### Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

### Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

### Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

### Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

### Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Friends,

The wind is blowing, the waves are crashing. Things aren't going well. Fear takes hold. In today's Gospel, the apostles are in a panic. Then they see someone gliding along the water. They were scared! Who wouldn't be? Jesus speaks directly to their fear. "Take heart; it is I" – literally in early Greek translation, "I am."

This is biblical code language that powerfully evokes the presence of God. When Moses stood before the burning bush, at a loss as to how he, the tongue-tied fugitive from Egypt, was supposed to return to the Pharaoh and convince that hardened soul to liberate the enslaved Hebrews, he felt he couldn't do it. God's answer to Moses' doubt was to tell Moses his name, "I AM." God's name is presence, and that presence brings reassurance. We're never alone.

Peter's reaction to Jesus walking on the water is to believe. The other disciples hold on for dear life as he stands, preparing for that daring leap. Peter's faith inspires us: At times, we face crucial decisions and feel like we are also about to jump out of a boat. The indecision we experience can seem rational. We don't want to drown. But Peter's leap was not simply blind. He knew he was better off putting on a life jacket by himself. But Christ was commanding him, "Come." This story is a story of faith-filled obedience. Jesus calls us to "Come." Trust in Him!

Peter leaps and lands on solid water. The wind and the waves overwhelm his awareness of the miracle, and along with doubt, he finds himself in the water. How beautiful that Peter's fall awakens his faith again. He does not attempt to rely on his swimming prowess. He cries out, "Lord, save me." Christ stretches out his hand to save his water-logged friend. He is anxious for Peter—and us—to learn the lesson. "You of little faith, why did you doubt?" In other words, "Don't take your eyes off me! I will keep you afloat."

Doubt can take root in all of us. Let's pray and work to trust in God's infinite mercy. And when the storms of life pop up, cry out to Jesus: "Lord, save me."

Amigos,

Sopla el viento, rompen las olas. Las cosas no van bien. El miedo se apodera de nosotros. En el Evangelio de hoy, los apóstoles entran en pánico. Entonces ven a alguien que se desliza por el agua. Estaban asustados. ¿Quién no lo estaría? Jesús habla directamente a su miedo. "Ánimo, soy yo" - literalmente en la traducción griega primitiva, "soy yo".

Este es un lenguaje bíblico que evoca poderosamente la presencia de Dios. Cuando Moisés se detuvo ante la zarza ardiente, sin saber cómo él, el fugitivo de Egipto con la lengua trabada iba a volver ante el Faraón y convencer a esa alma endurecida de que liberara a los hebreos esclavizados, sintió que no podía hacerlo. La respuesta de Dios a la duda de Moisés fue decirle su nombre: "SOY YO". El nombre de Dios es presencia, y esa presencia trae tranquilidad. Nunca estamos solos.

La reacción de Pedro cuando Jesús camina sobre las aguas es de creer. Los demás discípulos se aferran a su vida mientras él se levanta, preparándose para ese salto audaz. La fe de Pedro nos inspira: A veces, nos enfrentamos a decisiones cruciales y sentimos que también estamos a punto de saltar de una barca. La indecisión que experimentamos puede parecer racional. No queremos ahogarnos. Pero el salto de Pedro no fue simplemente a ciegas. Sabía que era mejor ponerse el solo un chaleco salvavidas. Pero Cristo le estaba ordenando: "Ven". Esta historia es una historia de obediencia llena de fe. Jesús nos llama a "Venir". Confía en El.

Pedro salta y aterriza en el agua. El viento y las olas abruma su conciencia del milagro y, junto con la duda, se encuentra en el agua. Qué hermoso que la caída de Pedro despierte de nuevo su fe. No intenta confiar en su habilidad para nadar. Grita: "Señor, sálvame". Cristo tiende la mano para salvar a su amigo abnegado. Quiere que Pedro -y nosotros- aprendamos la lección. "Hombre de poca fe, ¿por qué dudaste?". En otras palabras: "¡No me quites los ojos de encima! Yo te mantendré a flote".

La duda puede arraigar en todos nosotros. Recemos y trabajemos para confiar en la infinita misericordia de Dios. Y cuando surjan las tormentas de la vida, clamemos a Jesús: "Señor, sálvame".

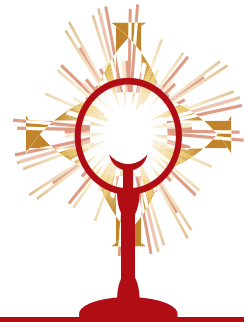
### Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary


