

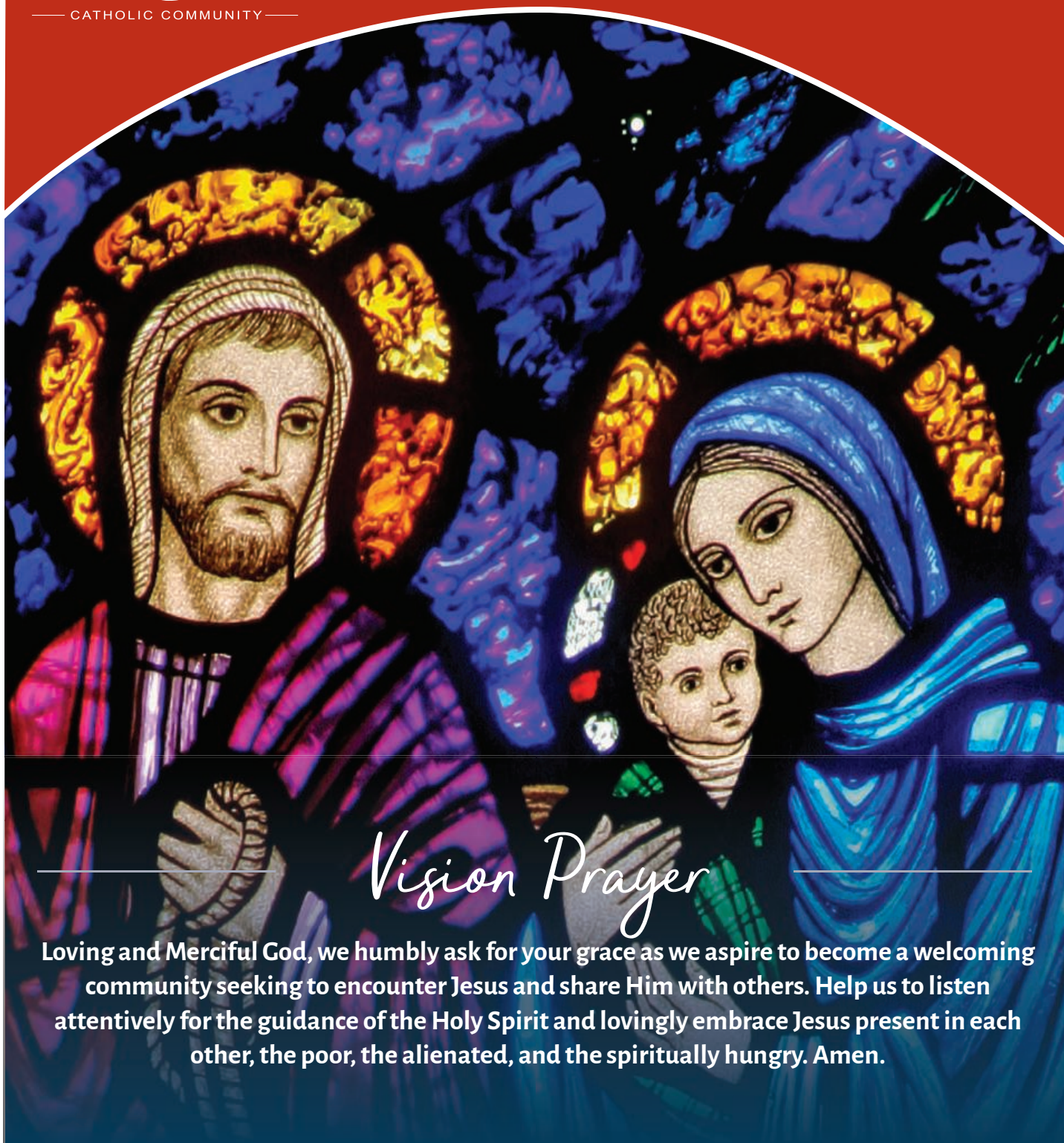

Welcome to St. Norbert Parish

To register, visit www.parish.stnorbert.org and click the *Register with Us* page under the *About* tab to complete the on-line Parish Registration form (<https://www.osvhub.com/stnorbert/directory/register>). The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

Today, we honor family life by pausing to ponder the particular and beautiful hidden life within the home of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. In many ways, their daily life together would have been similar to other families at that time. But in different ways, their life together is unique and provides a perfect model for all families.

