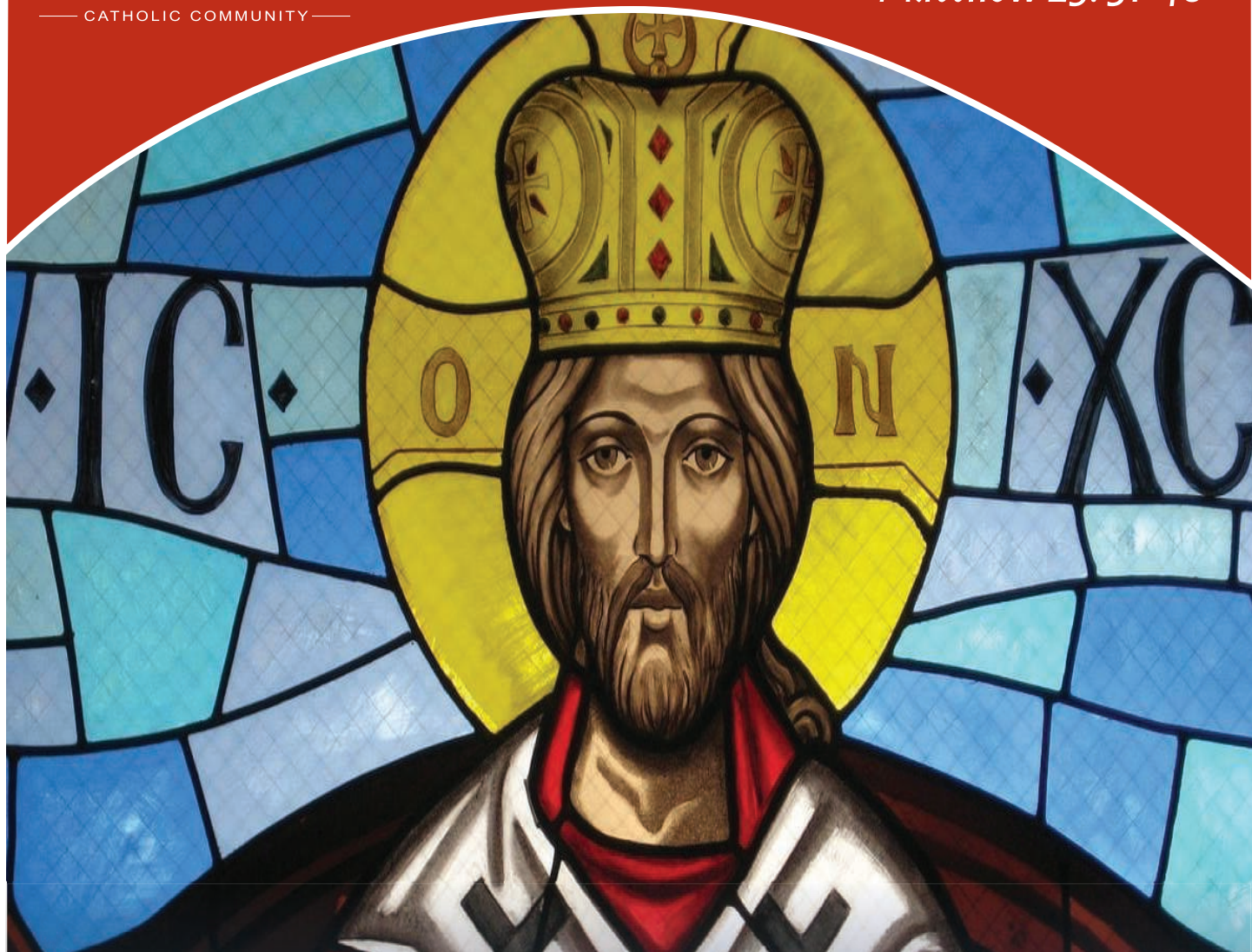

Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

The Solemnity of Christ the King is celebrated today and is relatively new. The Church has existed for almost 2000 years, but this Solemnity is less than 100 years old. It was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925.

