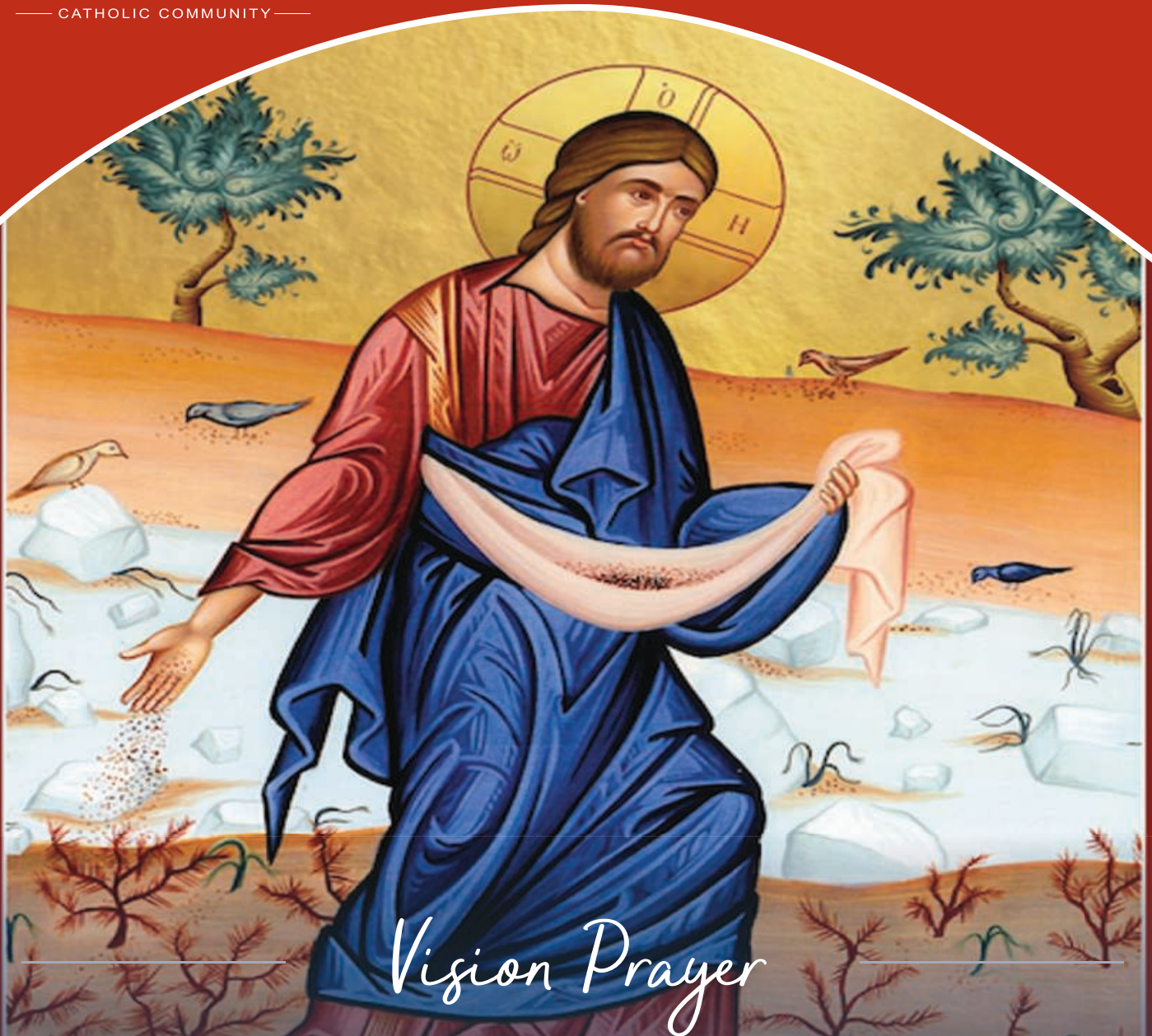

The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

### Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

### Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

### Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

### Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

### Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

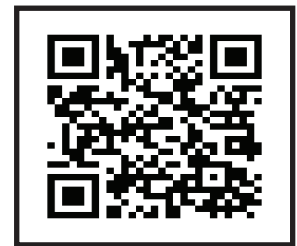

## Eucharistic Congress

THE GIFT OF FINEST WHEAT:

*This is My Body Given Up for You*

### *The Holy Mass – The Lord's Day Part 1 of 4*

Why is it so important to be at Mass on Sunday? Is it *“just a rule”* or more? Where do we begin? The best place to begin is at the beginning, the very beginning. Following the six days of Creation, having completed His first labor of love on behalf of mankind (creating and bringing mankind into being) God rests on the seventh day, the Sabbath. We read in Genesis *“God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it he rested from all the work he had done in creation.”*<sup>1</sup> Following Israel’s liberation from Egypt the observance of this seventh day will be codified in the Ten Commandments: *“Remember the Sabbath day—keep it holy.”*<sup>2</sup> This day, the seventh or Sabbath, for the Jewish people is Saturday.

The observance of the seventh day is recalled particularly so that Israel may imitate God, he rested on the seventh day, and recall the mighty work of salvation the Lord wrought on their behalf; freeing them from servile labor to be a people peculiarly his own. With Jesus, we see the fulfillment of the Old Law. In Jesus, some parts of the law are fulfilled, as in completed and done, others parts are fulfilled in that they are perfected. In Jesus, the definitive Lord’s Day, is Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord wherein Jesus conquers sin and death opens the way to heaven for all who believe in Him.

Pope Innocent I, writing at the beginning of the fifth century testifies to the custom of gathering on Sunday: *“We celebrate Sunday because of the venerable Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ, and we do so not only at Easter but also at the turning of the week.”*<sup>3</sup> The center point of these observance of this day for Christians, particularly Catholic, is the celebration of the Eucharist.

In the Eucharist, the saving sacrifice of Jesus is re-presented, made present again, and those persons believing in him are permitted to taste the fruits of the tree of life, the cross, in the reception of his very body and blood, under the forms of bread and wine. In ancient times, as now, it was a defining characteristic of the Christian people to refrain from servile labor on Sunday and gather for the *“breaking of the bread.”* Sharing in the one sacrifice of Christ the Christian people are made one.

Christians fully become the Body of Christ by sharing in the Body of Christ, the Eucharist. Christ is the head and we are the members. Separated from our head, by sin or our own negligence, we are not much different than a limb cut off from a perfectly healthy body; more dead than alive. By Baptism, we are made for communion. Observing the Lord’s Day fulfills this desire and duty of a grateful heart.
