

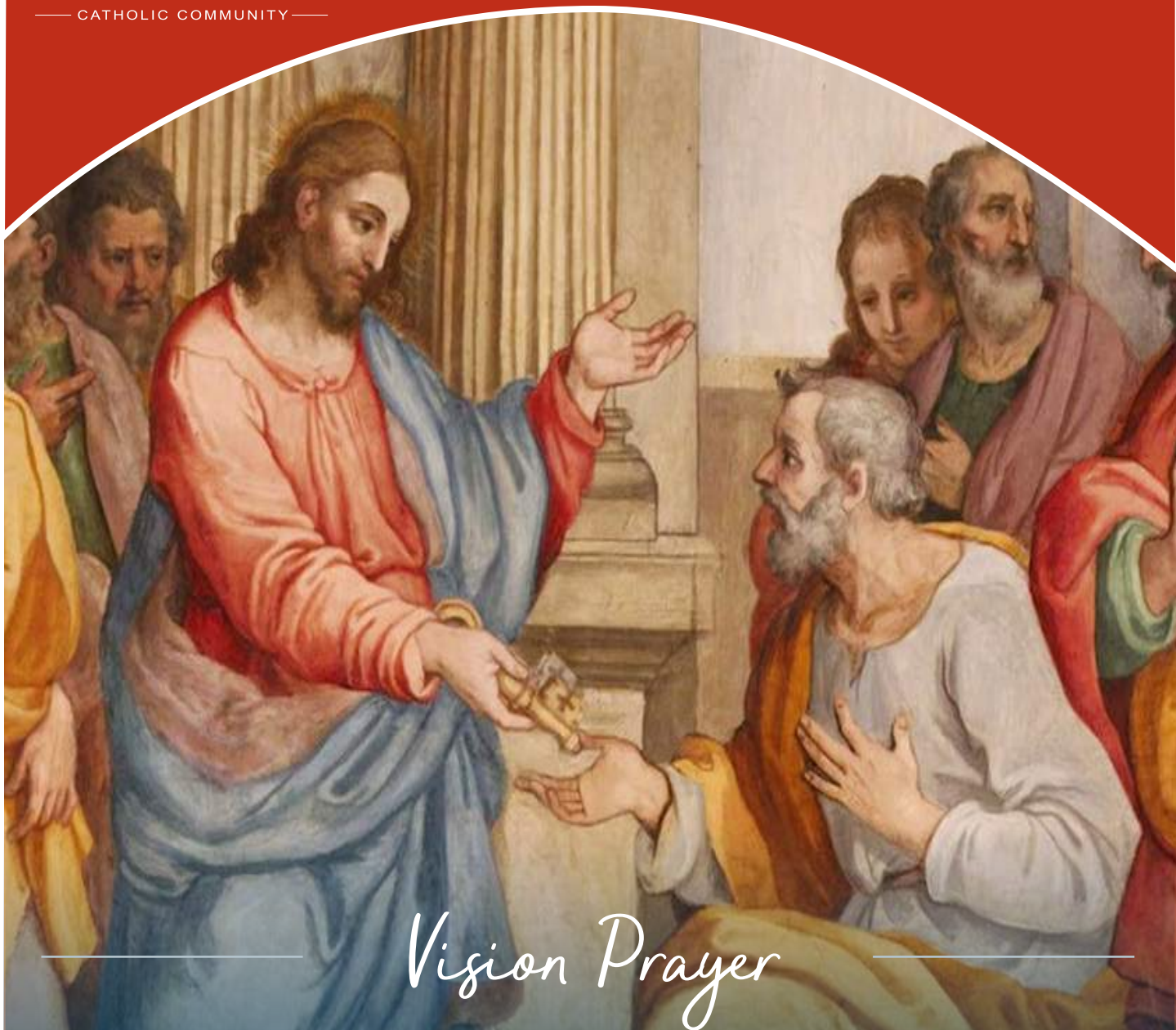

To register, visit www.parish.stnorbert.org and click the *Register with Us* page under the *About* tab to complete the on-line Parish Registration form (<https://www.osvhub.com/stnorbert/directory/register>). The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

Jesus asks two questions in today's Gospel. If Jesus were to ask you these two questions, what would you answer? First, what's most people's general opinion about Jesus today? When asked, most Christians would give the correct answer. Jesus is God. He is the Savior. But sometimes, those answers are more theoretical than personal. Often, it's easy to believe things about Jesus than believe in Jesus. So, what would you say if you were to answer the second question? Faith in Jesus must not only be theoretical, but it must also be deeply personal, flowing from the depths of your heart.

