## Welcome to St. Norbert Parish

The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

### Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

### Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

### Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

### Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

### Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

### Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

Our five senses can be a window into the soul. Our senses help us perceive the world around us and guide our decisions. The five wise virgins in today's parable represent those using their five senses to do God's will, whereas the five foolish virgins indulge their five senses in a life of sin

With our eyes, we're called to perceive the beauty of God's presence in the world, especially in other people. With our ears, we hear the Word of God proclaimed, inspiring the gift of faith. Our senses of smell, taste, and touch can lead us to the delights of the Kingdom of God or to the indulgences of the fallen world.

The holy use of the five senses can be seen as the connection between virgins and the oil for their lamps. View the oil as a symbol of good works or charity. Charity is necessary for attaining Heaven and being ready for Jesus when he comes. Their five senses are constantly seeking ways to accomplish God's holy will.

The five senses can also easily lead us to the selfish pursuit of fleshly pleasures. Think of the virgins whose oil runs out. Are you the wise or foolish virgin? What do you look at regularly? Do you seek the presence of God? Do you see Him in the poor, the vulnerable, the lonely, and the needy? Or do you allow temptation to draw you away from God?

With your ears, do you listen attentively to the Word of God? Or do you find yourself drawn to gossip and other sinful spoken words? Do you indulge your senses of touch, smell, and taste, choosing excessive pleasure? Or do you strive for temperance and self-control?

Today, examine the ways you use your five senses. Keep guard of your senses, and only allow the good things of Heaven into your heart. Doing so will produce the oil of charity within and enable you to be perpetually ready for the coming of our Lord.

Amigos,

Nuestros cinco sentidos pueden ser una ventana al alma. Nuestros sentidos nos ayudan a percibir el mundo que nos rodea y guían nuestras decisiones. Las cinco vírgenes prudentes de la parábola de hoy representan a quienes utilizan sus cinco sentidos para hacer la voluntad de Dios, mientras que las cinco vírgenes insensatas se entregan a sus cinco sentidos en una vida de pecado.

Con nuestros ojos, estamos llamados a percibir la belleza de la presencia de Dios en el mundo, especialmente en otras personas. Con los oídos, oímos la proclamación de la Palabra de Dios, que inspira el don de la fe. Nuestros sentidos del olfato, el gusto y el tacto pueden conducirnos a las delicias del Reino de Dios o a las indulgencias del mundo caído.

El uso santo de los cinco sentidos puede verse como la conexión entre las vírgenes y el aceite para sus lámparas. El aceite es un símbolo de las buenas obras o de la caridad. La caridad es necesaria para alcanzar el Cielo y estar preparadas para recibir a Jesús cuando venga. Sus cinco sentidos buscan constantemente la manera de cumplir la santa voluntad de Dios.

Los cinco sentidos también pueden llevarnos fácilmente a la búsqueda egoísta de los placeres carnales. Piensa en las vírgenes a las que se le acaba el aceite. ¿Eres tú la virgen prudente o la necia? ¿Qué miras con regularidad? ¿Buscas la presencia de Dios? ¿Ves a Dios en los pobres, los vulnerables, los solitarios y los necesitados? ¿O permites que la tentación te aleje de Dios?

Con tus oídos, ¿escuchas atentamente la Palabra de Dios? ¿O te dejas llevar por los chismes y otras palabras pecaminosas? ¿Disfrutas de tus sentidos del tacto, el olfato y el gusto, eligiendo el placer excesivo? ¿O te esfuerzas por tener templanza y autocontrol?

Examina hoy cómo utilizas tus cinco sentidos. Vigila tus sentidos, y sólo permite que entren en tu corazón las cosas buenas del Cielo. De este modo, obtendrás el óleo de la caridad y estarás siempre preparado para la venida del Señor.

