

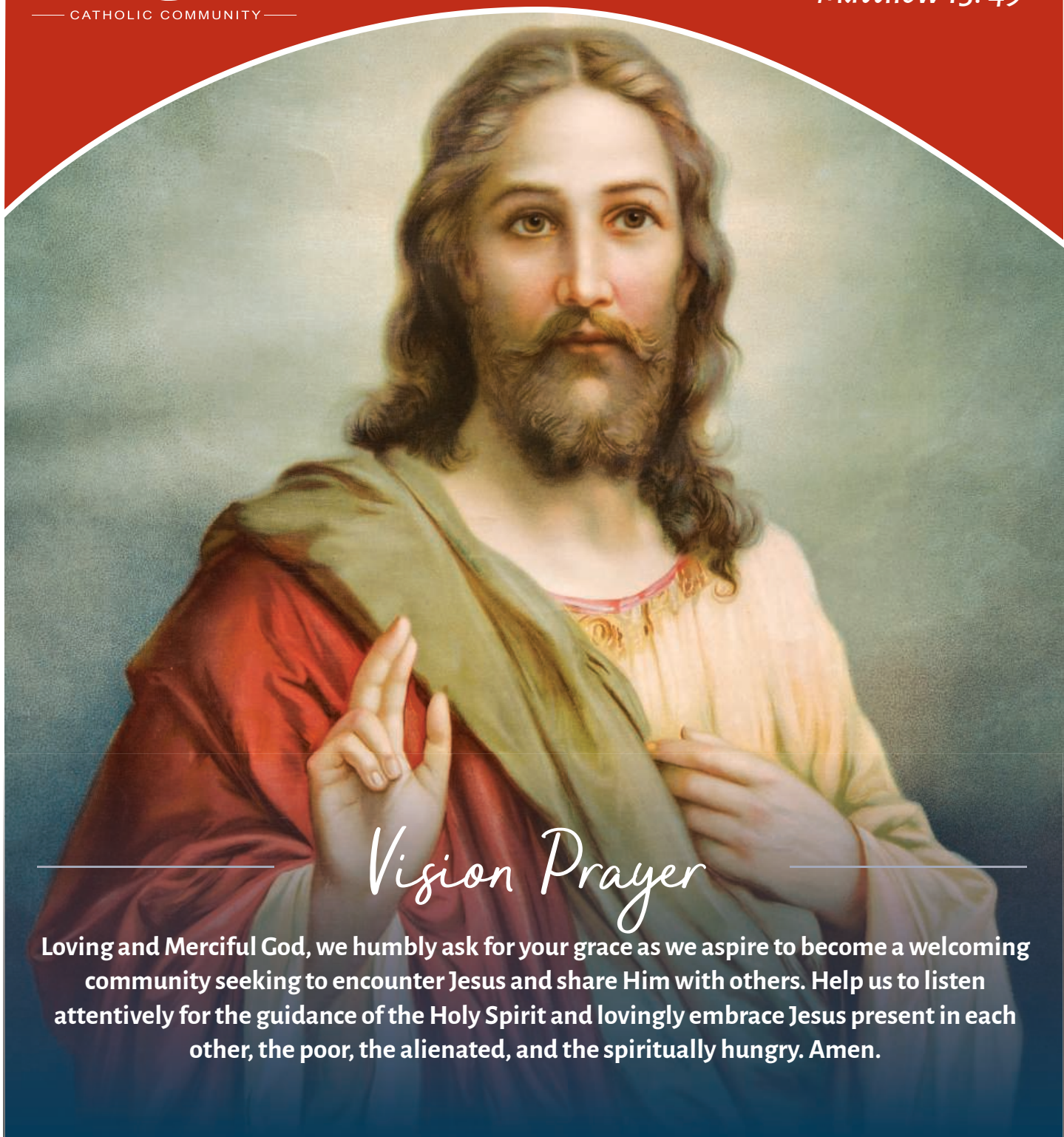

Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Friends,

In today's Gospel, we see in the parable how to encounter Christ in the following ways:

1. **The Kingdom of Heaven Is Like...:** In these lines of Scripture, Our Lord described his Father's Kingdom with us. If we're honest, we should all contemplate heaven often. Heaven is the home of the Trinity, the Blessed Mother, and the saints known and unknown. Heaven is our destiny, our eternal home. Although shrouded in mystery, heaven is as real as the everyday reality of our lives. Heaven can be known here and now and experienced, not in its totality, but in periodic moments of spiritual consolation. Jesus wants us to know about heaven.

2. **Heaven Is like a Treasure Buried in a Field...:** Experiences of heaven on earth are like treasures buried in a field of ordinary day-to-day events. When we have a soul-expanding experience of God, we don't forget it. It might recede from the foreground of our thoughts as we go about living, but recalling it brings the "treasure" back into focus. These little glimmers of the divine compel us to seek God more deeply—to "sell all we have and buy the field."

3. **Heaven Is like a Merchant Searching...:** Seeking the pearl of great price requires our time, attention, and effort—we dedicate the best moments of our day to the task. In our daily conversation with Christ, we fulfill our mission and purpose: "to know [God], to love him, and to serve him in this world, and to be happy with Him forever in heaven" (Baltimore Catechism).

