Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Friends,

The prophets teach us that it is not enough for the Lord to make a beeline toward us. We must clear a straight path toward him and help others reach him. Our sins are the roadblocks and setbacks in the journey.

In today's First Reading, Isaiah reminds us that we can help the Lord reach us or hinder him, but he is coming one way or the other. From the Fall to the Incarnation, salvation history was a long and twisted road. Mankind was lost in sin and groping in the dark to regain its bearings. The Lord's interventions before coming in Person were all to keep people moving and facing in the right direction, with mixed results. They expected to meet him at the end, not during the journey.

Today, the Lord tells Isaiah to encourage Israel after all their struggle and difficulty with the good news that not only are they getting closer, but the Lord is coming closer to them to help them along the way. They've paid the price for their sins and are ready to be reconciled with the Lord.

With all the imagery of making a straight path, filling in the valleys, and leveling the peaks, the Lord encourages them to make a beeline for him and build a direct way to him. A direct path between two people is suitable for both.

In the Incarnation and Birth of Our Lord, for which we're preparing, we meet Our Lord on the way, and he makes the way easier and accompanies us. The mountains and valleys inhibit God's grace from traveling into our hearts; they are roadblocks that keep out God's mercy, peace, and wisdom.

Advent is the season to smooth out and clear up the roads to our hearts. Christ wants to help us do that, as he will prove again during today's Mass. When we receive him in Holy Communion, let's promise we'll give him that chance.
