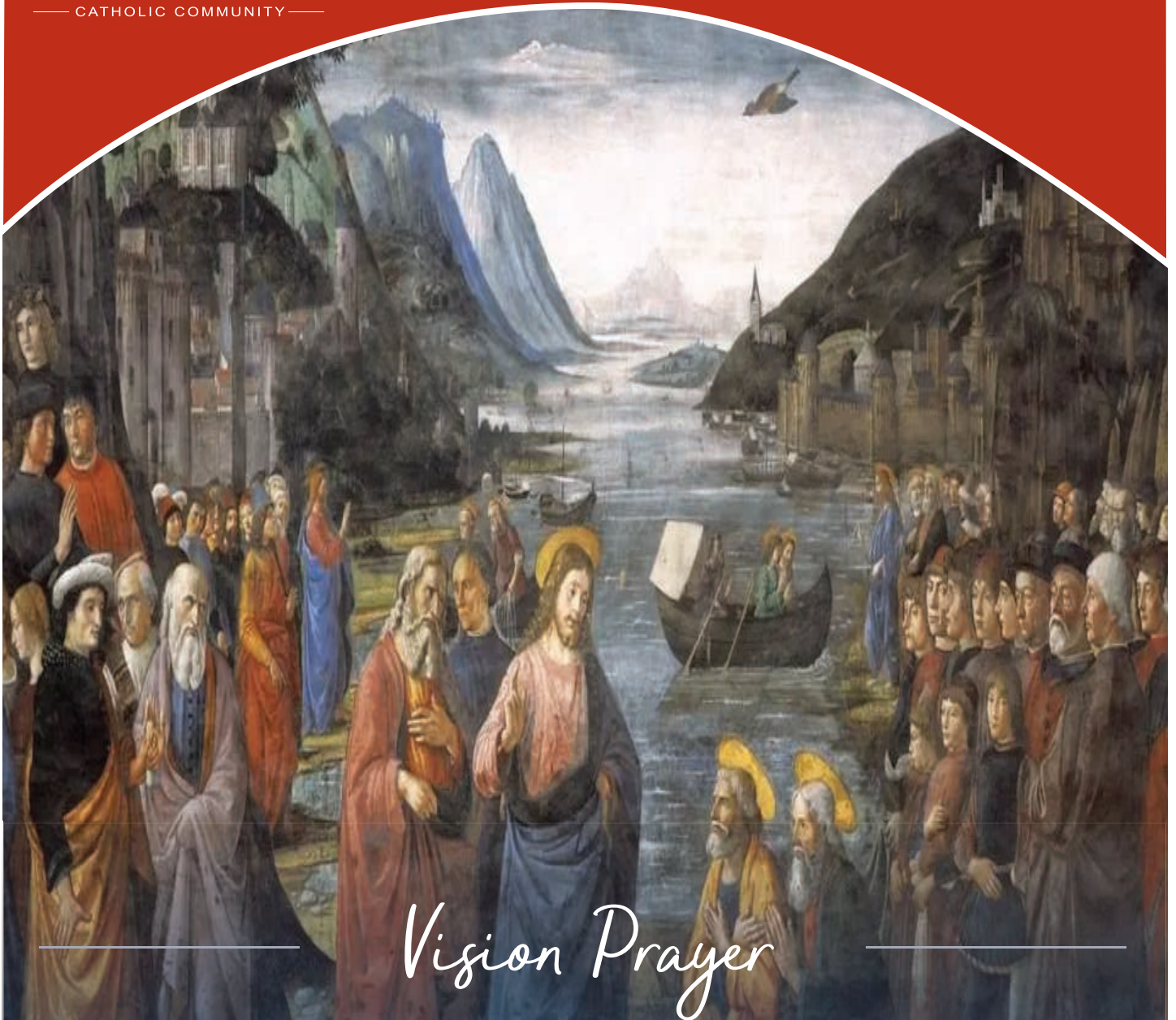

### Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

### Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

### Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

### Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

### Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Friends,

All that Christ does and asks us, in imitation of him, is to give life: "I came that they may have life and have it more abundantly" (John 10:10). He knows that our journey on this side of eternity will be imperfect, both because of the sufferings and sins we cause, and what others do to us. No sorrow or hurt is hidden from him. Still, it's life, not death, that he desires. So, he invites us to take on his heart: Only then can we go to those who have hurt us and, with forgiveness, love, and patience, seek to bring them back to the light. Doing so always brings us back to Christ's heart and his Church since He is the Light: He is the Way, the Truth, and the Life (John 14:6).

This passage is a reference for fraternal correction: the Christian practice of helping another live the truth in love and bringing to his or her attention a fault that may be causing harm to that person or to others. It's rooted in the outward gaze of Christ himself toward his children: a gaze with no selfishness, no egotism, but one of pure love that begins in the truth and desires the good of others. It's a practice that must constantly bring us back to our knees and to living in sincerity before God since only his light can truly illuminate our hearts and purify our intentions for the good of others.