He explained his reasons for doing so in an encyclical letter called "Quas Primas."

- He explained that throughout history, liturgical feasts have been instituted in response to particular needs arising in the life of the world and the Church.
- He gives the example of the feasts in honor of the martyrs.
- And then explains which need this new celebration addresses.
- He wrote this encyclical in 1925 when the world was still trying to recover from World War I, which had devastated Europe and shattered hopes for unlimited progress based solely on human reason.
- 1925 was also only a few years after the Russian Bolshevik Revolution, which had given birth to the world's first explicitly atheist totalitarian regime: Soviet communism.
- Everywhere the pope looked, he saw human societies abandoning Christian values and trying to build paradise on earth through other means.

But if humanity had been able to perfect itself without God's help, then Jesus Christ would never have come to earth. Jesus brought his Gospel and grace to a fallen race, and only by believing in that Gospel and accepting that grace can individuals and societies achieve true and lasting peace and prosperity.

Pope Pius XI instituted today's Solemnity to remind the world that to reject Christ in private or public life is to reject our only hope, and to accept him is to accept salvation.

Today, our world is troubled more than ever. How about this: With every Our Father, we pray, "Thy Kingdom Come." The Kingdom began with Christ preaching it and grows even today. Charity and justice are the ways we can help Christ's Kingdom spread. His Kingdom is a conquest of hearts, starting with ours. We should go out and, through our justice and charity, help him conquer the hearts of the whole world.

Amigos,

La solemnidad de Cristo Rey se celebra hoy y es relativamente nueva. La Iglesia existe desde hace aproximadamente 2000 años, pero esta solemnidad tiene menos de 100 años. Fue establecida por el Papa Pío XI en 1925.

Explicó sus razones para hacerlo en una carta encíclica llamada "Quas Primas".

- Explicó que, a lo largo de la historia, las fiestas litúrgicas se han instituido en respuesta a necesidades particulares surgidas en la vida del mundo y de la Iglesia.
- Pone el ejemplo de las fiestas en honor de los mártires.
- Y luego explica a qué necesidad responde esta nueva celebración.
- Escribió esta encíclica en 1925, cuando el mundo aún intentaba recuperarse de la Primera Guerra Mundial, que había devastado Europa y destrozado las esperanzas de un progreso ilimitado basado únicamente en la razón humana.
- 1925 fue también pocos años después de la Revolución Rusa Bolshevik, que había dado origen al primer régimen totalitario explícitamente ateo del mundo: El comunismo Soviético.
- Mirara donde mirara, el Papa veía que las sociedades humanas abandonaban los valores Cristianos e intentaban construir el paraíso en la tierra por otros medios.

Pero si la humanidad hubiera sido capaz de perfeccionarse sin la ayuda de Dios, entonces Jesucristo nunca habría venido a la tierra. Jesús trajo su Evangelio y su gracia a una raza caída, y sólo creyendo en ese Evangelio y aceptando esa gracia pueden los individuos y las sociedades alcanzar una paz y una prosperidad verdaderas y duraderas.

El Papa Pío XI instituyó la solemnidad de hoy para recordar al mundo que rechazar a Cristo en la vida privada o pública es rechazar nuestra única esperanza, y aceptarlo es aceptar la salvación.

Hoy, nuestro mundo está más perturbado que nunca. ¿Qué les parece esto? Con cada Padre Nuestro, rezamos: "Venga a nosotros tu Reino". El Reino comenzó con la predicación de Cristo y crece aún hoy. La caridad y la justicia son las formas en que podemos ayudar a que se extienda el Reino de Cristo. Su Reino es una conquista de los corazones, empezando por el nuestro. Debemos salir y, con nuestra justicia y caridad, ayudarle a conquistar los corazones de todo el mundo.
