Aprended de mí, que soy manso y humilde de corazón". La humildad es el secreto para experimentar la paz de Cristo. Cuanto más crecemos en humildad, más se apoderan de nuestro corazón la paz, la fuerza y la sabiduría de Cristo. Como todas las virtudes, la humildad crece gradualmente, como un músculo, si la ejercitamos.

Por suerte, para nosotros, hay tres maneras de ejercitar la humildad. En primer lugar, la oración. Cada vez que rezamos sinceramente, reconocemos nuestra dependencia de Dios: un acto de humildad. Por eso, San Juan Vianney solía decir: "Dios te manda a rezar, pero te prohíbe preocuparte". Era su variación del antiguo dicho que dice: "El valor es el miedo que ha dicho sus oraciones".

En segundo lugar, hablar bien de los demás. Cada vez que observamos y alabamos lo bueno de los demás, aflojamos los grilletes de la arrogancia y la envidia que atan a la humildad.

Tercero, obediencia a la voluntad de Dios. Cada vez que cumplimos concienzudamente nuestras responsabilidades en la vida, seguimos nuestra conciencia y obedecemos las enseñanzas de la Iglesia, estamos virviendo humildemente la rebelión arrogante del pecado original.

Hoy, Jesús volverá a demostrarnos su humildad y su amor, acercándose a nosotros en la Sagrada Comunión. Cuando lo haga, digámosle cuánto anhelamos su paz y pidámosle que ponga sobre nosotros su yugo de humildad.

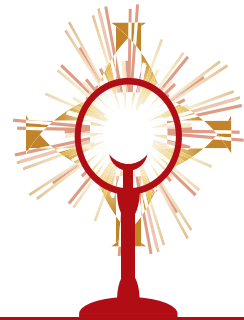

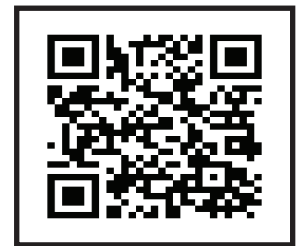

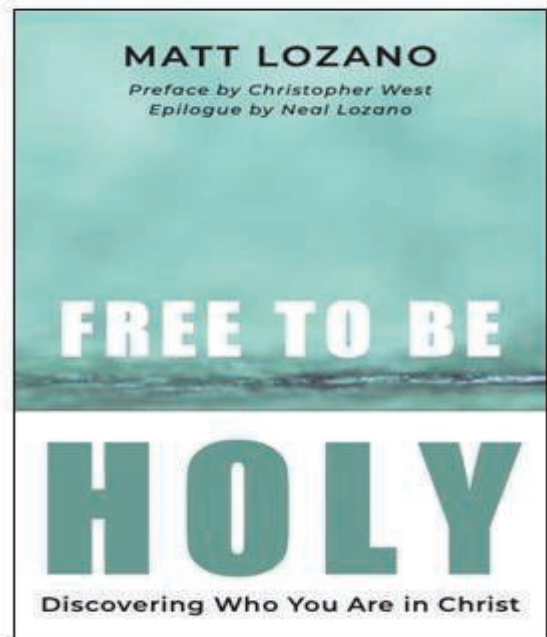