There seems to be a special grace hidden in communion—working together for the good of others and praying together. Jesus highlighted both in his words to his apostles. Let Jesus's affirmation strengthen our faith in the power of intercessory prayer and the great gift he has given us in the Church and our communities and families. Christ wishes to make himself present in the world through us in our communities. He said, "For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them" (Matthew 18:20).

Amigos,

Todo lo que Cristo hace y nos pide, a imitación suya, es dar vida: "Yo he venido para que tengan vida y la tengan en abundancia" (Jn 10,10). Él sabe que nuestro camino en este lado de la eternidad será imperfecto, tanto por lo que nos hacen los demás, como por los sufrimientos y pecados que causamos. A Él no se le oculta ningún dolor o herida. Sin embargo, lo que desea es la vida, no la muerte. Por eso, nos invita a asumir su corazón: Sólo así podremos ir hacia quienes nos han hecho daño y, con perdón, amor y paciencia, tratar de devolverlos a la luz. Hacerlo siempre nos devuelve al corazón de Cristo y a su Iglesia, ya que Él es la Luz: Él es el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida (Jn 14,6).

Este pasaje es una referencia para la corrección fraterna: la práctica cristiana de ayudar a otro a vivir la verdad en el amor y llamar su atención sobre una falta que puede estar causando daño a esa persona o a otros, está enraizada en la mirada exterior de Cristo mismo hacia sus hijos: una mirada sin egoísmo, sin egocentrismo, sino de puro amor que parte de la verdad y desea el bien de los demás. Es una práctica que debe llevarnos constantemente a arrodillarnos y a vivir con sinceridad ante Dios, ya que sólo su luz puede iluminar verdaderamente nuestros corazones y purificar nuestras intenciones para el bien de los demás.

Parece haber una gracia especial escondida en la comunión: trabajar juntos por el bien de los demás y rezar juntos. Jesús destacó ambas cosas en las palabras que dirigió a sus apóstoles. Dejemos que la afirmación de Jesús fortalezca nuestra fe en el poder de la oración de intercesión y en el gran don que nos ha dado en la Iglesia y en nuestras comunidades y familias. Cristo desea hacerse presente en el mundo a través de nosotros en nuestras comunidades. Dijo: "Porque donde están dos o tres reunidos en mi nombre, allí estoy yo en medio de ellos" (Mateo 18, 20).

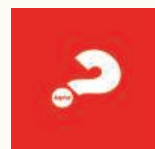

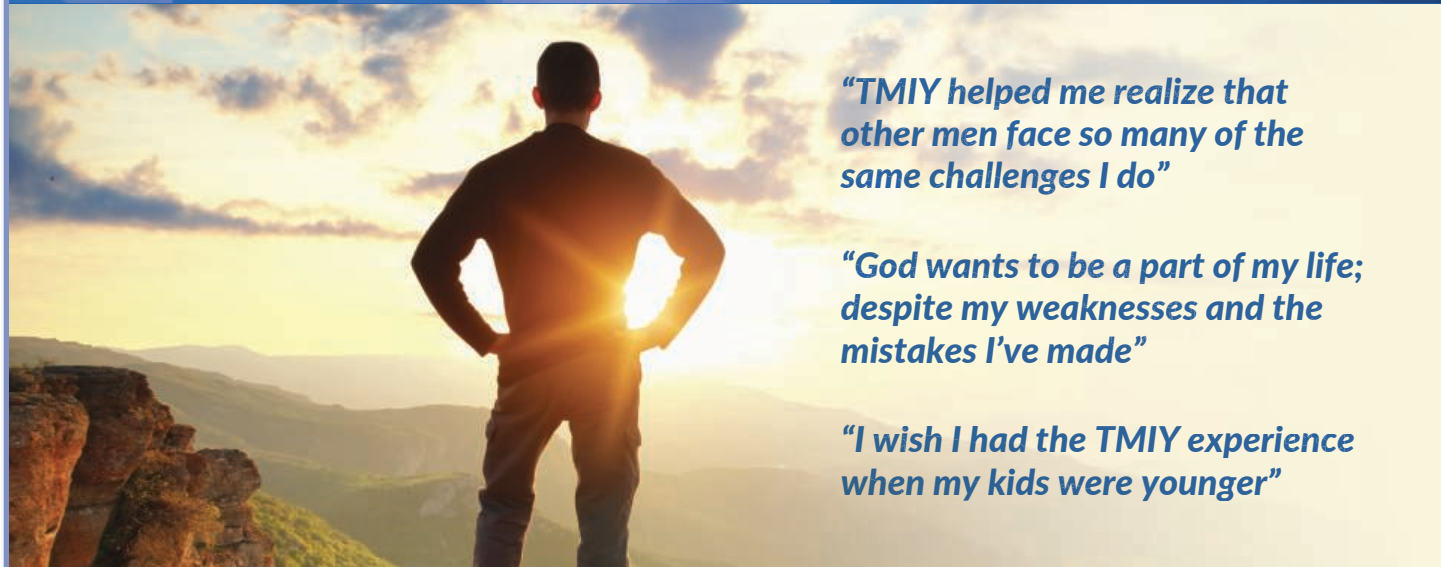
