

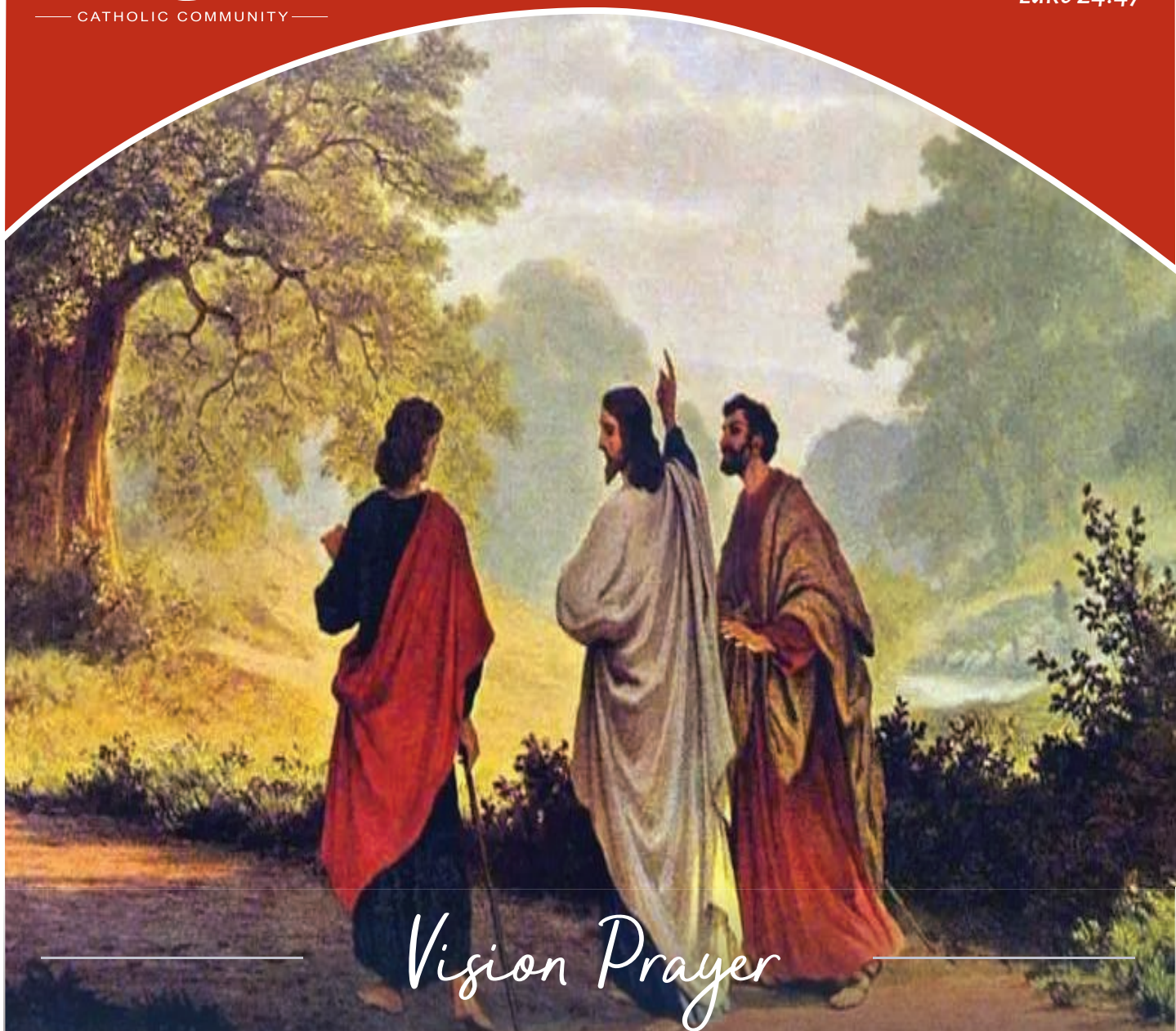

## Welcome to St. Norbert Parish

To register, visit [www.parish.stnorbert.org](http://www.parish.stnorbert.org) and click the *Register with Us* page under the *About* tab to complete the on-line Parish Registration form (<https://www.osvhub.com/stnorbert/directory/register>). The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

### Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

### Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

### Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

### Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

### Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

### Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

We all want to experience more deeply the newness of life that Christ's resurrection promises us. But this does not happen automatically; we have to let his grace penetrate and transform us. At least two things are necessary for that to happen...

First, St. Peter stressed in the First Reading that we must "repent and be converted." Today's Second Reading echoes that: "... Whoever keeps his word [i.e., avoiding sin], the love of God is truly perfected in him." If we want to put fresh honey in a jar, we first must clean out the smelly old leftovers we have been keeping there. The life of wisdom, courage, and joy that Christ brings us is the fresh honey, but to experience it, we need to confess our sins and renounce our selfish tendencies - not just once, but constantly. This is why the sacrament of confession should be a regular part of all our lives.

Prayer is our way of giving God the space He needs to work in our souls. During Lent, many of us dedicated more time to prayer attended Mass more frequently and read spiritual books. These disciplines enriched our daily lives. It's easy to be tempted to abandon them during the joyful Easter season, but that's exactly what the devil wants. God, on the other hand, wants us to continue growing in our faith.

At every Mass, Jesus shares with us His new life, His glorified, resurrected life, in Holy Communion. This is a profound gift that we should not take for granted. Let's express our gratitude to Him for this gift and ask for His guidance in putting His teachings into action throughout the week.

Amigos,

Todos queremos experimentar más profundamente la vida nueva que nos promete la resurrección de Cristo. Pero esto no sucede automáticamente; tenemos que dejar que su gracia penetre en nosotros y nos transforme. Para ello son necesarias al menos dos cosas.

En primer lugar, San Pedro subrayó en la Primera Lectura que debemos "arrepentirnos y convertirnos". En la Segunda Lectura de hoy se hace eco de ello: "Quien guarda su palabra [es decir, evitando el pecado], el amor de Dios se perfecciona verdaderamente en él". Si queremos poner miel fresca en un tarro, primero debemos limpiar los restos viejos y malolientes que hemos estado guardando allí. La vida de sabiduría, valentía y alegría que Cristo nos trae es la miel fresca, pero para experimentarla necesitamos confesar nuestros pecados y renunciar a nuestras tendencias egoístas, no sólo una vez, sino constantemente. Por eso, el sacramento de la confesión debe formar parte de nuestra vida

La oración es nuestro modo de dar a Dios el espacio que necesita para obrar en nuestras almas. Durante la Cuaresma, muchos de nosotros dedicamos más tiempo a la oración, asistimos a Misa con más frecuencia y leímos libros espirituales. Estas disciplinas enriquecieron nuestra vida cotidiana. Es fácil caer en la tentación de abandonarlas durante el tiempo alegre de Pascua, pero eso es exactamente lo que quiere el diablo. Dios, en cambio, quiere que sigamos creciendo en nuestra fe.

En cada Misa, Jesús comparte con nosotros su nueva vida, su vida glorificada y resucitada, en la Sagrada Comunión. Es un don profundo que no debemos dar por hecho. Expresémosle nuestra gratitud por este regalo y pidámosle que nos guíe para poner en práctica sus enseñanzas a lo largo de la semana.




