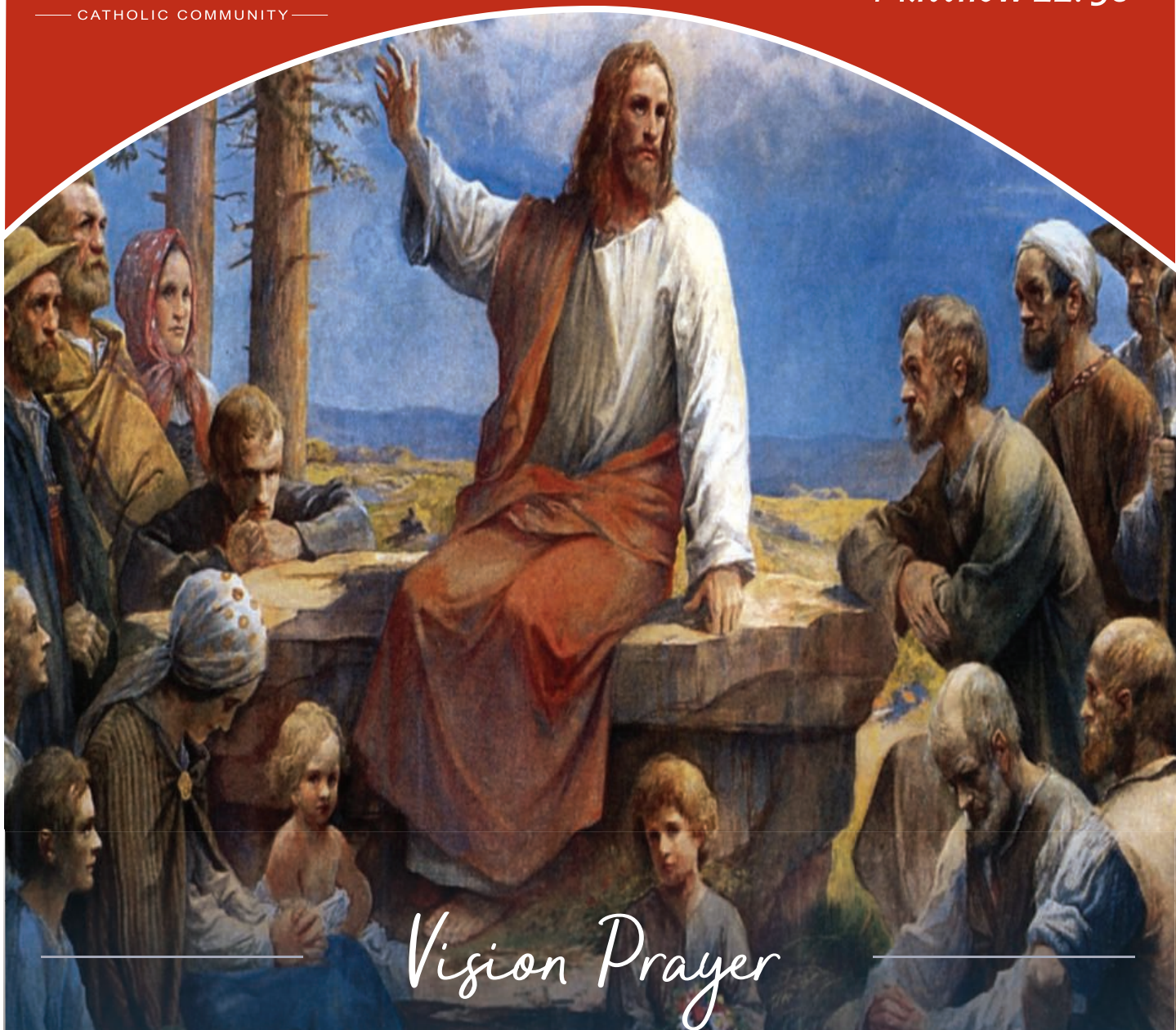

## Welcome to St. Norbert Parish

To register, visit [www.parish.stnorbert.org](http://www.parish.stnorbert.org) and click the *Register with Us* page under the *About* tab to complete the on-line Parish Registration form (<https://www.osvhub.com/stnorbert/directory/register>). The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

### Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

### Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

### Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

### Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

### Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

### Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

Jesus responds to the question about which of the commandments is the greatest. First, turning to Deuteronomy 6:15: "You shall love the Lord your God ..." This was familiar to the Jewish people, for they recited this passage in prayer (called the "Shema") several times a day and wrote it on all their doorposts. For us and the Jewish people, it's a constant reminder that God must be first in our lives. As our creator and redeemer, we owe him everything. Everything we have is a gift from him. Putting God first means setting aside the best part of our day for prayer and seeking to live his will every moment out of love for him.

Jesus next turns to the commandment found in Leviticus 19:18: "You shall love your neighbor ..." He combines the two commandments, not one without the other. There can be no love of God without loving our neighbor. And love of neighbor cannot exist without a pure and purifying love for God. Love for neighbor means putting others ahead of ourselves. Being "other-centered" is the key to our happiness. To love others means to seek their good, to serve them out of love for the Lord. We need to come out of ourselves and look beyond the interests of our egoism and self-love. The more we love authentically, the more fulfilled our life will become.

It's not easy to break out of selfish habits. Because of sin, we tend to inflate self-interest in a disordered way. Let's ask for the grace to purify our hearts and give us the interior strength to put others ahead of ourselves. God is ready to give us grace but won't force it on us. Difficult circumstances need to be faced by prayer and sacrifice. We need to pray even for those who we vehemently disagree with. Pray that we may rid ourselves of all selfishness and for a heart that is open to the infinite power of God's transforming touch.

Amigos,

Jesús responde a la pregunta sobre cuál de los mandamientos es el más importante. En primer lugar, vuelve a Deuteronomio 6,15: "Amarás al Señor tu Dios...". Esto era familiar para el pueblo judío, pues recitaban este pasaje en la oración (llamada el "Shema") varias veces al día y lo escribían en todos los postes de sus puertas. Para nosotros y para el pueblo judío, es un recordatorio constante de que Dios debe ser lo primero en nuestras vidas. Como creador y redentor, se lo debemos todo. Todo lo que tenemos es un regalo suyo. Poner a Dios en primer lugar significa dedicar la mejor parte del día a la oración y tratar de vivir su voluntad en todo momento por amor a Él.

A continuación, Jesús se refiere al mandamiento de Levítico 19,18: "Amarás a tu prójimo...". Combina los dos mandamientos, no uno sin el otro. No puede haber amor a Dios sin amar al prójimo. Y el amor al prójimo no puede existir sin un amor puro y purificador a Dios. El amor al prójimo significa poner a los demás por delante de nosotros mismos. Estar "centrados en los demás" es la clave de nuestra felicidad. Amar a los demás significa buscar su bien, servirles por amor al Señor. Necesitamos salir de nosotros mismos y mirar más allá de los intereses de nuestro egoísmo y amor propio. Cuanto más amemos auténticamente, más plena será nuestra vida.

No es fácil salir de los hábitos egoístas. A causa del pecado, tendemos a aumentar el interés propio de forma desordenada. Pidamos que la gracia purifique nuestros corazones y nos dé la fuerza interior para poner a los demás por delante de nosotros mismos. Dios está dispuesto a darnos la gracia, pero no nos la impondrá. Las circunstancias difíciles hay que afrontarlas con oración y sacrificio. Tenemos que rezar incluso por aquellos con los que discrepamos impetuosamente. Oremos para librarnos de todo egoísmo y para tener un corazón abierto al poder infinito del toque transformador de Dios.
