
Small Groups Conversation Guide



Seriously, God? Week Four

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. **Recognizing Bad Leadership** Have you ever been in a situation where you felt that the wrong person was in charge? How did that experience impact your faith and trust in God's plan?
- 2. **God's Awareness and Timing** The homily emphasizes that God sees bad leadership and hears the cries of those suffering under it. How does this change the way you approach difficult leadership situations in your life?
- 3. **God's Call to Leadership** Moses doubted his abilities, yet God chose him to lead. Have you ever felt called to step into a leadership role despite feeling unqualified? How did you respond?
- 4. **Trusting God in Leadership** The message suggests that leadership requires relying on God. What practical ways can we ensure that our leadership—whether in family, work, or community—is guided by faith rather than personal ambition?
- 5. **Prayer and Action** The homily encourages us to pray for the grace to use power and authority in a way that honors God. How can prayer help us discern when to step up as leaders and when to trust God's timing?