Deep personal faith in Jesus can only come from the Father speaking to your heart in a personal way. After Peter professed His faith, Jesus said, "Blessed are you, Simon. For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my heavenly Father." Peter's personal faith in Jesus was not just something he heard from others. It wasn't just a popularly accepted opinion; it was something the Father revealed to him. This is the gift of faith.

When our faith is based upon a personal revelation from the Father in Heaven, spoken within the secrecy of our souls, then nothing can break this faith. The gates of the netherworld cannot prevail against it.

Reflect today on this holy conversation between Jesus and His disciples. As you do, know that Jesus wants to have the same conversation with you. As Jesus took the disciples away to this quiet and safe place, He wants to take you away through prayer to the privacy of your own soul. There, within you, Jesus seeks to elicit a response of personal faith. He wants you to identify Who He is to you. He wants you to profess your faith in Him. This faith is your personal solid foundation; on that foundation, Jesus will build up His Church in you and through you

Amigos,

Jesús hace dos preguntas en el Evangelio de hoy. Si Jesús te hiciera estas dos preguntas, ¿qué responderías? En primer lugar, ¿cuál es hoy la opinión general de la mayoría de la gente sobre Jesús? A la pregunta, la mayoría de los cristianos darían la respuesta correcta. Jesús es Dios. Es el Salvador. Pero a veces, esas respuestas son más teóricas que personales. A menudo, es más fácil creer cosas sobre Jesús que creer en Jesús. Entonces, ¿qué dirías si tuvieras que responder a la segunda pregunta? La fe en Jesús no sólo debe ser teórica, sino también profundamente personal, fluyendo desde lo más profundo de tu corazón.

La fe personal profunda en Jesús solamente puede venir del Padre hablando a tu corazón de una manera personal. Después de que Pedro profesó su fe, Jesús dijo: "Bienaventurado eres, Simón. Porque no te lo ha revelado carne ni sangre, sino mi Padre celestial". La fe personal de Pedro en Jesús no era sólo algo que escuchó de otros. No era sólo una opinión popularmente aceptada; era algo que el Padre le reveló. Este es el don de la fe.

Cuando nuestra fe se basa en una revelación personal del Padre del Cielo, hablada en el secreto de nuestras almas, entonces nada puede quebrantar esta fe. Las puertas de los infiernos no pueden prevalecer contra ella.

Reflexiona hoy sobre esta santa conversación entre Jesús y sus discípulos. Al hacerlo, debes saber que Jesús quiere tener la misma conversación contigo. Así como Jesús se llevó a los discípulos a este lugar tranquilo y seguro, quiere llevarte a ti, a través de la oración, a la intimidad de tu propia alma. Allí, dentro de ti, Jesús busca provocar una respuesta de fe personal. Quiere que identifiques, quién es Él para ti. Quiere que profeses tu fe en Él. Esta fe es tu fundamento personal sólido; sobre ese fundamento, Jesús construirá Su Iglesia en ti y a través de ti.

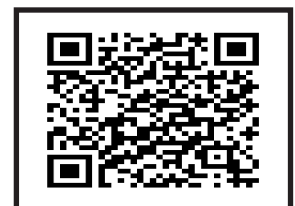

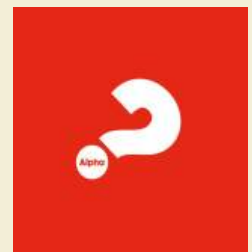

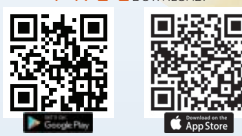
