## Welcome to St. Norbert Parish

### Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

### Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

### Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

### Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

### Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

### Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

"A voice proclaims: In the wilderness, prepare the way of the LORD! Make straight in the wasteland a highway for our God!" In the preceding passage, Saint John the Baptist quotes Isaiah 40:3: This was a prophecy of Isaiah speaking about the return of the Jewish exiles from Babylon back to Jerusalem. Usually, people would travel along the well-watered routes from Mesopotamia to Israel. Those routes were safer and provided the necessary food and water for the journey. But Isaiah prophesied that the Jewish exiles would travel the shortest route- straight across the desert- and that God would provide for their needs during that journey. Such a journey required much trust in the providence of God.

John the Baptist was called to cry out in the desert and point people directly to the Messiah. It was in the desert that they would discover their Savior. His message is for those who experience dryness, destitution, need, and loss in life due to sin. His message of repentance is first for those without God's spiritual nourishment. The news of John is pointed to those who humbly see the difficult situation faced in life and acknowledge their need for the Living Water of the Savior.

This new "straight" way implies that many aren't walking the direct path to Christ. Instead, they are taking unnecessary detours in life. John's message calls everyone to the straight and direct way of repenting their sins so they can come to faith in Christ Jesus. Walking through the desert requires trust in God's providence. It takes courage and confidence in the providence of God, who promises to meet our needs.

Advent is a time to reexamine the road you're on. Are you trying to find your own way to happiness? If so, listen to the "voice of one crying out in the wilderness." Saint John calls you to live more simply, to a greater detachment, abandoning all that is not of God, and to a more willing trust in the providence of God to lead you.

Amigos,

"Una voz proclama: ¡En el desierto, prepara el camino del Señor! Enderezar en el páramo una vía para nuestro Dios". En el pasaje anterior, San Juan Bautista cita Isaías 40:3: Se trata de una profecía de Isaías que habla del regreso de los judíos exiliados de Babilonia a Jerusalén. Normalmente, la gente viajaba por las rutas bien irrigadas de Mesopotamia a Israel. Esas rutas eran más seguras y proporcionaban la comida y el agua necesarias para el viaje. Pero Isaías profetizó que los judíos exiliados viajarían por la ruta más corta -directamente a través del desierto- y que Dios proveería de sus necesidades durante ese viaje. Un viaje así requería mucha confianza en la providencia de Dios.

Juan el Bautista fue llamado a clamar en el desierto y señalar a la gente directamente al Mesías. Era en el desierto donde descubrirían a su Salvador. Su mensaje es para aquellos que experimentan sequedad, indigencia, necesidad y pérdida en la vida debido al pecado. Su mensaje de arrepentimiento es primero para los que carecen del alimento espiritual de Dios. La noticia de Juan se dirige a los que ven con humildad la difícil situación que afrontan en la vida y reconocen su necesidad del Agua Viva del Salvador.

Este nuevo camino "recto" implica que muchos no están caminando por la senda directa hacia Cristo. En su lugar, están tomando desvíos innecesarios en la vida. El mensaje de Juan llama a todos al camino recto y directo del arrepentimiento de sus pecados para que puedan llegar a la fe en Cristo Jesús. Caminar por el desierto requiere confianza en la providencia de Dios. Requiere valor y confianza en la providencia de Dios, que promete satisfacer nuestras necesidades.

El Adviento es un tiempo para reexaminar el camino que estás recorriendo. ¿Intentas encontrar tu propio camino hacia la felicidad? Si es así, escucha la "voz del que clama en el desierto". San Juan te llama a vivir con más sencillez, a un mayor desprendimiento, abandonando todo lo que no es de Dios, y a una confianza más dispuesta en la providencia de Dios para que te guíe.

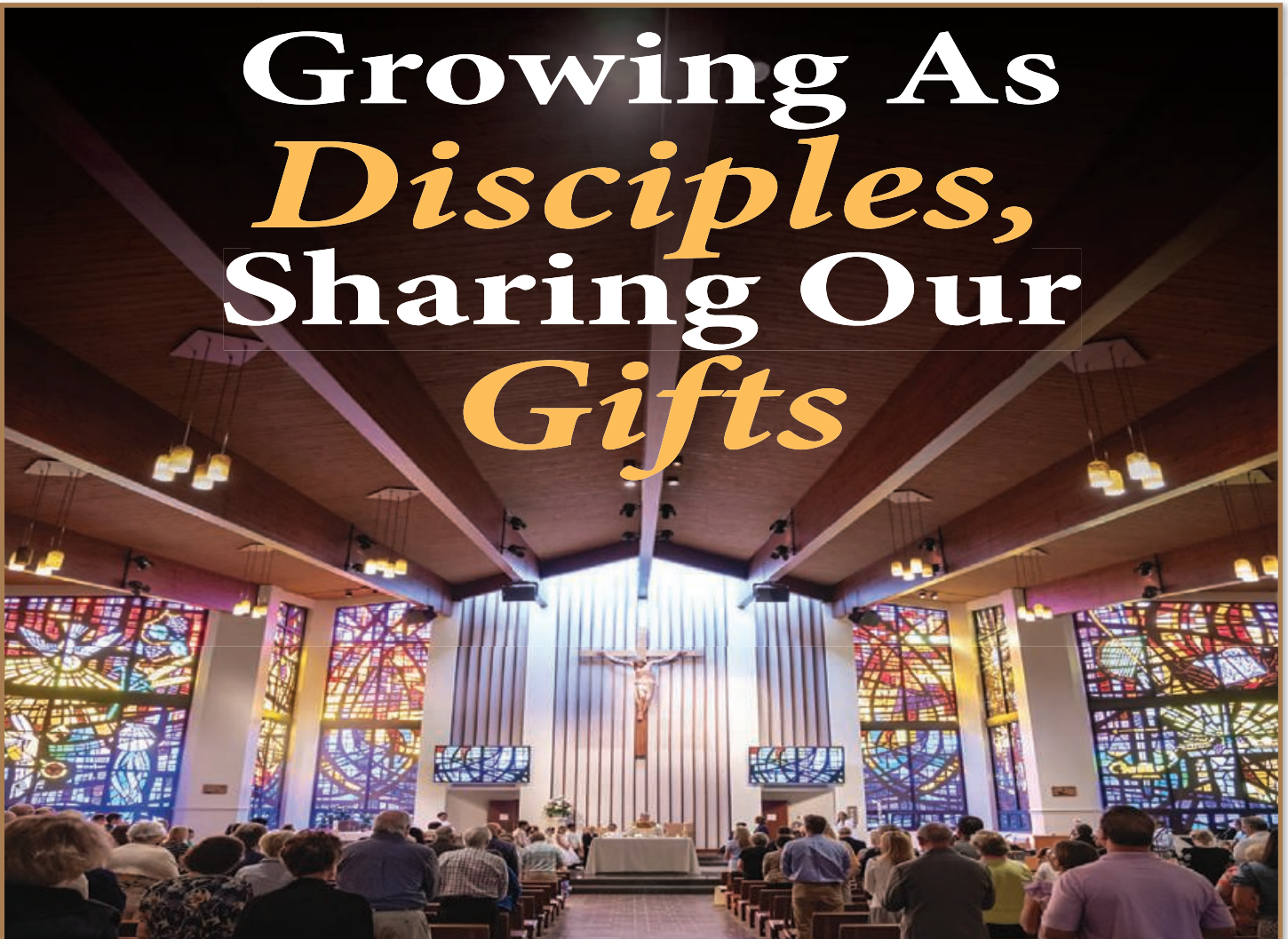
