

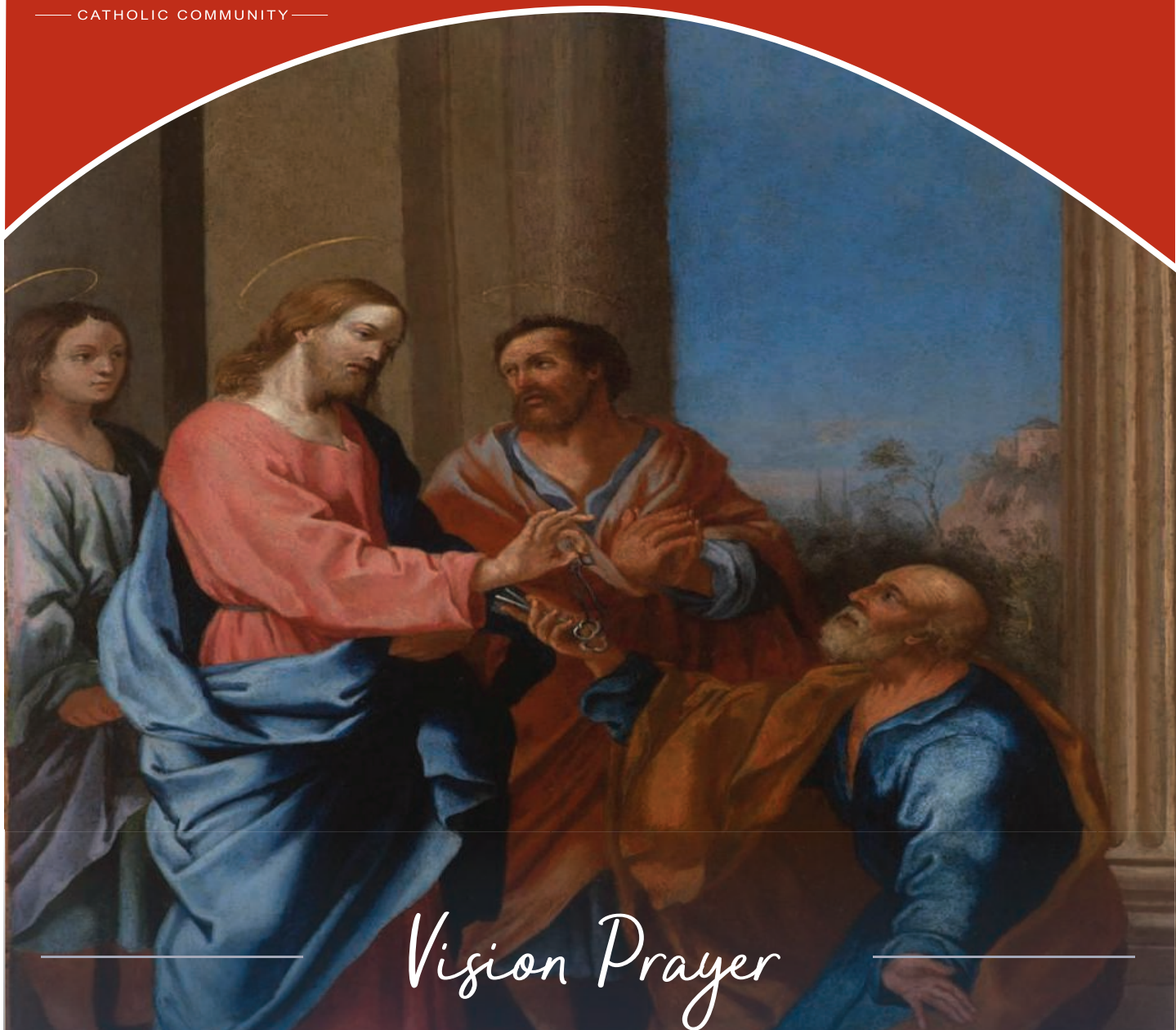

### Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

### Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

### Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

### Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

### Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Friends,

Love, kindness, gentleness, mercy... these qualities are easy to think about. They inspire us to be holy by growing in virtue. But sometimes more is needed. Sometimes, pondering the beauty of the virtues and fruits of the Spirit does not suffice to help us embrace a life of holiness. This is one of the reasons for our parable today.

