Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Friends,

In the Letter to the Ephesians, Paul urges: “Do not keep living like the Gentiles. Put away the old self, the former way of life. Be transformed by Christ, in whom God has created you anew for a life of righteousness and holiness.” Paul points out how the conduct of the Gentiles leads to shallowness. Immoral living and superficial thinking go hand in hand.

The Christians in Ephesus have “learned Christ” and now have a deep understanding of the meaning and purpose of life. Now Paul reminds his readers of the profound change in their identity brought about through their conversion to Christ. By speaking about putting away the old self and putting on the new self, Paul seems to be referring to Baptism. Christians “have ‘put on’ Christ in baptism. So, they must ‘put off’ evil works and ‘put on’ the way of the Lord into whom they have been baptized.” A baptized person dies with Christ and rises to a new life. They are freed from the slavery to sin. This does not mean Christians cannot sin but acquire a new freedom to reject sin.

Jesus has given us the Holy Eucharist to strengthen us to resist sin and from turning away from God. Ask our Lord to help us enter more deeply into the mystery of the Eucharist so that we may better appreciate Christ’s gift and accept His grace and wisdom. Spend time with Jesus in the Eucharist and conform our lives to His.

The key to putting on the new self is to be renewed in our innermost thoughts daily. Prayerfully reading of Scripture, participating in the liturgy, and studying God’s truth can contribute to a renewed mind and a transformed life. Let’s ask ourselves: Which of these three do I most need now?

Amigos,

En la Carta a los Efesios, Pablo exhorta: “No sigan viviendo como los gentiles. Despójense del viejo yo, del antiguo estilo de vida. Transfórmense por Cristo, en quien Dios los ha creado de nuevo para una vida de justicia y santidad.” Pablo señala cómo la conducta de los gentiles conduce a la superficialidad. La vida inmoral y el pensamiento superficial van de la mano.

Los cristianos de Éfeso han “aprendido de Cristo” y ahora tienen una comprensión profunda del significado y el propósito de la vida. Ahora Pablo recuerda a sus lectores el profundo cambio de identidad que ha supuesto su conversión a Cristo. Al hablar de despojarse del viejo yo y revestirse del nuevo, Pablo parece referirse al Bautismo. Los cristianos “se han ‘revestido’ de Cristo en el bautismo. Así que deben ‘despojarse’ de las malas obras y ‘revestirse’ del camino del Señor en el que han sido bautizados.” El bautizado muere con Cristo y resucita a una vida nueva. Son liberados de la esclavitud del pecado. Esto no significa que los cristianos no puedan pecar, sino que adquieren una nueva libertad para rechazar el pecado.

Jesús nos ha dado la Sagrada Eucaristía para fortalecernos a resistir al pecado y a no apartarnos de Dios. Pídele al Señor que nos ayude a entrar más profundamente en el misterio de la Eucaristía para que podamos apreciar mejor el don de Cristo y aceptar su gracia y sabiduría. Pasar tiempo con Jesús en la Eucaristía y conformar nuestra vida a la suya.

La clave para revestirnos del nuevo yo es renovarnos cada día en nuestros pensamientos más íntimos. “La lectura orante de las Escrituras, la participación en la liturgia y el estudio de la verdad de Dios pueden contribuir a una mente renovada y a una vida transformada. Preguntémonos: ¿Cuál de estas tres cosas necesito más ahora?”

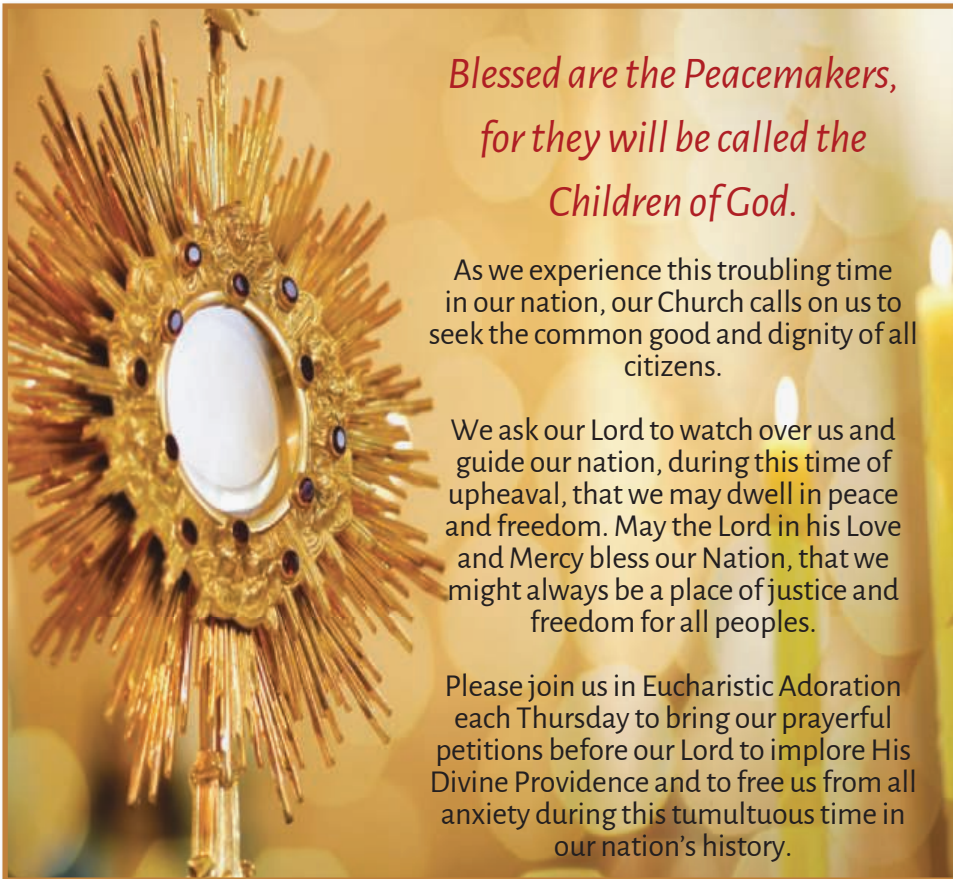
