

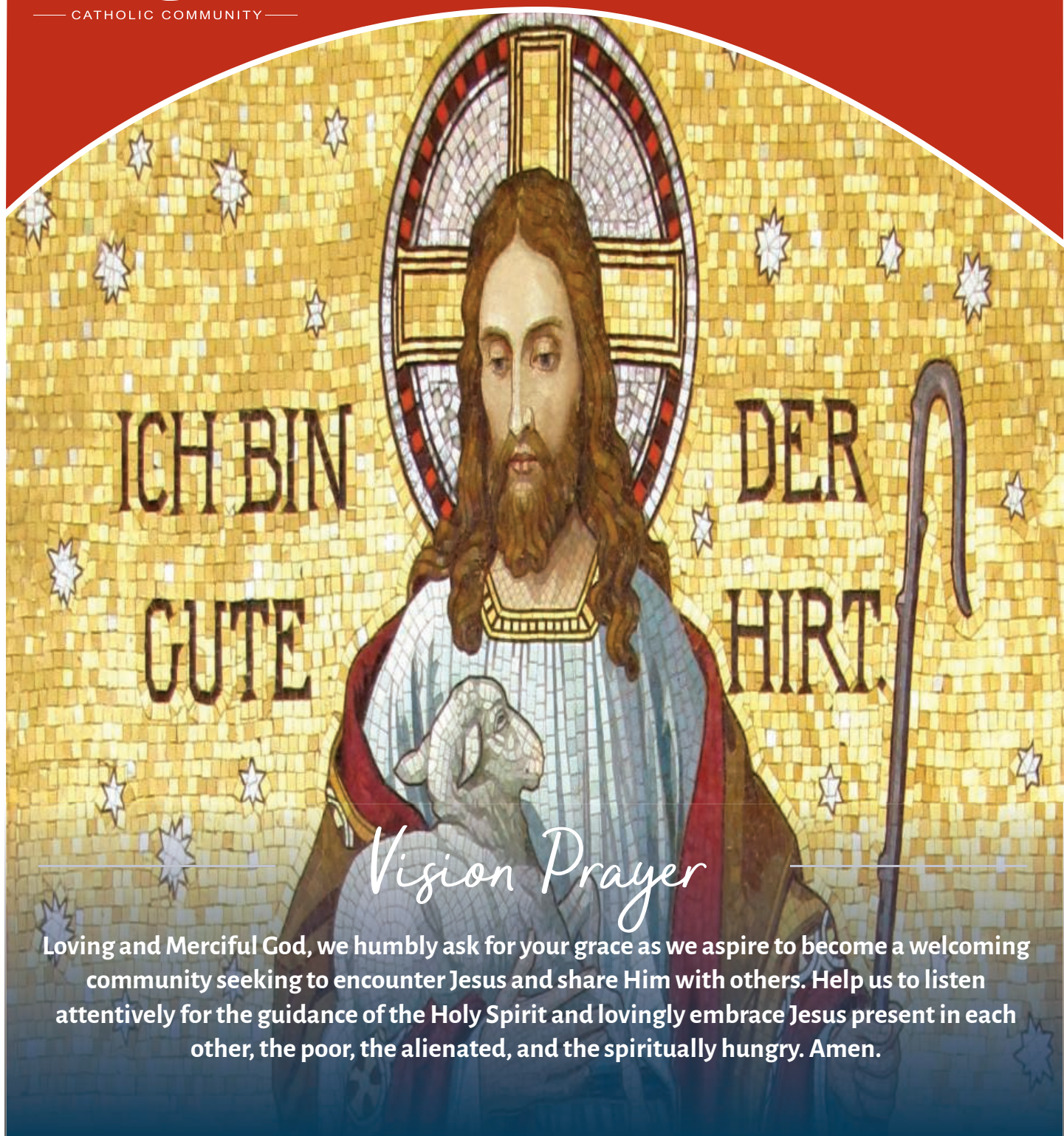

The Parish Registration form can also be picked up at the parish office.

### Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

### Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

### Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

### Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

### Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

### Prayer & Healing Ministry

The parish has a dedicated group of parishioners offering intercessory prayers upon request. If you have a special intention, please complete the Prayer Intentions form on the *Prayer* page under the *Faith Formation* tab of the parish website.

Friends,

Today, on the Fourth Sunday of Easter, we mark a significant occasion—Good Shepherd Sunday. This day holds a special place in our hearts as we reflect upon the tender image of Jesus as the Shepherd of us all. It's a day to pray for more shepherds within our Church who will shepherd God's flock with the Heart of Christ.

The Gospel explains why the Pharisees were not true shepherds. It was because they "work for pay" and have "no concern for the sheep." First, the "pay" these Pharisees worked for was their self-importance—a fleeting and worldly reward. They saw themselves as the true teachers and interpreters of the Law and saw anyone who did not follow them as a threat. The Pharisees perceived Jesus as a threat. Instead, they condemned this innocent and holy man out of their pride.

While God shepherds us today through His pastors, we're not mere recipients of His love. We are all called, without exception, to participate in this shepherding of the Good Shepherd in our own unique way. This call extends to all our lives: families, work, and school. We can live out our calling by prioritizing and loving others with the Shepherd's heart.

Reflect, today, on the Good Shepherd. Look to imitate the Shepherd's love in the Heart of Christ. Laying our lives down is not just an act of sacrificial love, but a transformative act that enables us to focus on the needs of those around us. Pride and selfishness must disappear, and the good of the other must become our only goal. Pray that the Good Shepherd will use you to shepherd those in your life who need it the most and see the profound impact it can have on your relationships and your own spiritual journey.
