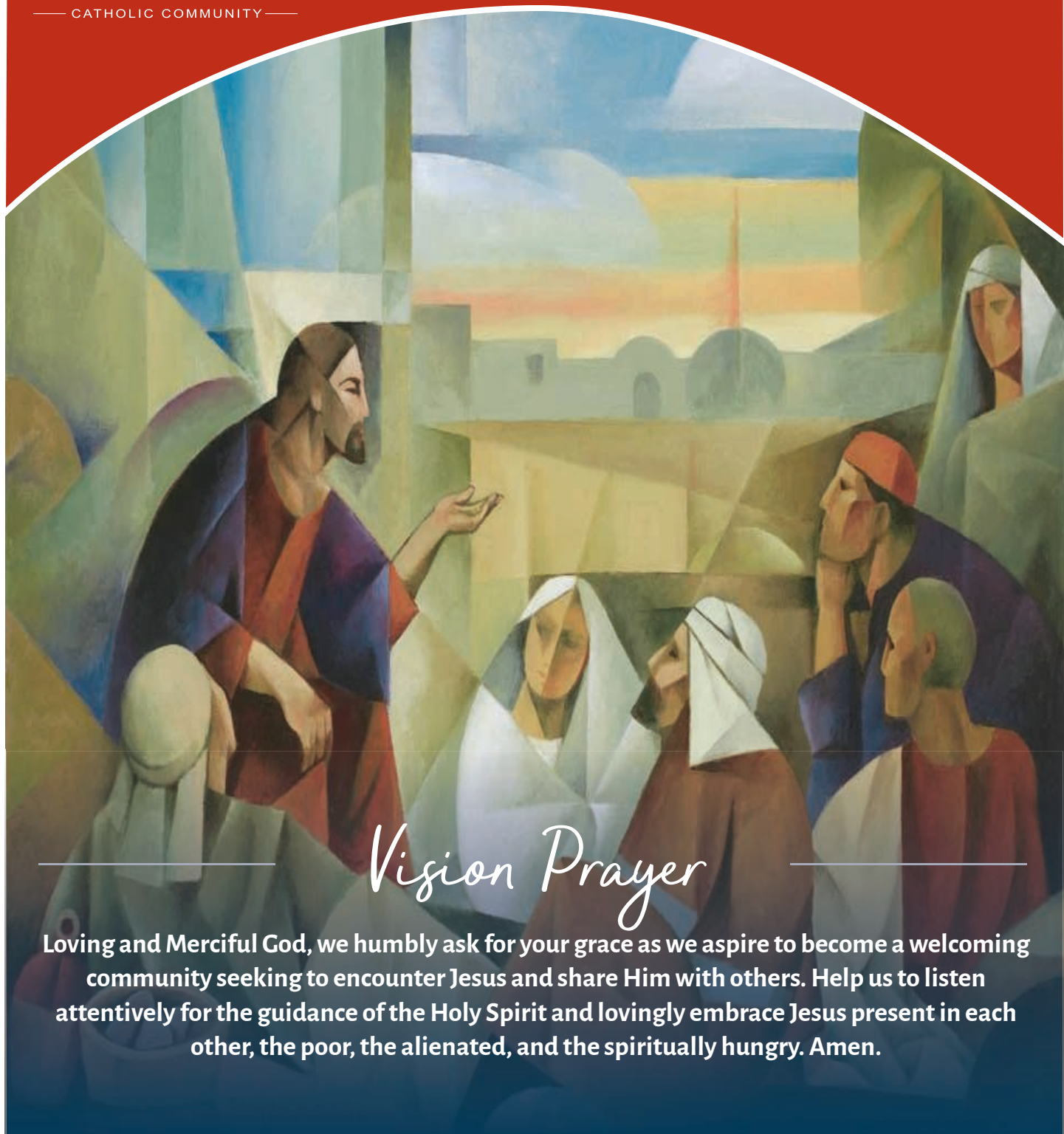

To register, visit www.parish.stnorbert.org and click the *Register with Us* page under the *About* tab to complete the on-line Parish Registration form (<https://www.osvhub.com/stnorbert/directory/register>). The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Friends,