By God's providence and design, the family life of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph was spoken of very little in the Scripture. We read of the birth of Jesus, the presentation in the Temple, the flight into Egypt, and the finding of Jesus in the Temple at age twelve. But other than these stories of their life together, we know very little.

In the Gospel, this family "fulfilled all the prescriptions of the law of the Lord...".

Family life, just like our individual lives, must be ordered by the laws of our Lord. The primary law of the Lord regarding family life is that it must share in the unity and "communion of love" found in the Holy Trinity. Each person of the Trinity has perfect respect for the other, gives selflessly to each other without reserve, and receives each person in their totality. Their love makes them one and enables them to act together in perfect harmony as a communion of divine Persons.

Today, think of your own closest relationships. If you're blessed with a close family, ponder them. If not, think of the persons in your life who you're called to love with familial love. Who are you to be there for in good times and in bad? Who are you to sacrifice yourself for without reserve? Who are you to offer respect, compassion, time, mercy, and every other virtue? And how well do you fulfill this duty of love? Reflect today on the fact that God wants you to share in a communion of life, not only with the Most Holy Trinity but also with those around you, especially your family.

Hoy honramos la vida familiar deteniéndonos a reflexionar sobre la hermosa y particular vida en el hogar de Jesús, María y José. En muchos aspectos, su vida cotidiana en común habría sido similar a la de otras familias de aquella época. Pero en otros aspectos, su vida en común es única y constituye un modelo perfecto para todas las familias.

Por providencia y designio de Dios, en las Escrituras se habla muy poco de la vida familiar de Jesús, María y José. Leemos sobre el nacimiento de Jesús, la presentación en el Templo, la huida a Egipto y el hallazgo de Jesús en el Templo a los doce años. Pero aparte de estos relatos de su vida en común, sabemos muy poco.

En el Evangelio, esta familia "cumplía todas las prescripciones de la ley del Señor...".

La vida familiar, al igual que nuestra vida individual, debe estar ordenada por las leyes del Señor. La primera ley del Señor respecto a la vida familiar es que ésta debe participar de la unidad y de la "comunidad de amor" que se da en la Santísima Trinidad. Cada una de las personas de la Trinidad respeta perfectamente a la otra, se da desinteresadamente sin reservas y la recibe en su totalidad. Su amor los hace uno y les permite actuar juntos en perfecta armonía como comunión de Personas divinas.

Hoy, piensa en tus relaciones más cercanas. Si has sido bendecido con una familia unida, reflexiona sobre ella. Si no, piensa en las personas de tu vida a las que estás llamado a amar con amor familiar. ¿A quién debes apoyar en los buenos y en los malos momentos? ¿Por quién debes sacrificar sin reservas? ¿A quién debes ofrecer respeto, compasión, tiempo, misericordia y cualquier otra virtud? ¿Y en qué medida cumples este deber de amor? Reflexiona hoy sobre el hecho de que Dios quiere que participes en una comunión de vida, no sólo con la Santísima Trinidad, sino también con quienes te rodean, especialmente tu familia.

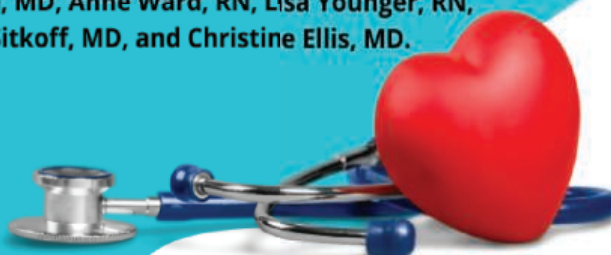


MEDICAL MISSION TRIP TO HONDURAS
