Marriage

To start your wedding planning, contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 at least six months prior to your wedding date for church availability and to schedule an initial meeting with a priest or deacon.

Baptism

At St. Norbert Parish, we celebrate baptisms on the 3rd weekend of each month during Mass. The Mass with Baptism rotates monthly among the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil, and 9:00 am and 11:30 am Sunday morning Masses.

The Baptismal Registration and Godparent Eligibility forms can be found on the *Baptism* page of the parish website, under the *Sacraments* tab. Parents must attend a Baptism Prep class for the first child being baptized Catholic. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to inquire about the Baptism process and upcoming dates/times of the monthly Masses.

Sponsor Certificates

If a registered member of St. Norbert Parish is in need of a Letter of Eligibility to be a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation Sponsor, the individual...

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church or a Convalidation Ceremony.
- Must be an active member of St. Norbert Parish.

Contact the parish office to request a Letter of Eligibility at least three weeks before the date needed and to arrange to pick up the letter.

Communion Visits

The Eucharist is nourishment in our time of need. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 to arrange for a sick or homebound parishioner to receive Holy Communion.

Anointing of the Sick

Opportunities for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick are available regularly. Contact the parish office at 610-644-1655 for details to arrange for this sacrament. If the parish office is closed, and there is a danger of death, please follow the directions on the telephone messaging system regarding emergencies for parishioners. A priest will automatically be paged.

Friends,

In his Bread of Life discourse, Jesus insisted three times that the people eat his flesh and drink his blood. The crowds' response to this is understandable. They said, "This saying is hard; who can accept it?" And now, some began to harden their hearts and refuse to believe.

John's Gospel tells us that many of Jesus' disciples did not accept his teaching and stopped following him. When Jesus confronted Peter and the other Apostles about his teaching and whether they would leave him, Peter confessed his faith. Peter admits that Jesus is the Holy One of God and that Jesus has the words of eternal life.

The primary reason why Jesus lost many of his disciples is found in his statements about eating his flesh and drinking his blood. Indeed, Jesus' disciples asked themselves questions like how Jesus could give them his flesh for food. His shocking words about eating his flesh and drinking his blood called for supernatural faith. That's what Jesus meant when he said to those who didn't believe him: "No one can come to me unless it is granted him by the Father" (John 6:65).

Jesus gave his disciples two keys to understand his words. The first is that Jesus is divine: You can only understand how Jesus, as the Son of Man, can give his body and blood as food and drink if you believe and know that he has divine power.

The second key is the mystery of Jesus' resurrection: Jesus invites his disciples to eat the living flesh of his resurrected body. He indicates that he will be raised up to "life" by the power of the Spirit and then taken up to heaven in the Ascension Through the Resurrection and Ascension. Jesus is no longer bound by space and time. He can appear when, where, and under whatever form he wills. Ultimately, those who left Jesus after this teaching did not understand that he wanted to give them his resurrected body and blood, miraculously present under the veil of bread and wine. Let's come to the altar and receive the bread of life.

Amigos,

En su discurso del Pan de Vida, Jesús insistió tres veces en que la gente comiera su cuerpo y bebiera su sangre. Es comprensible la respuesta de la muchedumbre. Decían: “Esta palabra es dura; ¿quién podrá aceptarla?”. Y ahora, algunos empezaron a endurecer su corazón y a negarse a creer.

El Evangelio de Juan nos dice que muchos de los discípulos de Jesús no aceptaron sus enseñanzas y dejaron de seguirle. Cuando Jesús se enfrentó a Pedro y a los demás Apóstoles sobre sus enseñanzas y sobre si lo dejarían, Pedro confesó su fe. Pedro admite que Jesús es el Santo de Dios y que Jesús tiene palabras de vida eterna.