Today's parable presents a message of great hope to those who find it difficult to follow the will of God. Jesus is in Jerusalem, exchanging words with the Pharisees. They have tried to trap him by asking where he gets his authority. Our Lord, in his wit, turns it back to them. He asks them a question that causes them to accuse themselves of lacking fidelity to God. Jesus is looking for faith.

Faith is the attitude that searches for authority in life higher than one's own. When God calls us to live his will, we should, in faith, accept it and live it. Even if it seems inconvenient or uncomfortable, we should not look for ways to live outside it. We must bypass inauthentic outlooks on life.

To understand this Gospel passage, we must try to rid ourselves of the "modern mentality." In the modern mentality, we do whatever we please if we don't step on anyone else's toes. Jesus proposes a different mentality. Jesus suggests that we not only listen to but also do the will of God in our lives. Neither son in this parable was perfectly in tune with Christ's suggestion, but at least one of the sons came to his senses and repented for his stubbornness of heart.

Many of us reading through this scene would congratulate Jesus for putting down his enemies. We would toss confetti at the Lord for his wisdom and knowledge in escaping this predicament. This, though, wasn't the case. Jesus felt it as a loss. He didn't care about appearing better than the others. He left saddened because he genuinely desired the Pharisees believe him and accept his saving message. We ought not to try to shine over our foes. Instead, we should work hard to help them see the light.

Let's ask our Lord for the gifts of humility and honesty so that we will be aware of the ways we refuse to say yes to God's will. And pray for the strength to turn back to him every day.

Amigos,

La parábola de hoy presenta un mensaje de gran esperanza para quienes tienen dificultades para seguir la voluntad de Dios. Jesús está en Jerusalén, intercambiando palabras con los fariseos. Éstos han intentado tenderle una trampa preguntándole de dónde saca su autoridad. Nuestro Señor, con su ingenio, se la devuelve. Les hace una pregunta que los lleva a acusarse de falta de fidelidad a Dios. Jesús busca la fe.

La fe es la actitud que busca en la vida una autoridad superior a la propia. Cuando Dios nos llama a vivir su voluntad, debemos, con fe, aceptarla y vivirla. Aunque nos parezca inconveniente o incómoda, no debemos buscar la manera de vivir al margen de ella. Debemos evitar las perspectivas inauténticas de la vida.

Para entender este pasaje del Evangelio, debemos intentar librarnos de la "mentalidad moderna". En la mentalidad moderna, hacemos lo que nos da la gana si no pisamos a nadie. Jesús propone una mentalidad diferente. Jesús sugiere que no sólo escuchemos, sino que hagamos la voluntad de Dios en nuestras vidas. Ninguno de los hijos de esta parábola estaba en perfecta sintonía con la sugerencia de Cristo, pero al menos uno de los hijos entró en razón y se arrepintió de su terquedad de corazón.

Muchos de nosotros, al leer esta escena, felicitaríamos a Jesús por haber acabado con sus enemigos. Lanzaríamos confeti al Señor por su sabiduría y conocimiento para escapar de este aprieto. Pero no fue así. Jesús lo sintió como una pérdida. No le importaba parecer mejor que los demás. Se marchó entristecido porque deseaba de verdad que los fariseos le creyeran y aceptaran su mensaje salvador. No debemos tratar de brillar por encima de nuestros enemigos. Por el contrario, debemos esforzarnos por ayudarles a ver la luz.

Pidamos a nuestro Señor los dones de la humildad y la honestidad para que seamos conscientes de las formas en que nos negamos a decir sí a la voluntad de Dios. Y recemos para tener las fuerzas para volver a Él cada día.
