Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Friends,

As we enter the Bread of Life Discourse in the Gospel of John, it's important to remember that this is not a one-sided conversation. It's a dynamic dialogue, a lively exchange of ideas and beliefs between the crowds and Jesus. Jesus challenges the crowds, and they, in turn, respond with their questions and concerns, creating a rich tapestry of understanding.

When Jesus challenges them to work for the food that endures for eternal life, the crowds ask how they can accomplish God's words. When Jesus challenges them to believe in him, they ask him for a sign more significant than the manna in the desert. When Jesus promises that God will give them the true bread that gives life, they ask for it.

In response, Jesus identifies himself as the Bread of Life, the bread that gives eternal life. Today's Gospel contains the reaction of the crowds, who began to quarrel about how exactly Jesus could give them his flesh to eat. Each time the crowds ask a question, Jesus answers it and tries to bring them more deeply into the mystery of the Eucharist.

Are you ready to enter the mystery of the Eucharist? Jesus' food and drink is a kind of pledge: "The Son of man will not only receive an everlasting kingdom; he will also give everlasting life and bodily resurrection to those who partake of the banquet. And this banquet will consist of only his flesh and blood."

Jesus's promise of real food and drink is not just a physical sustenance but a spiritual nourishment. It's a pledge of bodily resurrection, a reassurance that "The Son of man will not only receive an everlasting kingdom; he will also give everlasting life and bodily resurrection to those who partake in the banquet."

And so, when the crowds ask: "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus says I will not give you ordinary food and drink. But miraculous food and drink. I will provide you with the flesh and blood of the Son of Man through authentic food and true drink. Do you believe?

Amigos,

Al entrar en el Discurso del Pan de Vida del Evangelio de Juan, es importante recordar que no se trata de una conversación unilateral. Es un diálogo dinámico, un animado intercambio de ideas y creencias entre la multitud y Jesús. Jesús desafía a las multitudes, y ellas, a su vez, responden con sus preguntas y preocupaciones, creando un rico tapiz de entendimiento.

Cuando Jesús les desafía a trabajar por el alimento que da la vida eterna, las multitudes preguntan cómo pueden cumplir las palabras de Dios. Cuando Jesús les reta a creer en él, le piden una señal más significativa que el maná del desierto. Cuando Jesús les promete que Dios les dará el verdadero pan que da la vida, se lo piden.

En respuesta, Jesús se identifica como el Pan de Vida, el pan que da la vida eterna. El Evangelio de hoy recoge la reacción de las multitudes, que empiezan a discutir sobre cómo podía Jesús darles exactamente su cuerpo para comer. Cada vez que la muchedumbre hace una pregunta, Jesús la responde y trata de adentrarla más en el misterio de la Eucaristía.

¿Estás preparado para entrar en el misterio de la Eucaristía? La comida y la bebida de Jesús son una especie de promesa: "El Hijo del hombre no sólo recibirá un reino eterno, sino que también dará vida eterna y resurrección corporal a los que participen en el banquete. Y este banquete consistirá sólo en su cuerpo y su sangre".

La promesa de Jesús de comida y bebida de verdad no es sólo un sustento físico, sino un alimento espiritual. Es una promesa de resurrección corporal, una garantía de que "El Hijo del hombre no sólo recibirá un reino eterno, sino que también dará vida eterna y resurrección corporal a los que participen en el banquete".

Y así, cuando la multitud pregunta: "¿Cómo puede Este darnos a comer su cuerpo?". Jesús dice: "No les daré comida y bebida ordinarias. Sino comida y bebida milagrosas. Les daré el cuerpo y la sangre del Hijo del hombre mediante comida auténtica y bebida verdadera. ¿Lo creen?"