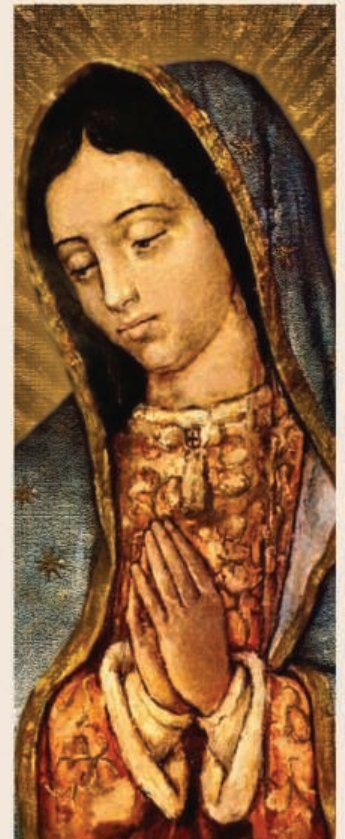

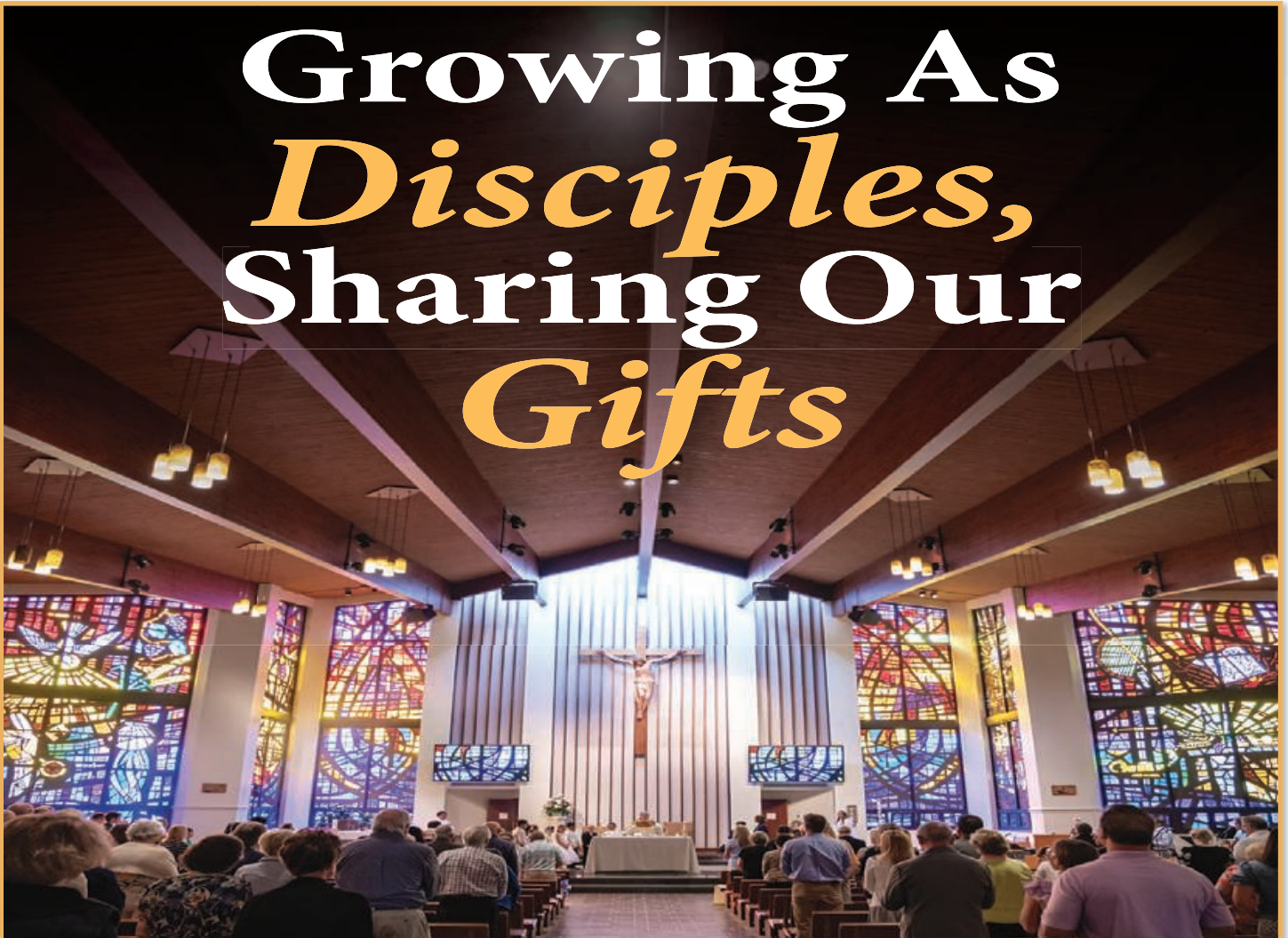
