

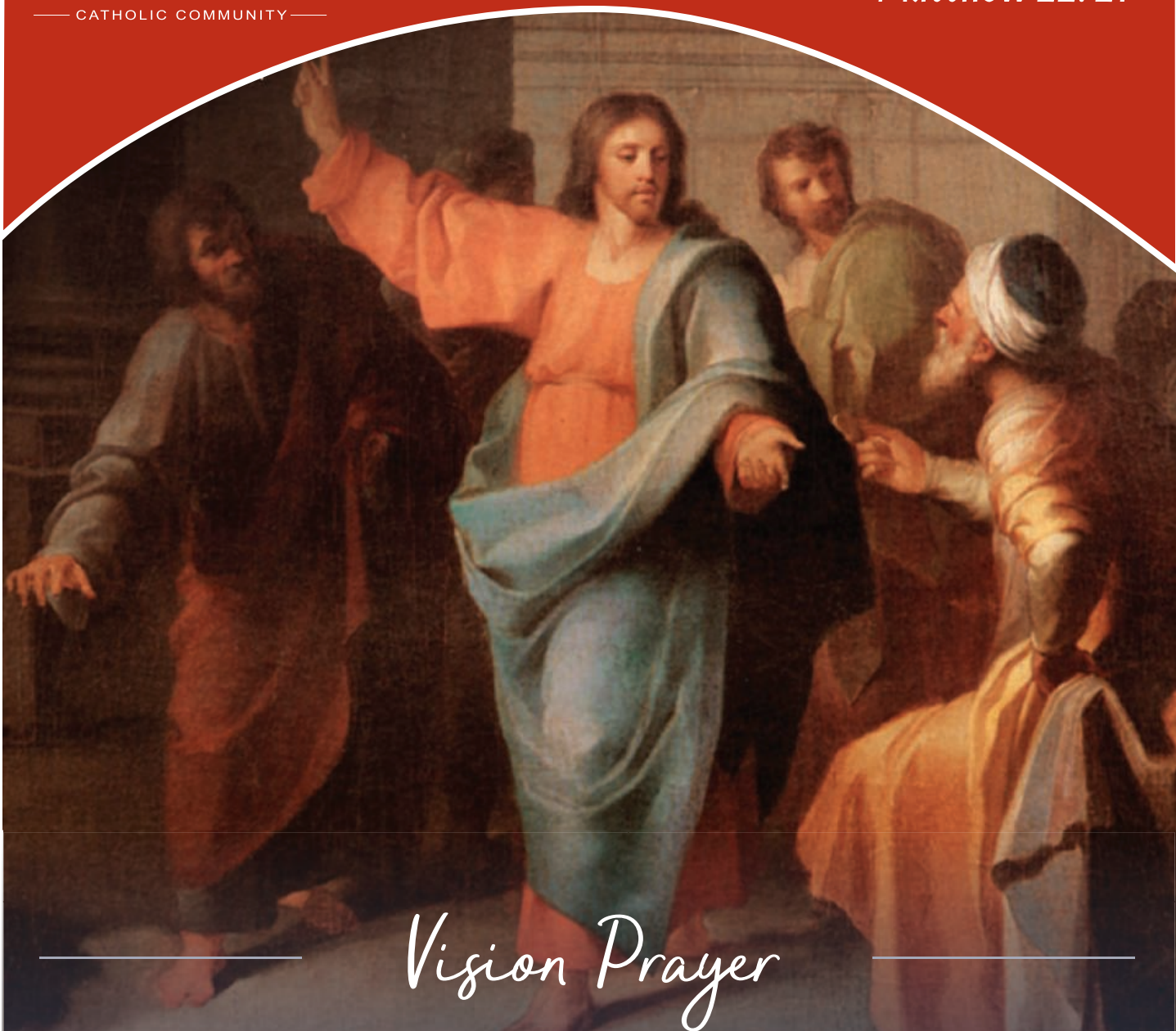

The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

### Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

### Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

### Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

### Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

### Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Friends,

The Pharisees were trying to trap Jesus with this question about paying taxes. Their opposition to Him was mounting. Jesus didn't humiliate them with his answer. He simply invited them to give to God what belongs to God. Although it's not included in today's reading, Matthew's passage's last line of this section tells us, "When they heard this, they were amazed, and leaving him they went away" (Matthew 22:22).

Were they amazed because they wondered what belonged to God? We can ask the same question today, "What belongs to God?" Specific things belong to God for what they are: Sundays, an object consecrated for sacred use only, or things owed to God by pure justice, like gratitude, praise, obedience, etc. There are also things that belong to God because we freely choose to give them, like our time, talent, and sacrifices.

Take a moment and consider what kinds of things we have chosen to give to God. To make a gift not rooted in justice or duty is an act of generosity and love. Perhaps you've shared some of your belongings with God. Maybe you've given your talent to Jesus. Or have you contributed your time?

Conversely, are there things you have given to God that you keep retracting? Look at these also and talk to Jesus about it. Ask for the grace to again place them in Jesus's loving, open hands.

Everything we have belongs to God. Loving God by giving him our thoughts, words, actions, time, talents, and sufferings is an act more beautiful than we realize. But when we bring those treasures into the light of God, he lets them shine. Handing them to God makes them even more precious. So, giving God what belongs to him warrants a celebration because we don't lose out; instead, we receive it back in greater splendor, even one hundredfold.

You should have received a brochure & commitment card for our "Growing As Disciples, Sharing Our Gifts" program by now. Today begins "Commitment Weekend." I invite you to participate and help us respond to God's gift of love. More information will be provided during the Mass. Thank you for your generosity and support of St. Norbert Parish Community.

Amigos,

Los fariseos intentaban atrapar a Jesús con esta pregunta sobre el pago de impuestos. Su oposición a Él iba en aumento. Jesús no los humilló con su respuesta. Simplemente les invitó a dar a Dios lo que pertenece a Dios. Aunque no se incluye en la lectura de hoy, la última línea de esta sección del pasaje de Mateo nos dice: "Al oír esto, se asombraron, y dejándole, se fueron" (Mateo 22:22).

¿Se asombraban porque se preguntaban qué era de Dios? Hoy podemos hacernos la misma pregunta: "¿Qué pertenece a Dios?". Las cosas concretas pertenecen a Dios por lo que son: Los domingos, un objeto consagrado sólo para uso sagrado, o cosas debidas a Dios por pura justicia, como la gratitud, la alabanza, la obediencia, etc. También hay cosas que pertenecen a Dios porque elegimos libremente darlas, como nuestro tiempo, talento y sacrificios.

Tómate un momento y considera qué tipo de cosas hemos elegido dar a Dios. Hacer un regalo que no se basa en la justicia o el deber es un acto de generosidad y amor. Tal vez hayas compartido algunas de tus pertenencias con Dios. Tal vez hayas dado tu talento a Jesús. ¿O has contribuido con tu tiempo?

A la inversa, ¿hay cosas que has dado a Dios de las que te vas retractando? Míralas también y habla de ello con Jesús. Pídele la gracia de volver a ponerlas en las manos amorosas y abiertas de Jesús.

Todo lo que tenemos pertenece a Dios. Amar a Dios entregándole nuestros pensamientos, palabras, acciones, tiempo, talentos y sufrimientos es un acto más hermoso de lo que creemos. Pero cuando llevamos esos tesoros a la luz de Dios, Él los hace brillar. Entregárselos a Dios los hace aún más preciosos. Por eso, dar a Dios lo que le pertenece merece una celebración, porque no salimos perdiendo, sino que lo recibimos de vuelta en mayor esplendor, incluso multiplicado cien veces más.