Today's Gospel gives us food for thought. Let's take a good look at our spiritual lives. It's very easy to become complacent. It's easy to become lukewarm in our prayer and moral life. If that's you to any degree, this Gospel is worth careful and thorough attention.

In this passage, Jesus addresses the sin of unforgiveness. It depicts the wrath of God that will be inflicted on those who refuse to forgive others. The "wicked servant" was a man forgiven a "huge amount" by God. This is all of us. Every one of us has been forgiven by God an amount that cost Jesus His life. The consequence of our sins was the death of the Son of God.

Through Jesus, death has been transformed into the means of new life. And if we want to receive the forgiveness of sins, we must fully share in God's forgiveness. Not only must we receive His forgiveness, but we must also forgive those who have sinned against us. Completely and without reserve.

In this parable, the wicked servant failed to forgive his servant's small debt. In fact, every sin committed against us, no matter how grave in the eyes of God, is a small debt compared to the debt we owe God. For that reason, we must never hesitate to forgive. If this is difficult, and if reflecting on God's mercy, kindness, and love does not move us to completely forgive, then spend time with this parable.

Reflect on the absolute requirement of the Christian life to forgive. Mercy can seem unfair. From the perspective of strict justice, it is. But from the standpoint of freedom and the virtues of Heaven, mercy makes perfect sense. Don't hesitate to forgive, for if you can do so from the bottom of your heart, God will bring you to the riches of His Kingdom.

Amigos,

El amor, la bondad, la mansedumbre, la misericordia... son cualidades en las que es fácil pensar, nos inspiran a ser santos creciendo en virtudes. Pero a veces hace falta algo más. A veces, reflexionar sobre la belleza de las virtudes y los frutos del Espíritu no basta para ayudarnos a abrazar una vida de santidad. Esta es una de las razones de nuestra parábola de hoy.

El Evangelio de hoy nos da que pensar. Echemos un buen vistazo a nuestra vida espiritual. Es muy fácil caer en la autocomplacencia. Es fácil volverse tibio en nuestra oración y en nuestra vida moral. Si es así en alguna medida, merece la pena prestar atención a este Evangelio.

En este pasaje, Jesús aborda el pecado de la falta de perdón. Describe la ira de Dios que se infligirá a quienes se nieguen a perdonar a los demás. El "siervo malvado" era un hombre al que Dios había perdonado "mucho". Así somos todos nosotros. Cada uno de nosotros ha sido perdonado tanto por Dios que le costó la vida a Jesús. La consecuencia de nuestros pecados fue la muerte del Hijo de Dios.

A través de Jesús, la muerte se ha transformado en el medio de una nueva vida. Y si queremos recibir el perdón de los pecados, debemos compartir plenamente el perdón de Dios. No sólo debemos recibir Su perdón, sino que también debemos perdonar a quienes han pecado contra nosotros, completamente y sin reservas.

En esta parábola, el siervo malvado no perdonó la pequeña deuda de su siervo. De hecho, cada pecado cometido contra nosotros, por grave que sea a los ojos de Dios, es una pequeña deuda comparada con la deuda que tenemos con Dios. Por eso, nunca debemos dudar en perdonar. Si esto nos resulta difícil, y si reflexionar sobre la misericordia, la bondad y el amor de Dios no nos mueve a perdonar por completo, entonces dediquemos tiempo a esta parábola.

Reflexiona sobre la exigencia absoluta de la vida cristiana de perdonar. La misericordia puede parecer injusta. Desde la perspectiva de la justicia estricta, lo es. Pero desde el punto de vista de la libertad y de las virtudes del Cielo, la misericordia tiene todo el sentido. No dudes en perdonar, porque si lo haces de corazón, Dios te llevará a las riquezas de su Reino

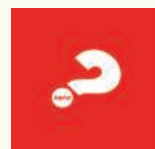

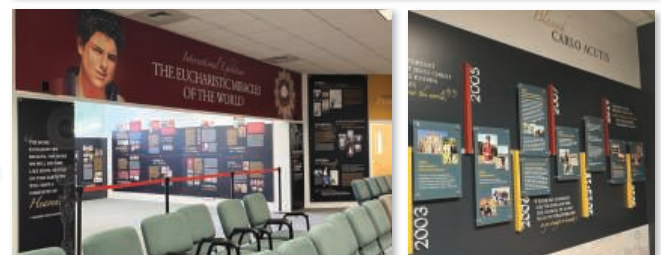