We avail ourselves of heaven on earth—an experience of Jesus. "We can touch Christ's heart and feel him touching ours. Only in this personal relationship with Christ and this encounter with the Risen One do we truly become Christians. And in this way our reason opens, all Christ's wisdom as does all the riches of truth" (Benedict XVI, General Audience, September 3, 2008). Jesus wants us to know something of the heaven that's prepared for us. Thoughts of heaven can sooth our suffering souls. May we be worthy one day of joining Him there.

Amigos,

En el Evangelio de hoy, vemos en la parábola cómo encontrar a Cristo de las siguientes maneras:

1. El Reino de los Cielos es como...: En estas líneas de la Escritura, Nuestro Señor nos describe el Reino de su Padre. Si somos honrados, todos deberíamos contemplar el cielo a menudo. El Cielo es el hogar de la Trinidad, de la Santísima Virgen y de los santos conocidos y desconocidos. El cielo es nuestro destino, nuestro hogar eterno. Aunque envuelto en misterio, el cielo es tan real como la realidad cotidiana de nuestras vidas. El cielo puede conocerse aquí y ahora y experimentarse, no en su totalidad, sino en momentos periódicos de consuelo espiritual. Jesús quiere que conozcamos el cielo.

2. El cielo es como un tesoro enterrado en el campo...: Las experiencias del cielo en la tierra son como tesoros enterrados en un campo de acontecimientos cotidianos. Cuando tenemos una experiencia de Dios que nos expande el alma, no la olvidamos. Puede que desaparezca del primer plano de nuestros pensamientos mientras vivimos, pero al recordarla, el "tesoro" vuelve a estar en primer plano. Estos pequeños destellos de lo divino nos obligan a buscar a Dios más profundamente: a "vender todo lo que tenemos y comprar el campo".

3. El Cielo Es Como Un Comerciante Buscando...: Buscar la perla de gran precio requiere nuestro tiempo, atención y esfuerzo - dedicamos los mejores momentos de nuestro día a esa tarea. En nuestra conversación diaria con Cristo, cumplimos nuestra misión y propósito: "conocerle [a Dios], amarle y servirle en este mundo, y ser felices con Él para siempre en el cielo" (Catecismo de Baltimore).

Disfrutamos del cielo en la tierra: una experiencia de Jesús. "Podemos tocar el corazón de Cristo y sentir que El toca el nuestro. Sólo en esta relación personal con Cristo y en este encuentro con el Resucitado nos hacemos verdaderamente cristianos. Y así se abre nuestra razón, toda la sabiduría de Cristo como todas las riquezas de la verdad" (Benedicto XVI, Audiencia general, 3 de septiembre de 2008). Jesús quiere que conozcamos algo del cielo que está preparado para nosotros. Pensar en el cielo puede aliviar nuestras almas sufrientes. Que un día seamos dignos de unirnos a Él, allá en el cielo.

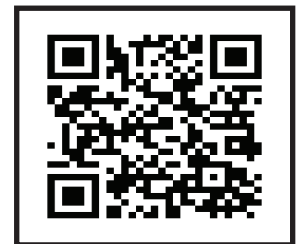

The Holy Mass – Assisting at Mass vs. Going to Church *Part 3 of 4*

Over the past few weeks we considered from where the obligation to attend Holy Mass each Sunday comes. We learned that our remembrance of the Passion, Death and Resurrection is not only an external one but one that literally changes us from within. As such, the Church requires her sons and daughters to faithfully be present for this memorial each Sunday, the definitive Lord's Day. Sometimes our participation at Mass can feel out of sync with how important we are told it is. At the Second Vatican Council, the Council Fathers recognized this very problem (it is ages old). As a result, they sought to encourage people to **actively participate** in the sacrifice of the Mass. What does this mean?

Active Participation does not so much mean "doing" something particular as it does being fully conscious and present to what Jesus is doing on behalf of his people. In Spanish, the verb used to describe "going to Mass" (our English expression) is *asistir* (to assist or to attend). In English, the term was and is still used by some describe their attending Holy Mass. The idea of "assisting" at Mass gives the impression that someone needs to be doing something in order to be at Mass. However, the expression involves a great deal more than simply executing a function.

The Fathers of the Second Vatican Council made it a point to illustrate the way the lay faithful participate in the life of the Church. Their words I believe help us understand how all of us who assist at Mass are called to do so. They teach:

"the laity, dedicated to Christ and anointed by the Holy Spirit, are marvelously called and wonderfully prepared so that ever more abundant fruits of the Spirit may be produced in them. For all their works, prayers and apostolic endeavors, their ordinary married and family life, their daily occupations, their physical and mental relaxation, if carried out in the Spirit, and even the hardships of life, if patiently borne - all these become "spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ". Together with the offering of the Lord's body, they are most fittingly offered in the celebration of the Eucharist."

Some of the immediate things we do to prepare for Mass can assist us in consciously making an offering of the whole of our lives to God through Jesus Christ. Taking time to read the Word of God which will be proclaimed in advance is an important part of our preparation. Fasting for one hour from food and drink (except water/medicine) remind us physically of the absolutely unique guest we prepare to welcome into our hearts. Taking care to dress and groom ourselves well for Mass reminds us of the fact we kneel in the presence of the King of kings who deigns to call you and me his brothers and sisters.