La razón principal por la que Jesús perdió a muchos de sus discípulos se encuentra en sus declaraciones sobre comer su cuerpo y beber su sangre. De hecho, los discípulos de Jesús se hacían preguntas como la de cómo Jesús podía darles su cuerpo como alimento. Sus impactantes palabras sobre comer su cuerpo y beber su sangre exigían una fe sobrenatural. A eso se refería Jesús cuando dijo a los que no le creían: “Nadie puede venir a mí si no se lo concede el Padre” (Juan 6, 65).

Jesús dio a sus discípulos dos claves para entender sus palabras. La primera es que Jesús es divino: sólo puedes entender cómo Jesús, como Hijo del Hombre, puede dar su cuerpo y su sangre como comida y bebida si crees y sabes que tiene poder divino.

La segunda clave es el misterio de la resurrección de Jesús: Jesús invita a sus discípulos a comer la carne viva de su cuerpo resucitado. Indica que será resucitado a la “vida” por el poder del Espíritu y luego llevado al cielo en la Ascensión a través de la Resurrección y la Ascensión. Jesús ya no está atado por el espacio y el tiempo. Puede aparecer cuando, donde y bajo la forma que quiera. En última instancia, los que abandonaron a Jesús después de esta enseñanza no comprendieron que quería entregarles su cuerpo y su sangre resucitados, milagrosamente presentes bajo el velo del pan y del vino. Acerquémonos al altar y recibamos el pan de vida.

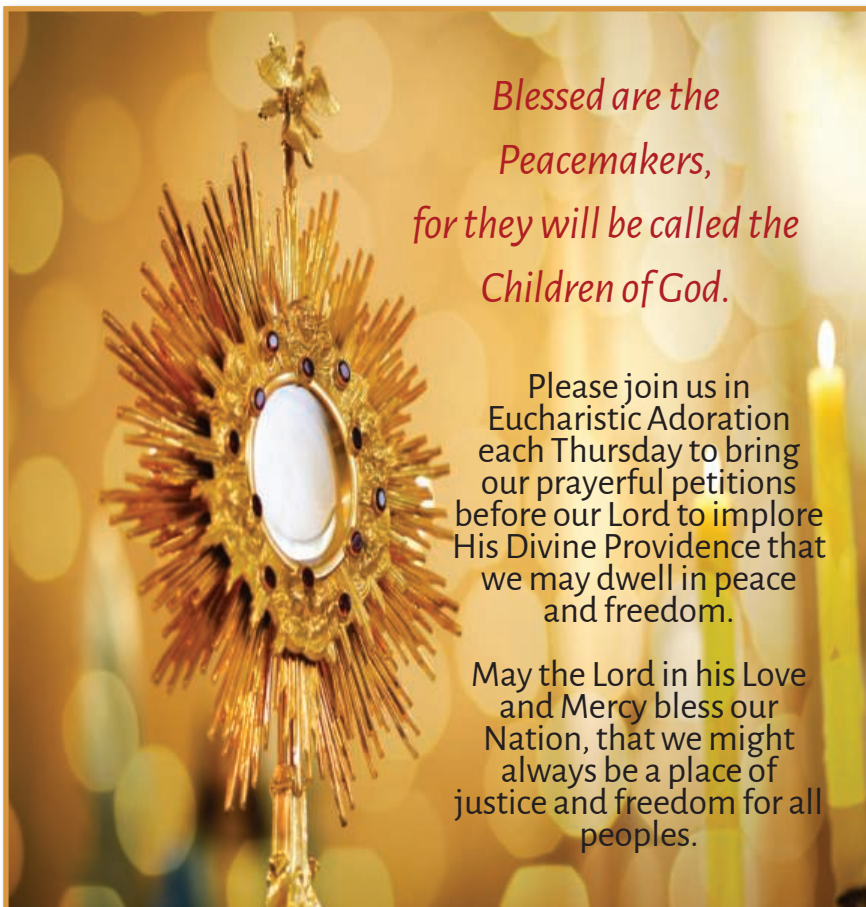
