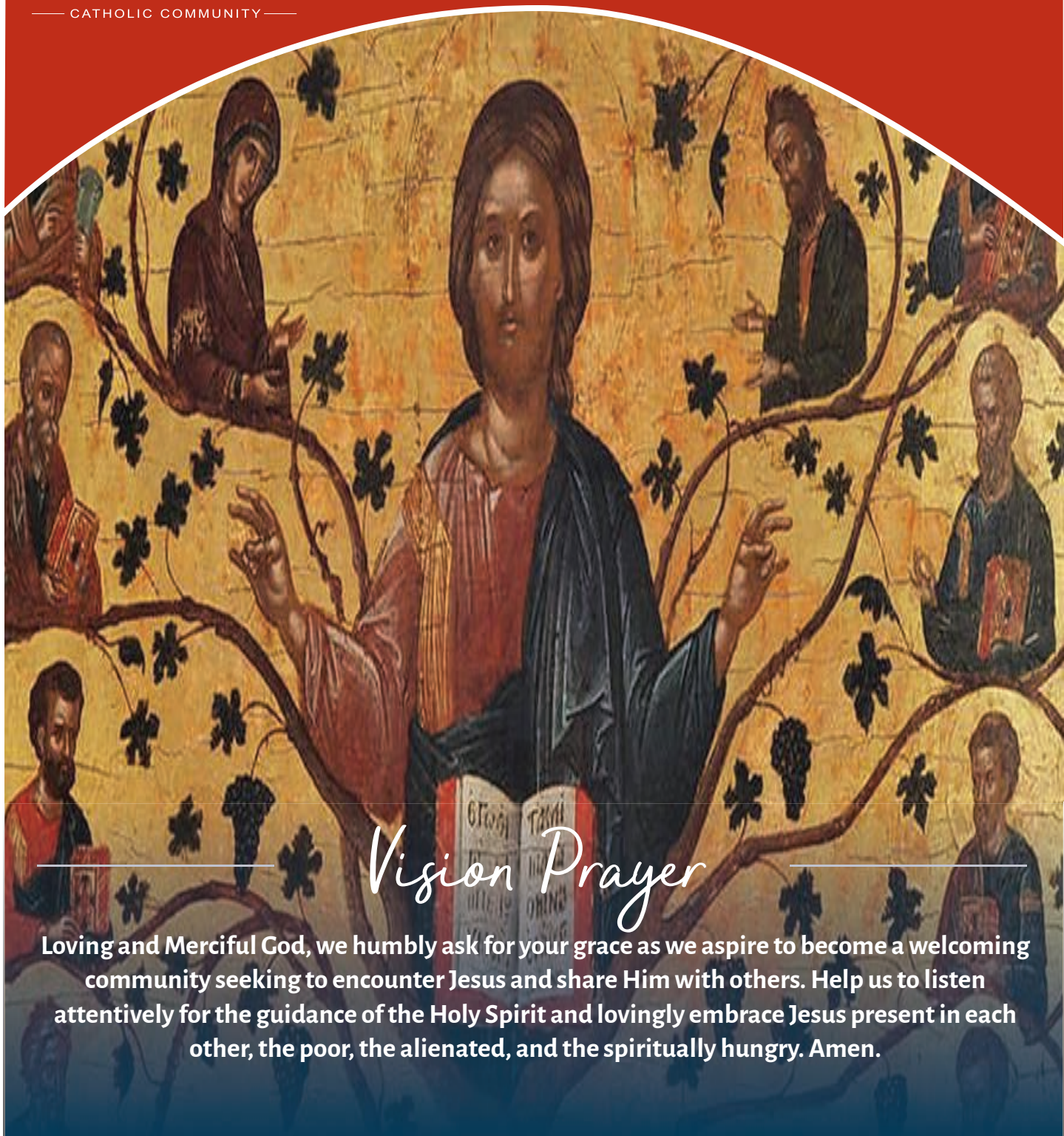

### Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

### Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

### Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

### Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

### Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

### Prayer & Healing Ministry

Friends,

The First Reading this Sunday tells us that the Apostles and disciples in Jerusalem were hesitant to welcome Saul into their community. Saul was the one who had been rounding up and persecuting the followers of Jesus. Perhaps they thought Saul was plotting to infiltrate and round them up to be killed. This is why Barnabas took charge of introducing Saul to the Apostles. Barnabas told them about Saul's experience with the risen Jesus on the way to Damascus and how he boldly proclaimed Jesus as the Messiah in the synagogues of Damascus. Saul wanted to spend time with the Apostles in Jerusalem but couldn't stay there long. He had to flee because people tried to kill him for now preaching the good news of Christ. Saul went from the persecutor to the persecuted very quickly.

The Christians in Jerusalem saved Saul by sending him to Tarsus. Saul would remain there until Barnabas brought him to minister to the Christian community in Antioch. This essentially launched Saul's mission: teaching and preaching the Gospel, proclaiming Jesus as the long-awaited Messiah, and fulfilling the Scriptures.

The Second Reading reaffirms that love needs to become action. And speaks about the power of divine grace and charity. On our own, we can do little or nothing. But we can bear lasting fruit with God and his Son, Jesus Christ. God's love gives us confidence and strength to be witnesses for Christ.

When we follow the commandments and act as children of God, we please the Father. We abide in God through faith and love; the Father abides in us through the Holy Spirit, who graciously imparts divine power and life to us. When keeping the commandments from the heart, we strengthen our relationship with God; we 'remain' in his grace and a life-giving relationship with him. Let's pray to remain connected to Jesus, the true vine.

Amigos,

La primera lectura de este domingo nos dice que los Apóstoles y discípulos de Jerusalén dudaban en acoger a Saulo en su comunidad. Saulo era el que había estado acorralando y persiguiendo a los seguidores de Jesús. Tal vez pensaron que Saulo estaba tramando infiltrarse y acorralarlos para matarlos. Por eso Bernabé se encargó de presentar a Saulo a los apóstoles. Bernabé les contó la experiencia de Saulo con Jesús resucitado en el camino a Damasco y cómo proclamó audazmente a Jesús como el Mesías en las sinagogas de Damasco. Saulo quería pasar tiempo con los Apóstoles en Jerusalén, pero no pudo quedarse allí mucho tiempo. Tuvo que huir porque la gente trató de matarlo por ahora, predicando las buenas nuevas de Cristo. Saulo pasó rápidamente de perseguidor a perseguido.

Los cristianos de Jerusalén salvaron a Saulo enviándolo a Tarso. Saulo permanecería allí hasta que Bernabé lo llevó a ministrar a la comunidad cristiana de Antioquía. Esto lanzó esencialmente la misión de Saulo: enseñar y predicar el Evangelio, proclamar a Jesús como el Mesías tan esperado y cumplir las Escrituras.

La segunda lectura reafirma que el amor debe convertirse en acción. Y habla del poder de la gracia divina y de la caridad. Por nosotros mismos, poco o nada podemos hacer. Pero podemos dar frutos duraderos con Dios y su Hijo, Jesucristo. El amor de Dios nos da confianza y fuerza para ser testigos de Cristo.

Cuando seguimos los mandamientos y actuamos como hijos de Dios, agradamos al Padre. Permanecemos en Dios por la fe y el amor; el Padre permanece en nosotros por el Espíritu Santo, que nos imparte con gracia el poder y la vida divinos. Al guardar los mandamientos de corazón, fortalecemos nuestra relación con Dios; «permanecemos» en su gracia y en una relación vivificante con Él. Recemos para permanecer unidos a Jesús, la vida verdadera.
