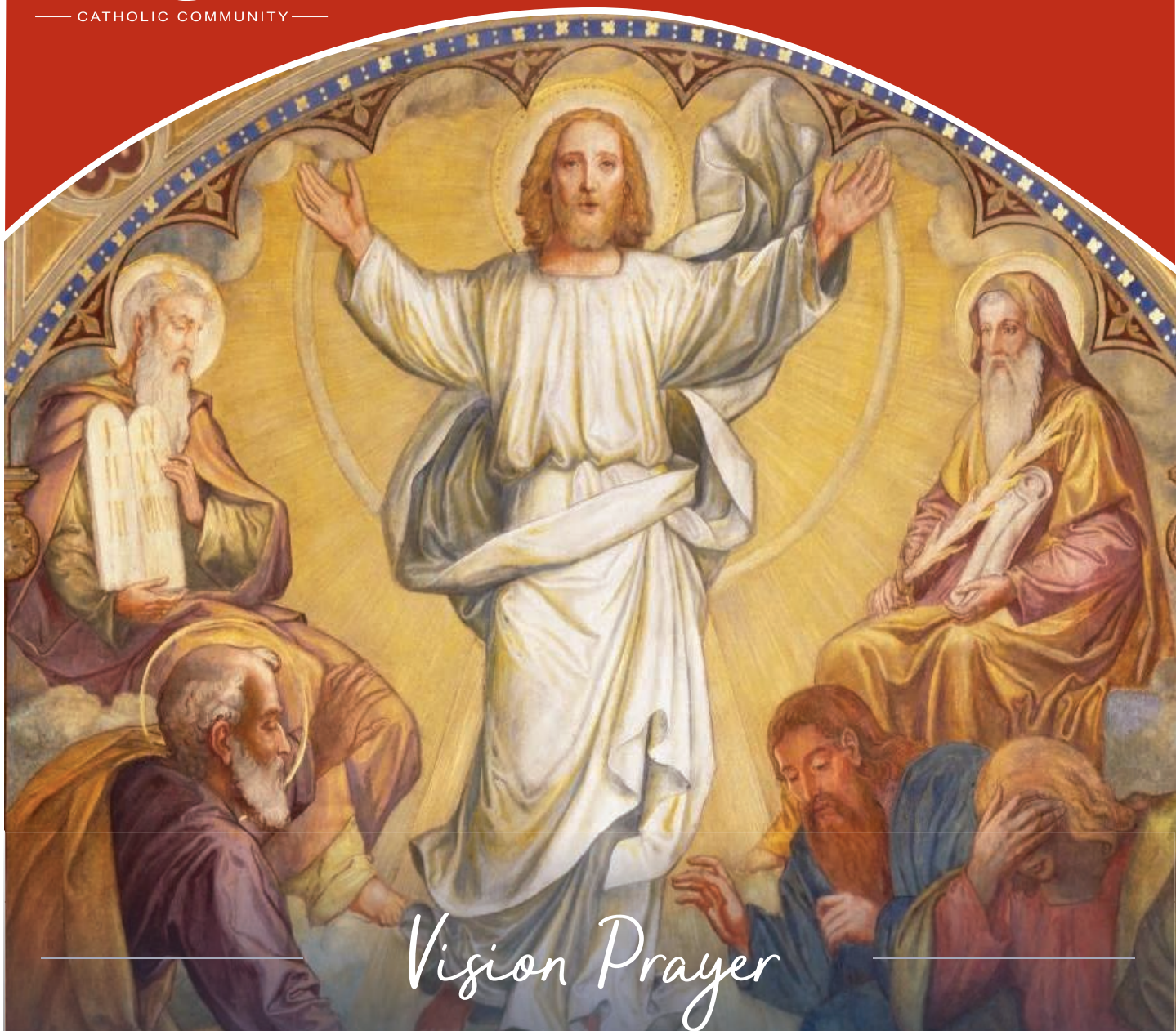

To register, visit www.parish.stnorbert.org and click the *Register with Us* page under the *About* tab to complete the on-line Parish Registration form (<https://www.osvhub.com/stnorbert/directory/register>). The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

“Jesus took with him Peter and James and his brother John and led them up a high mountain by themselves.” Today we celebrate the feast of the Transfiguration. The dictionary defines transfigure as *transforming into something more beautiful or elevated*. The common theme of today’s readings is the transformation of Christ by God the Father, who sent His Son as our Savior and Redeemer. We see the Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in the Transfiguration. The Father is the voice, the Son is the man Jesus, and the Holy Spirit is the shining cloud.

The primary purpose of Jesus’ Transfiguration was to consult his Heavenly Father to ascertain His plan for Our Lord’s suffering, death, and Resurrection. The secondary aim was to make Jesus’ chosen disciples aware of His Divine glory so they might let go of their worldly ambitions about a conquering political Messiah. A third purpose was to strengthen their Faith and hope and to encourage them to persevere through the future ordeal.

The Gospel describes Christ’s Transfiguration and challenges us to revitalize our Faith as true disciples of Christ. Today’s feast offers us a message of hope and encouragement. In moments of doubt and despair, the expectation of our transformation in Heaven helps us reach out to God and listen to His consoling words: “This is my beloved son/ daughter in whom I am well pleased.”

We need these ‘mountain-top’ experiences in our own lives. We can share experiences like those of Peter, James, and John when spending extra time in prayer. Communion with Jesus in prayer and in the Eucharist should be a source of daily transformation. We must also be transformed by becoming humbler and more selfless, sharing love, compassion, and forgiveness with others. But in our everyday lives, we often fail to recognize Jesus when he appears to us “transfigured,” hidden in someone in need. With the eyes of Faith, let’s look for Jesus in every one of our brothers and sisters, the children of God whom we come across each day. And by His grace, respond to Him in them with love and service.

Amigos,

“Jesús tomó consigo a Pedro, a Santiago y a su hermano Juan, y los llevó solos a un monte alto”. Hoy celebramos la fiesta de la Transfiguración. El diccionario define transfigurar como *transformar en algo más bello o elevado*. El tema común de las lecturas de hoy es la transformación de Cristo por Dios Padre, que envió a su Hijo como nuestro Salvador y Redentor. Vemos la Trinidad, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo en la Transfiguración. El Padre es la voz, el Hijo es Jesús el hombre, y el Espíritu Santo es la nube resplandeciente.

El objetivo principal de la Transfiguración de Jesús era consultar a su Padre Celestial para averiguar Su plan para el sufrimiento, la muerte y la Resurrección de Nuestro Señor. El objetivo secundario era hacer que los discípulos elegidos de Jesús fueran conscientes de Su gloria Divina para que pudieran dejar de lado sus ambiciones mundanas sobre un Mesías político conquistador. Un tercer propósito era fortalecer su Fe y esperanza y animarles a perseverar a través de la prueba futura.

El Evangelio describe la Transfiguración de Cristo y nos desafía a revitalizar nuestra fe como verdaderos discípulos de Cristo. La fiesta de hoy nos ofrece un mensaje de esperanza y aliento. En momentos de duda y desesperación, la espera de nuestra transformación en el Cielo nos ayuda a acercarnos a Dios y escuchar sus palabras consoladoras: “Este es mi hijo/hija amado/a de quien estoy muy complacido.

Necesitamos estas experiencias de “cima de montaña” en nuestras propias vidas. Podemos compartir experiencias como las de Pedro, Santiago y Juan cuando dedicamos más tiempo a la oración. La comunión con Jesús en la oración y en la Eucaristía debe ser una fuente de transformación diaria. También debemos transformarnos haciéndonos más humildes y desinteresados, compartiendo el amor, la compasión y el perdón con los demás. Pero en nuestra vida cotidiana, a menudo no reconocemos a Jesús cuando se nos aparece “transfigurado”, escondido en alguien necesitado. Con los ojos de la fe, busquemos a Jesús en cada uno de nuestros hermanos y hermanas, los hijos de Dios con los que nos cruzamos cada día y por su gracia, respondamos a Él en ellos con amor y servicio.

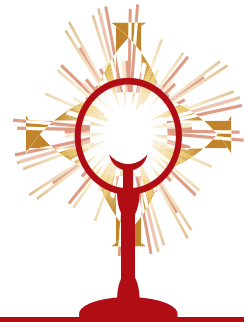
Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

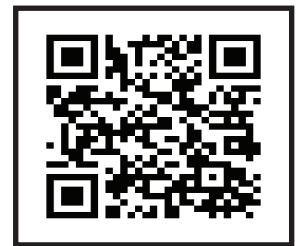

The Holy Mass – Making a Holy Communion *Part 4 of 4*

Over the past few weeks we considered from where the obligation to attend Holy Mass each Sunday comes. We then considered the way by which we might fruitfully [assist] or actively participate at Mass on Sunday. One of the central pieces we often associate with Mass is Holy Communion. Something we need to keep in mind is that Holy Communion is one part of the greater whole of the Mass.

Why do we participate in Mass however? Jesus' total self-sacrifice on our behalf to the Father on the Cross happened once for all. The Mass perpetuates the sacrifice of the Cross. We who live several hundred years removed from that initial sacrifice may share in its fruits now. Whether or not we receive Jesus in the Eucharist at each Mass, we are called to be present for that sacrifice which defines us, which makes us who we are in Jesus Christ.

Receiving the Eucharist, we are offered an even more intimate share in that one sacrifice; receiving Jesus into our very bodies. Like anything else we can do that better or worse. **Holy** Communion means to receive Jesus in the Eucharist in a state of grace. A state of grace means to be free from mortal sin. Why is this so important?

The Eucharist, is Jesus. Jesus makes himself really and truly present to us body, blood, soul and divinity. Receiving Jesus in Holy Communion is a sign of our belief that Jesus present there in the Eucharist and also, of our actual and moral communion with Jesus. This means that first, we have faith Jesus is there in the Eucharist. Secondly, we are initiated into Jesus' body on earth, the Church. Finally, it means that being a member of the Church, my life is in moral communion with Jesus and his way of life: his teachings, his law, and those promulgated by his representatives in the Church.

If we cannot say with a clear conscience that our life is both in actual and moral communion with Jesus in the Church, we ought to refrain from making an act of Holy Communion as we would be receiving Jesus unworthily. St. Paul noticed this disconnect among the Corinthians and reminded them:

“Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord unworthily will have to answer for the body and blood of the Lord. A person should examine himself, and so eat the bread and drink the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body, eats and drinks judgment on himself.”¹

The best way we can prepare to receive Jesus worthily is to make a good confession. There we may be forgiven any and all sins committed since our Baptism. Having been reconciled to Christ and to his Church in confession we may be confident of being in a state of grace. We may be confident of making a worthy, a holy communion glorifying God, and growing in the life of grace which prepares the way for heaven.
